### RACE COMMENTS:

<b>Race 1</b>	<b>AJC On Facebook 2100</b>
<p><b>HANGLES</b> (L Magorrian) jumped outwards at the start crowding <b>SPAWN OF ELAIA</b> (M McNab). Passing the 1800 metres <b>ARITE GURU</b> (A Sims), <b>JEDI KNIGHT</b> (S Spratt) and <b>SUNSET GIRL</b> (S Collett) all had to steady briefly when crowded to the inside of <b>ATUA</b> (C Lammas) which shifted in. Rider C Lammas was advised he must exercise greater care when shifting ground.</p> <p><b>ARITE GURU</b> raced three wide without cover for the majority of the race.</p> <p><b>LOCALLY SAUCED</b> (T Thornton) and <b>SUNSET GIRL</b> were held up early in the final straight.</p>	

**HANGLES** had to change ground passing the 350 metres to obtain clear running.  
**TAMA AKARANA** (Z Nor Azman) had difficulty obtaining clear running until near the 200 metres.  
**SO TRUE** (B Hutton) had difficulty obtaining clear running until inside the final 200 metres.  
**RODMAR** (S McKay) ducked out under pressure passing the 250 metres crowding **THE HEAT IS ON** (L Allpress). When being corrected by its rider **RODMAR** then shifted in, with **SO TRUE** then shifting inwards to avoid that runner's heels, crowding **LOCALLY SAUCED** which had to steady briefly. Inconvenienced as a result was **HANGLES**.  
**THE HEAT IS ON** underwent a veterinary examination following the race which could find no abnormalities.  
Following the race **SUNSET GIRL** was observed to have suffered a minor laceration after being galloped on.

**Race 2** | **NZB Insurance Pearl Series Race 800**

**MATUZALEM** (S McKay) jumped in the air at the start losing ground.  
**DALLAS** (S Spratt) was slow away.  
**DIG IT UP** (L Allpress) lay out rounding the turn forcing **NOVA INCANTO** (S Collett) wider on the track.  
**MATUZALEM** made the bend awkwardly, running wide.  
**MARKOVA** (T Thornton) and **EARLEYGAIN** (V Colgan) raced in restricted room soon after entering the final straight to the inside of **DIG IT UP** which had made the corner awkwardly, with **EARLEYGAIN** and **MARKOVA** then having difficulty obtaining clear running for the remainder of the straight.  
When questioned regarding the performance of **NOVA INCANTO** Rider S Collett advised that the gelding may prefer a step up in distance and further easing of the ground.

**Race 3** | **NZB Insurance Pearl Series Race 800**

**MISS PEGLET** (V Gatu) was slow away.  
**ARRIVO** (A Sims) hung outwards throughout, running wide rounding the bend approaching the 600 metres hampering **COLOGNE** (S Spratt) and **SWISS DREAM** (U Holmquist) which were both forced wider on the track.  
**INDECISION** (D Johnson) was briefly steadied approaching the 600 metres when crowded to the inside of **BRUCE ARTHUR** (M McNab) which shifted in.  
**COLOGNE** made the final turn awkwardly.  
**MISS PEGLET** was held up over the concluding stages.  
Following the race Apprentice Rider A Sims reported that **ARRIVO** had felt uncomfortable. **ARRIVO** underwent a post-race veterinary examination which could find no abnormalities with Trainer Ms J Entwisle advising she would now spell the filly.

**Race 4** | **Trials @ Avondale 14 June 1200**

**SNEEK IN TH'CASTLE** (R Elliot) began awkwardly, losing ground.  
**RED RUMBA** (L Satherley) was slow away.  
**LADY CONTI** (A Collett) was inconvenienced when leaving the barriers when **SHOOT TO KILL** (D Johnson) shifted inwards.  
**BLACK RABBIT** (S McKay) was crowded passing the 900 metres to the inside of **RAPID AS** (U Holmquist) which shifted in. Apprentice Rider U Holmquist was advised she must exercise greater care.  
**I'VERACEDFIFTY** (S Collett) made the bend passing the 900 metres awkwardly and raced ungenerously for a distance.  
**TWO THIRTY** (L Allpress) raced in restricted room over the concluding stages.

