RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	Race Images 1200
<p>THE KIPLING GIRL (L Magorrian) and BETTERBEGOOD (T Thornton) came together when leaving the barriers with BETTERBEGOOD then shifting out making contact with GO LIKE ELLE (L Satherley).</p> <p>DEVIANT MISS (A Collett) knuckled when leaving the barriers.</p> <p>ANGEL VAN HAARLEM (D Prastiyou) was crowded and steadied when racing in restricted room shortly after leaving the barriers by NOTA BENE (S Collett) which shifted in. S Collett was advised she must exercise greater care.</p> <p>SNEAKYSID (S McKay) was steadied when racing in restricted room passing the 1100 metres.</p> <p>DEVIANT MISS, MOST LIKELY (M Hills) and ANGEL VAN HAARLEM all raced in restricted room passing the 1100 metres, to the inside of MONEY TRAIL (S Spratt) which shifted in and away from THE KIPLING GIRL. S Spratt was advised she must make a greater attempt to relieve pressure when horses are shifting ground.</p> <p>Approaching the 1000 metres GO LIKE ELLE was steadied when becoming awkwardly placed on heels.</p>	

EXPLOSIVE OCTAINE (L Innes) raced ungenerously passing the 900 metres and hung out forcing **ANGEL VAN HAARLEM** out on to **MOST LIKELY** which was steadied, losing ground. As a result **BETTERBEGOOD** which was following had to steady.

EXPLOSIVE OCTAINE raced greenly throughout making the bend awkwardly near the 400 metres.

When questioned regarding the performance of **ANGEL VAN HAARLEM** Apprentice D Prastiyou advised that the filly had failed to handle the existing track conditions.

When questioned regarding the performance of **NOTA BENE** Rider S Collett advised although the filly had been a little reluctant amongst horses but had been otherwise disappointing. **NOTA BENE** underwent a subsequent veterinary examination which could find no abnormalities. Trainer S Marsh advised that he would report anything that may become apparent in days subsequent and further advised that he intends to ride the filly in a more forward position at its next race day appearance.

Race 2

Tourism Ireland 1200

CALLIGRAPHY (V Gatu) and **MR LUIGI** (S Spratt) both began awkwardly, losing ground.

JOUET CUVÉE (A Schwerin) was crowded when leaving the barriers.

MR LUIGI raced ungenerously in the early stages and when approaching the 900 metres became awkwardly placed on heels and was badly hampered, losing ground. Hampered as a result was **DARCI GLITTER** (D Prastiyou). **DARCI GLITTER** then raced ungenerously for a distance. **MR LUIGI** continued to race ungenerously through the middle stages.

MR LUIGI was briefly held up passing the 400 metres.

JACQUI ICKX (U Holmquist) steadied passing the 400 metres when awkwardly placed on heels.

ELEGANT LAD (B Hutton) shifted out to obtain clear running passing the 350 metres crowding **JOUET CUVÉE** which commenced to race ungenerously when being steadied away from that runner's heels. B Hutton was advised that he must exercise greater care after the rider of **JOUET CUVÉE** reported that the mare had re-acted poorly and commenced to hang in, becoming awkwardly placed.

PARALLEL UNIVERSE shied near the 50 metres shifting outwards and unbalancing rider L Innes.

Race 3

Scott Electrical 1200

BALLYCHINE (C Grylls) was a late scratching at 11.41am on veterinary advice after becoming fractious in the barriers. Following the race **BALLYCHINE** received treatment for abrasions to the hind leg and stifles by the Veterinarian.

SENASSY (S Weatherley) began awkwardly, losing ground.

TRANKY DOO (Z Nor Azman) and **CITY BOY** (A Collett) came together when leaving the barriers.

SWISS ELLE (BR Jones) began awkwardly and then became awkwardly placed on heels and was further steadied.

NULLA CREEK (B Hutton) was slow to begin.

Passing the 500 metres **THE TILBURY** (E Smith) shifted out slightly under pressure taking **WOOSTER** (L Innes) out on to **CHATHAM WHISPER** (U Holmquist) which was crowded and hampered losing ground. **THE TILBURY** was then straightened by its rider. Video footage of this incident proved inconclusive and no action was taken other than Apprentice E Smith being reminded of her obligations when horses are shifting ground.

When questioned regarding the performance of **GREY SAPPHIRE** rider S Collett advised that the filly had failed to handle today's existing track conditions.

When questioned regarding the performance of **SENASSY** apprentice rider S Weatherley advised that after beginning poorly the mare had got further back than intended and had not recovered.

Race 4

Scot Thrust 1200

SABER (S Olney) began awkwardly, unbalancing its rider.

SHEBANG (T Thornton) was slow to begin.

AAJA NACHLE (B Hutton) and **RAMARRO** (S Spratt) both raced in restricted room shortly after the start and were steadied.

PAN DULCE (A Schwerin) shifted out soon after entering the final straight, crowding **SABER** which was briefly steadied near the 350 metres. **SABER** then shifted in to obtain clear running. Apprentice rider A Schwerin was advised that she must exercise greater care in similar circumstances.

