## RACE COMMENTS:

<b>Race 1</b>	<b>SELLAR &amp; SELLAR CHARTERED ACCOUNTANTS MAIDEN 1000 METRES</b>
<p><b>LUCYINRIO (C Grylls)</b> was slow to begin.</p> <p><b>MISS HOI POLLOI (M Tanaka)</b> was crowded leaving the barriers and lost ground.</p> <p><b>TRINOVANTES (L Hemi)</b> raced greenly in the early stages.</p> <p><b>ARCTURUS (J Riddell)</b> was held up momentarily rounding the final turn.</p> <p><b>DEJA ROO (D Turner)</b> improved onto heels near the 400 metres and had to steady.</p> <p><b>VERGARA (L Allpress)</b> was inclined to race greenly over the final stages.</p> <p><b>EVA JENSINE (Z Moki)</b> hung throughout.</p> <p><b>D Bradley</b> reported that <b>PETITE MIDAS</b> was outpaced throughout. A subsequent veterinary examination of <b>PETITE MIDAS</b> was clear.</p>	
<b>Race 2</b>	<b>JOHNSON BROS R65 1000 METRES</b>
<p><b>ELUSIVE JANE (R Hannam)</b> was slow to begin and was then crowded when <b>DANMULAN (D Hirini)</b> shifted in on jumping away.</p> <p><b>HOCUS POCUS (M Tanaka)</b> was crowded shortly after leaving the barrier, losing ground.</p> <p><b>DANMULAN</b> raced keenly in the middle stages, having to be firmly restrained off the heels of <b>HOSKINS (D Bradley)</b> near the 500 metres. <b>DANMULAN</b> then lay out rounding the final turn taking <b>STORMY RAY (L Hirini)</b> and <b>HOCUS POCUS</b> wider.</p>	