**Race 5** | **Winter Racing At Avondale 15 July 1200**

**MAQUIS** (T Thornton) began awkwardly hampering **LUPELANI** (L Allpress) which lost ground.  
**SHOWYOUHOW** (D Johnson) began awkwardly making contact with the hind quarters of **LIGHTNING STRIKE** (S Spratt).  
**FLASH SUGGESTION** (S Collett) over-raced when being restrained near the 900 metres and continued to race very ungenerously making the bend near the 800 metres awkwardly and running wide hampering **MAQUIS**.  
**LUPELANI** made the bend near the 900 metres awkwardly.  
**SHOWYOUHOW** hung out badly making the final bend.  
**GO LIKE ELLE** (L Satherley) raced greenly under pressure in the final straight.  
**BEAUTY'S ROSE** (S Weatherley) had to change ground passing the 150 metres and then again near the 75 metres to obtain clear running.  
When questioned regarding the performance of **SHOWYOUHOW** Rider D Johnson advised that the gelding had hung and had raced greenly at this stage of its career and may be better suited to racing on left-handed tracks.

<b>SHOWYOUHOW</b> underwent a post-race veterinary examination which could find no abnormalities. <b>Trainer Ms J Jeffrey</b> (NITETIME LOVER) was issued with a warning after inadvertently adding a towel when saddling.	
<b>Race 6</b>	<b>West Brook Winery 1200</b>
<p><b>MAJESTIC EMPRESS</b> (M McNab) was declared a late scratching on veterinary advice at 1.21pm after becoming very fractious in its barrier stall. The Stable Representative was advised that <b>MAJESTIC EMPRESS</b> must now barrier trial to the satisfaction of a Stipendiary Steward prior to racing next. <b>MAJESTIC EMPRESS</b> received veterinary attention for lacerations to the stifles.</p> <p><b>ROSE SAUVAGE</b> (L Allpress) was slow away.</p> <p><b>NUTU</b> (S McKay) began awkwardly and then got its head up when being steadied to avoid the heels of <b>BALLERINE</b> (C Grylls) which lay in shortly after leaving the barriers.</p> <p><b>YA THINK</b> (D Danis) raced in restricted room passing the 900 metres making contact with the hind quarters of <b>CHANKOWONG</b> (S Collett) which became unbalanced with <b>CHANKOWONG</b> then making the bend awkwardly.</p> <p><b>KRAKUSY</b> (U Holmquist) hung outwards when making the bend.</p> <p><b>DOUBLE MALT</b> (B Hutton) shifted out passing the 200 metres to obtain clear running inconveniencing <b>NUTU</b>.</p>	
<b>Race 7</b>	<b>AJC Members 1400</b>
<p><b>HEAVEN FORBID</b> (L Allpress) was removed from the barriers and declared a late scratching on veterinary advice at 1.56pm as it had suffered a laceration above its eye requiring veterinary attention.</p> <p><b>ODISHA</b> (S Collett) shifted in passing the 300 metres inconveniencing <b>LORIGGIO</b> (L Magorrian).</p> <p><b>BELLA BLUE</b> (S Spratt) was held up from near the 200 metres.</p> <p><b>SUPERMATIC</b> (C Lammas) was held up approaching the 200 metres for a distance.</p> <p>Passing the 175 metres <b>ODISHA</b> shifted in abruptly under pressure crowding <b>BEAUFIGHTER</b> (M Cameron).</p> <p>When questioned regarding the performance of <b>ARUNDEL</b> (V Colgan) said his chances had not been helped by being taken on in the early and middle stages.</p> <p><b>RHYTHM 'N PLAY</b> underwent a veterinary examination following the race after commencing to give ground quickly from near the 600 metres which could find no abnormalities.</p>	