SABER shifted in under pressure in the final straight and passing the 200 metres briefly crowded **AAJA NACHLE** which was steadied and shifted out passing the 150 metres to obtain clear running. Apprentice rider S Olney was advised she must exercise greater care in similar circumstances.

Race 5	Equilume 1600
<p>KAURI MAN (B Hutton) put its head down as the start was affected, losing considerable ground. MANGAROA TAHI (C Grylls) began awkwardly and then had to be steadied off heels. REMINDE ME AGAIN (L Magorrian) and BATTLEFIELD (L Satherley) were slow away. UABASSO (M Hills) began awkwardly, losing ground. JUMEIRAH (Z Nor Azman) dipped when linking on to the Course Proper near the 1500 metres. SUN HOUSE (S Spratt) raced keenly when being restrained in the early to middle stages and passing the 1000 metres shifted out with NINA ARORA (L Innes) shifting away from that runner, crowding KYPO RIVER (BR Jones) which shifted out and hampered BINGIE (M Coleman). When questioned regarding the performance of JUMEIRAH apprentice rider Z Nor Azman advised that he was of the opinion that the filly had failed to handle the existing track conditions.</p>	
Race 6	Bidvest 1600
<p>OUR KING SWAY (M Coleman) and CELEBRITY MISS (T Thornton) came together when leaving the barriers. GUSTAVO (C Grylls) began awkwardly and was then crowded. SPOKE TO CARLO (L Innes) over-raced in the early to middle stages when being restrained. When questioned regarding the performance of SPOKE TO CARLO rider L Innes advised that the gelding felt indifferent in its action with the gelding undergoing a subsequent veterinary examination which could find no abnormality. Trainer N Tiley was asked to report anything that may become apparent in days subsequent.</p>	
Race 7	Broderick Print 1400
<p>PERSUASIVE (M Coleman) had to shift ground inwards to obtain clear running passing the 400 metres.</p>	
Race 8	Graeme Thomson Jewellers Great Northern Foal Stakes
<p>GEORGETHEFIFTH (L Magorrian) was slow to begin. BLUESUEDE CHOUXS (S Spratt) began awkwardly and then was crowded shortly after the start. CHURCH ROAD (T Thornton) had to steady when placed in restricted room shortly after the start. JACKSON ROAD (BR Jones) raced greenly passing the 800 metres and then commenced to give ground. ITS TIME FOR MAGIC (M Hills) lay out making the final turn and when the rider was changing his whip hand from right to left shifted out abruptly near the 350 metres forcing SMILING MORE (M Coleman) wider on the track. ICHIBAN (L Innes) commenced to hang out when placed under pressure early in the final straight and shifted out to the outside of the track making contact with the outside running rail on several occasions when ducking out abruptly inside the final 100 metres losing momentum. When questioned regarding the performance of MAGIC WARRIOR rider S Collett advised that the gelding had failed to handle today's existing track conditions.</p>	
Race 9	Neat Meat 1400
<p>FIRE JET (D Prastiyou) began awkwardly shifting out making heavy contact with REAL WINNERS (S McKay) which was crowded on to the hind quarters of SCAMP (E Smith) losing ground. BASIL BRUSH (V Gatu) began awkwardly, losing ground. ANNABELINDA (B Hutton) began awkwardly. BIG 'N' RICH (A Schwerin) had to be steadied passing the 1200 metres when racing in restricted room to the outside of WEE SONYA (T Thornton) which was steadied when awkwardly placed.</p>	
Race 10	Shamrock Group 1600
<p>NOMISMA (L Innes) underwent a veterinary examination making contact with the front of the gates and was cleared fit to race. FAST CATCH (S Spratt) and WORTHISWAITNGOLD (E Farr) came together on jumping away, losing ground. MR DOOLE (L Magorrian) was tightened and hampered near the 1200 metres when crowded by WORTHISWAITNGOLD. Rider E Farr was reprimanded by Stewards and she must exercise greater care. Entering the final straight PLAYBOY PRINCE (BR Jones) shifted out dictating ANA (E Smith) out on to NOTHING (Z Nor Azman) and PRIVATE HERO (D Prastiyou) which both raced in restricted room for a short distance. MARCIANO (G Cooksley) shifted out under pressure passing the 150 metres making brief contact with ROC DE BANK (M Hills). When questioned regarding the performance of NOMISMA rider L Innes advised that the gelding may be feeling the effects of recent racing.</p>	

Race 11

Auckland Co-op Taxis 2100

TAAXMAN (S Weatherley) began awkwardly, and then raced ungenerously for a short distance.

PERMESSO (A Collett) and **INASTRIDE** (M Cameron) were both crowded shortly after the start with A Collett (PERMESSO) becoming unbalanced losing the use of her left stirrup iron and as a result was retired from the event. The Stewards checked the gear following the race which was in good condition and it was found that the buckle had failed to latch properly. A Collett was severely reprimanded by Stewards and advised in future she must take all reasonable measures to ensure that her gear is safely secured.

TAAXMAN commenced to give ground from near the 700 metres and approaching the 600 metres lay out across the heels of **MR KANTON** (E Farr) then clipping that runner's heel and blundering.