<p><b>DANMULAN</b> then raced greenly for the remainder of the race.</p> <p><b>ELUSIVE JANE</b> shied at the winning post veering out sharply, when well back.</p> <p><b>L Allpress</b> reported that <b>WONDERBAR</b> was unsuited to today's racing surface.</p>	
<b>Race 3</b>	<b>SOUTH WAIRARAPA VETERINARY SERVICES MAIDEN 2050 METRES</b>
<p><b>STREET FIGHTER (J Parkes)</b> bounded when the gates opened and settled back.</p> <p><b>POROTENE MHIA (M Singh)</b> was slow to begin.</p> <p><b>DAME WYNNIE (T Johnson)</b> over-raced near the winning post on the first occasion when being restrained.</p> <p><b>DOMEROVA (L Allpress)</b> over-race briefly near the 1800 metres however settled quickly.</p> <p><b>SPARCLING THYME (C Grylls)</b> raced wide without cover in the early stages.</p> <p><b>DAME WYNNIE</b> commenced to give ground near the 1000 metres and was not persevered with over the final stages.</p> <p>Connections advised that <b>DAME WYNNIE</b> would now be retired.</p> <p><b>SPARCLING THYME</b> raced greenly over the final 50 metres.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the performance of <b>FASTNET FIRE, M Cameron</b> could offer no excuses.</p>	
<b>Race 4</b>	<b>CHALLENGE GREYTOWN MAIDEN 3YO</b>
<p><b>ELAMO (N Teeluck)</b> began awkwardly.</p> <p><b>PRINCESS RAAJ (L Allpress)</b> raced ungenerously for a short distance near the 1100 metres when being restrained and then hung badly for the remainder of the race.</p> <p><b>WENTWORTH (D Turner)</b> was held up passing the 700 metres and had to steady off heels before shifting ground out near the 500 metres to improve.</p>	
<b>Race 5</b>	<b>RANCHMANS MAIDEN 1600 METRES</b>
<p><b>CARRINGTON PARK (R Goldsbury)</b> was slow to begin.</p> <p><b>RAZZLE DAZZLE MAN (J Parkes)</b> began awkwardly and shortly after leaving the barriers lay in and became awkwardly placed near the heels of <b>LAUCALA BAY (H Andrew)</b>. Simultaneously <b>DANACANTO (N Teeluck)</b> lay in and became badly placed near the heels of <b>RAZZLE DAZZLE MAN</b> which, when being corrected away from the heels of <b>LAUCALA BAY</b>, shifted out marginally resulting in <b>DANACANTO</b> clipping a heel, blundering and dislodging N Teeluck. <b>N Teeluck</b> was uninjured.</p> <p><b>CARRINGTON PARK (R Goldsbury)</b> was carried over extra ground by the riderless <b>DANACANTO</b> in the early stages and then continued to be inconvenienced for a considerable part of the race by that runner and was never able to recover previously lost ground.</p> <p><b>EDNA MARY (D Bradley)</b> raced wide throughout.</p>	
<b>Race 6</b>	<b>NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE</b>
<p><b>EM KAY POPS (L Hemi)</b> was slow.</p> <p><b>HIGH ESTEEM (H Tinsley)</b> raced three wide without cover throughout.</p> <p><b>SPRITZ (M Cameron)</b> had to shift ground on two occasions in the final straight in order to continue its finishing run and near the 100 metres when improving to the inside of <b>HIGH ESTEEM</b>, shifted out under hard riding and bumped <b>HIGH ESTEEM</b> which became unbalanced. <b>M Cameron</b> was advised to exercise greater care when shifting ground.</p> <p><b>Z Moki</b>, the rider of the 5<sup>th</sup> placed <b>KATIEM MARIE</b> admitted a charge under Rule 647 (1) of failing to weigh in after the race. After hearing submissions the JCA imposed a fine of \$250.00 in addition Apprentice <b>Moki's</b> riding fee was forfeited.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the performance of <b>ELLY MAY, L Allpress</b> could offer no excuses.</p>	
<b>Race 7</b>	<b>LIQUORLAND MASTERTON R75 2050M</b>
<p><b>BEEBEE STAR (D Bradley)</b> was slow away.</p> <p><b>NO CHANGE</b> shifted out on jumping away hampering <b>ROCKY</b> which lost ground.</p> <p><b>HIGHLY LIKELY (M Cameron)</b> was crowded at the start, having to steady.</p> <p><b>O'REILLY'S DANCER (J Riddell)</b> over-raced at the winning post on the first occasion and shifted in inconveniencing <b>RED SUNSET (N Teeluck)</b> which when over-racing, had to steady.</p> <p><b>ROCKY</b> raced keenly throughout.</p> <p><b>JACK'S BOY (T Johnson)</b> raced three-wide throughout.</p> <p><b>MEGABLAST</b> was held up passing the 500 metres until early in the home straight.</p> <p>A veterinary inspection of <b>BEEBEE STAR</b> which gave ground quickly and was not persevered with in the home straight was clear.</p> <p><b>J Riddell</b> reported that <b>O'REILLY'S DANCER</b> pulled too hard throughout having nothing left at the finish. A veterinary inspection of <b>O'REILLY'S DANCER</b> was clear.</p>	
<b>Race 8</b>	<b>COTTER &amp; STEVENS R65 1600M</b>
<p><b>FREELINKS (D Bradley)</b> was crowded leaving the barrier and lost ground.</p> <p><b>AUXSOELUSIVE (L Allpress)</b> commenced to over race passing the 1200 metres having to be restrained off heels for some distance.</p> <p><b>TARIHIRA (D Hirini)</b> race wide throughout.</p> <p><b>LINCHPIN (M Cameron)</b> lay out rounding the final turn dictating <b>FAALTLINE (Z Moki)</b> out onto <b>TARIHIRA</b> which had to steady.</p>	

**FAALTLINE** then lay out onto **CASTUP (H Tinsley)** which was inconvenienced for a distance. Apprentice **Z Moki** was advised to exercise care.

**DELILAH DELTORO (D Turner)** was held up rounding the turn.

**TRONIC ROSE (R Hannam)** lay out under hard riding in the home straight.

**D Bradley** reported that he was of the opinion that there may have been something amiss with **FREELINKS**. A subsequent veterinary examination revealed no abnormality.