<b>Race 8</b>	<a href="http://www.ajc.co.nz">www.ajc.co.nz</a> <b>1400</b>
<p><b>Trainer R Manning</b> was issued with a warning for presenting CAMEAHOTFRIDAY without notified gear (side winkers).</p> <p><b>BERNETTA</b> (L Magorrian), <b>SPIDER</b> (L Satherley) and <b>MUSCADET</b> (A Collett) were slow away.</p> <p><b>GARDENIER</b> (M Cameron) made contact with the hind quarters of <b>SIR RITCHIE</b> (U Holmquist) near the 1300 metres.</p> <p><b>CAMEAHOTFRIDAY</b> (L Allpress) commenced to over-race when being restrained off the heels of <b>SIR RITCHIE</b> which shifted in for a distance passing the 1000 metres.</p> <p><b>GARDENIER, SPIDER</b> (L Satherley), <b>NEEDLEPOINT</b> (V Colgan) and <b>MIGHTY MAK</b> (B Hutton) all over-raced for a distance when the pace steadied passing the 900 metres.</p> <p><b>GARDENIER</b> became awkwardly placed on heels passing the 700 metres and shifted out forcing <b>CLOUDS OF GLORY</b> (C Grylls) wider on the track.</p> <p><b>MIGHTY MAK</b> (B Hutton) lay in across heels passing the 350 metres.</p>	
<b>Race 9</b>	<b>Wingate Street 1400</b>
<p><b>HEEZA DREIMER</b> (A Collett) shifted outwards when leaving the barriers causing crowding to <b>GOLD HUNTER</b> (C Lammas) and <b>PRIORITY</b> (R Scott) which both lost ground.</p> <p><b>EIGHT TO RULE</b> (S McKay) lay out when leaving the barriers bumping <b>CARDON BOY</b> (L Magorrian) which then shifted away from that runner hampering <b>NULLA CREEK</b> (R Elliot) which lost ground.</p> <p>Passing the 900 metres <b>NULLA CREEK</b> commenced to race ungenerously, shifting in and making contact with <b>CARDON BOY</b> which then raced in restricted room for a short distance. <b>NULLA CREEK</b> continued to race ungenerously and had to be steadied losing ground. Hampered as a result was <b>GOLD HUNTER</b>.</p>	
<b>Race 10</b>	<b>Goodwin Property Management 1600</b>
<p><b>WHITTAKER</b> (S McKay) jumped away awkwardly.</p> <p><b>O'CAROL</b> (M Cameron) was slow away.</p>	
<b>Race 11</b>	<b>NZ All Golds Cosmopolitan Club 1600</b>
<p><b>Rider A Collett</b> was stood down after Race 9 as she was feeling unwell and as there was no senior rider available Apprentice Rider A Jones was permitted as the replacement rider for <b>ATTICUS FINCH</b>.</p> <p><b>ZUMA</b> (M McNab) was slow away.</p>	

**SHANE O'** (S McKay) and **NAKURU** (D Johnson) both jumped away awkwardly and came together with **SHANE O'** then making contact with **SUN HOUSE** (S Spratt) and losing ground.

**BLACKMAGICWOMAN** (B Hutton) and **ATTICUS FINCH** (A Jones) raced in restricted room to the inside of **VICENTE** (BR Jones) which was taken in slightly passing the 1300 metres. As a result **ATTICUS FINCH** then lost ground.

**SHANE O'** made the bend near the 900 metres awkwardly, losing ground.

**SUN HOUSE** returned to the enclosure with blood present in the nasal area, with **SUN HOUSE** being declared a bleeder after undergoing an endoscopic examination. Co Trainer S McKee was advised that **SUN HOUSE** would face a mandatory stand down from training for two months, and racing from three months, and further advised a veterinary certificate of fitness would be required prior to racing next.
