#### **RACE COMMENTS:**

Race 1 SELLAR & SELLAR CHARTERED ACCOUNTANTS MAIDEN 1000 METRES

LUCYINRIO (C Grylls) was slow to begin.

MISS HOI POLLOI (M Tanaka) was crowded leaving the barriers and lost ground.

TRINOVANTES (L Hemi) raced greenly in the early stages.

ARCTURUS (J Riddell) was held up momentarily rounding the final turn.

**DEJA ROO (D Turner)** improved onto heels near the 400 metres and had to steady.

**VERGARA (L Allpress)** was inclined to race greenly over the final stages.

EVA JENSINE (Z Moki) hung throughout.

**D** Bradley reported that **PETITE MIDAS** was outpaced throughout. A subsequent veterinary examination of **PETITE MIDAS** was clear.

Race 2 JOHNSON BROS R65 1000 METRES

**ELUSIVE JANE (R Hannam)** was slow to begin and was then crowded when **DANMULAN (D Hirini)** shifted in on jumping away.

**HOCUS POCUS (M Tanaka)** was crowded shortly after leaving the barrier, losing ground.

**DANMULAN** raced keenly in the middle stages, having to be firmly restrained off the heels of **HOSKINS (D Bradley)** near the 500 metres. **DANMULAN** then lay out rounding the final turn taking **STORMY RAY (L Hirini)** and **HOCUS POCUS** wider.

**DANMULAN** then raced greenly for the remainder of the race.

**ELUSIVE JANE** shied at the winning post veering out sharply, when well back.

L Allpress reported that WONDERBAR was unsuited to today's racing surface.

## Race 3 SOUTH WAIRARAPA VETERINARY SERVICES MAIDEN 2050 METRES

STREET FIGHTER (J ParkKes) bounded when the gates opened and settled back.

POROTENE MHIA (M Singh) was slow to begin.

DAME WYNNIE (T Johnson) over-raced near the winning post on the first occasion when being restrained.

**DOMEROVA (L Allpress)** over-race briefly near the 1800 metres however settled quickly.

**SPARCLING THYME (C Grylls)** raced wide without cover in the early stages.

**DAME WYNNIE** commenced to give ground near the 1000 metres and was not persevered with over the final stages.

Connections advised that **DAME WYNNIE** would now be retired.

**SPARCLING THYME** raced greenly over the final 50 metres.

When questioned regarding the performance of FASTNET FIRE, M Cameron could offer no excuses.

#### Race 4 CHALLENGE GREYTOWN MAIDEN 3YO

**ELAMO (N Teeluck)** began awkwardly.

**PRINCESS RAAJ (L Allpress)** raced ungenerously for a short distance near the 1100 metres when being restrained and then hung badly for the remainder of the race.

**WENTWORTH (D Turner)** was held up passing the 700 metres and had to steady off heels before shifting ground out near the 500 metres to improve.

### Race 5 RANCHMANS MAIDEN 1600 METRES

CARRINGTON PARK (R Goldsbury) was slow to begin.

RAZZLE DAZZLE MAN (J Parkes) began awkwardly and shortly after leaving the barriers lay in and became awkwardly placed near the heels of LAUCALA BAY (H Andrew). Simultaneously DANACANTO (N Teeluck) lay in and became badly placed near the heels of RAZZLE DAZZLE MAN which, when being corrected away from the heels of LAUCALA BAY, shifted out marginally resulting in DANACANTO clipping a heel, blundering and dislodging N Teeluck. N Teeluck was uninjured. CARRINGTON PARK (R Goldsbury) was carried over extra ground by the riderless DANACANTO in the early stages and then continued to be inconvenienced for a considerable part of the race by that runner and was never able to recover previously lost ground.

EDNA MARY (D Bradley) raced wide throughout.

#### Race 6 NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE

EM KAY POPS (L Hemi) was slow.

HIGH ESTEEM (H Tinsley) raced three wide without cover throughout.

**SPRITZ (M Cameron)** had to shift ground on two occasions in the final straight in order to continue its finishing run and near the 100 metres when improving to the inside of **HIGH ESTEEM**, shifted out under hard riding and bumped **HIGH ESTEEM** which became unbalanced. **M Cameron** was advised to exercise greater care when shifting ground.

**Z Moki,** the rider of the 5<sup>th</sup> placed **KATIEM MARIE** admitted a charge under Rule 647 (1) of failing to weigh in after the race. After hearing submissions the JCA imposed a fine of \$250.00 in addition Apprentice **Moki's** riding fee was forfeited.

When questioned regarding the performance of ELLY MAY, L Allpress could offer no excuses.

# Race 7 LIQUORLAND MASTERTON R75 2050M

BEEBEE STAR (D Bradley) was slow away.

NO CHANGE shifted out on jumping away hampering ROCKY which lost ground.

**HIGHLY LIKELY (M Cameron)** was crowded at the start, having to steady.

O'REILLY'S DANCER (J Riddell) over-raced at the winning post on the first occasion and shifted in inconveniencing RED SUNSET (N Teeluck) which when over-racing, had to steady.

**ROCKY** raced keenly throughout.

JACK'S BOY (T Johnson) raced three-wide throughout.

MEGABLAST was held up passing the 500 metres until early in the home straight.

A veterinary inspection of **BEEBEE STAR** which gave ground quickly and was not persevered with in the home straight was clear.

**J Riddell** reported that **O'REILLY'S DANCER** pulled too hard throughout having nothing left at the finish. A veterinary inspection of **O'REILLY'S DANCER was** clear.

# Race 8 COTTER & STEVENS R65 1600M

FREELINKS (D Bradley) was crowded leaving the barrier and lost ground.

**AUXSOELUSIVE (L Allpress)** commenced to over race passing the 1200 metres having to be restrained off heels for some distance.

TARIHIRA (D Hirini) race wide throughout.

**LINCHPIN (M Cameron)** lay out rounding the final turn dictating **FAALTLINE (Z Moki)** out onto **TARIHIRA** which had to steady.

**FAALTLINE** then lay out onto **CASTUP (H Tinsley)** which was inconvenienced for a distance. Apprentice **Z Moki** was advised to exercise care.

**DELILAH DELTORO (D Turner) was** held up rounding the turn.

TRONIC ROSE (R Hannam) lay out under hard riding in the home straight.

**D** Bradley reported that he was of the opinion that there may have been something amiss with FREELINKS. A subsequent veterinary examination revealed no abnormality.
