RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	SPRAY SPECIALISTS MAIDEN (2200 metres)
<p>KNUCKLEHEAD jumped out and hampered BINGIE, which settled back.</p> <p>BEFORUNOIT was slow to begin and settled back. The gelding, which was a jumper resuming, was under pressure throughout the race to maintain contact with the field.</p> <p>BINGIE raced wide throughout.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the performance of HAVATASTE, rider S McKay reported the gelding was unsuited to the Heavy 11 track conditions.</p>	
Race 2	PRYDA 3YO MAIDEN (1200 metres)
<p>FINDERZ KEEPAS was slow to begin and was further hampered when SHEMULOC shifted in.</p> <p>LEICACUTCAT over-raced and got its head up when being steadied racing into the 800 metre bend.</p> <p>SHEMULOC over-raced when wide throughout.</p> <p>BEADLE had to switch ground inwards off heels near the 400 metres in order to improve.</p> <p>THAT'S FUNNY raced greenly in the home straight and shifted in abruptly when struck with the whip near the 100 metres then continued to hang inwards until the finish.</p>	
Race 3	NOEL'S BUILDING MAIDEN (1200 metres)
<p>QUATRE VINGTS and IRISH KING were slow to begin and settled back.</p> <p>IRISH KING hung throughout.</p>	

The winner, CHATEAU MAROUX was inclined to lay in throughout the home straight.	
Race 4	PLACEMAKERS HANDICAP (1200 metres)
<p>PLEASURE PALACE dislodged rider T Johnson during the preliminary. Following a veterinary examination PLEASURE PALACE was cleared to start.</p> <p>OFF ROADING was declared a late scratching at 2.20pm when the gelding refused to load into its barrier. Trainer L Elliot was advised that OFF ROADING must trial.</p> <p>YIN DRAGON was very slow to begin.</p> <p>WHATWEDO over-raced going into the 800 metre bend and had to be steadied to avoid the heels of PLEASURE PALACE.</p> <p>SHE'S ALL CLANG (M Cameron) was under pressure from the 700 metre mark but could not respond and finished in last place. Rider M Cameron could offer no excuse for the mare's performance. SHE'S ALL CLANG was subject to a veterinary inspection which did not reveal any abnormalities.</p>	
Race 5	GARY DYER PAINTERS & DECORATORS MAIDEN (1400 metres)
DAL TALISKER began awkwardly and settled back.	
Race 6	GUTHRIE BOWRON PAINT & PAPER SUPERSTORE MAIDEN (1600 metres)
<p>JITZU and ENTREAT were slow to begin and settled back.</p> <p>THE GREAT GURU began awkwardly and lost a little ground.</p> <p>S McKay the rider of ZIMMABELLE advised that the mare was never comfortable in the Heavy 11 track conditions.</p>	
Race 7	CARTERS HANDICAP (1600 metres)
<p>IMA TUI GIRL began awkwardly.</p> <p>DAL LAUREON was jostled approaching the 800 metres when racing in restricted room between SPENDAHOLIC and IN A MINUTE.</p> <p>Rider L Allpress advised that CRAFTY LADY, which finished last, would benefit from the race.</p> <p>RISING SON (R Elliot) ducked out abruptly soon after entering the home straight but was quickly straightened by the rider.</p>
