RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	TE AROHA LIQUOR 1000
<p>FULLY SPARKED (U Holmquist) was slow away.</p> <p>CORPORATE MISSILE (C Lammas) jumped away awkwardly crowding MIDNIGHT GOSSIP (L Innes) on to GOOD SHOW (D Johnson).</p> <p>LADY ROSEANNE (L Magorrian) made the turn near the 700 metres awkwardly and commenced to hang outwards hampering GANGSTERS LASS (L Satherley). LADY ROSEANNE continued to hang outwards rounding the bend.</p> <p>ASTARA (S Collett) raced in restricted room between MIACOCA (S Spratt) and MIDNIGHT GOSSIP approaching the 200 metres.</p> <p>MY PAISANN (T Thornton) shifted in passing the 75 metres to obtain clear running.</p>	
Race 2	GREENE RACING 1400
<p>HEEZNOT (L Innes) was slow away.</p> <p>CAPRIKOSA (M Du Plessis) and DEVERSTATION (B Hutton) came together jumping away with CAPRIKOSA then shifting inwards inconveniencing LICAVOLI (M Hills).</p>	

<p>DEVERSTATION raced ungenerously when being restrained in the early stages, and shifted back on to NELSON PARK (D Nolan) passing the 1100 metres which in turn shifted back on to LICAVOLI which commenced to race ungenerously. Apprentice rider B Hutton was advised that he must not ease the pace in the manner that puts riders in difficulty behind him.</p> <p>CAPRIKOSA, NELSON PARK, JANE'S SECRET (M McNab), HEEZNOT and LICAVOLI all over-raced through the middle stages on a slow tempo with LICAVOLI racing ungenerously when being restrained passing the 750 metres, shifting in, crowding JANE'S SECRET, with LICAVOLI then shifting back out and hampering ARAPUNI HEIGHTS (L Satherley).</p> <p>SHERIDAN (D Johnson) raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.</p> <p>CAPRIKOSA was inclined to shift out over the final 150 metres under pressure.</p>	
Race 3	SUNLINE LODGE 1400
<p>HOT TEMPO (O Bosson) was slow away.</p> <p>VICTORIA'S SECRET (S Collett) over-raced when being restrained for a distance from the 1000 metres, and shifted out passing the 900 metres hampering KAHAROA ROSE which was also over-racing on a moderate pace.</p> <p>HIGH FINANCE (C Lammas) raced wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>The right side-winker became detached from LADY ECHEZEAUX (B Hutton) near the 300 metres.</p>	
Race 4	STEPHEN MARSH RACING STABLES 1200
<p>OKANAGAN (O Bosson), ELECTRIC (A Collett) and HOLD ON (M McNab) were all slow away.</p> <p>HONE (A Jones) knuckled when leaving the barriers.</p> <p>NEW THANG (C Lammas) was steadied to avoid heels near the 700 metres.</p> <p>ELECTRIC made the final bend awkwardly laying out.</p> <p>MARCHERO (L Satherley) raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.</p> <p>MARCHERO was briefly steadied passing the 400 metres when awkwardly placed.</p>	
Race 5	ASCOT FARM 2200
<p>RUN FORREST RUN (M Du Plessis) began awkwardly crowding I'M ALL EARS (Z Nor Azman) on to PANORAMA (M McNab) and DANZABEEL (D Johnson).</p> <p>THE LOCAL (L Magorrian) began awkwardly, making contact with DOMINATION (O Bosson).</p> <p>SAKHEE'S STAR (U Holmquist) raced wide in the early stages before improving forward to lead near the 1500 metres.</p> <p>CHATEAU ROC (B Hutton) over-raced in the early stages.</p> <p>DANZABEEL was not persevered with after becoming tailed off passing the 300 metres. DANZABEEL underwent a subsequent veterinary examination which found an irregular heartbeat. Trainer Ms D Guy was advised by the veterinarian to have the mare undergo an ECG examination.</p> <p>THOUGHTFUL (T Thornton) shifted out passing the 250 metres, inconveniencing I'M ALL EARS.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the performance of PANORAMA, rider M McNab could offer no explanation.</p> <p>PANORAMA underwent a post-race veterinary examination which could find no obvious abnormality.</p>	
Race 6	LEE SOMERVELL RACING STABLES 2200
<p>CANDYBELLE (O Bosson) began awkwardly.</p> <p>MAXIMUM HEIGHT (U Holmquist) raced ungenerously when being restrained in the early stages.</p>	
Race 7	PIKE RACING 1600
<p>THE PATRIOT (L Magorrian) began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p>GOLD HUNTER (T Thornton) and QUEENOFTEAMAZON (S Spratt) were both slow away.</p> <p>NAILED IT (O Bosson) over-raced when being restrained in the early stages.</p> <p>SIR SAVA (G Cooksley) was held up early in the final straight.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the performance of MOPSY, rider D Johnson could offer no tangible excuse other than the mare may now prefer more ground. MOPSY underwent a post-race veterinary examination which could find no obvious abnormality.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the performance of SAM'S READY, rider L Innes was unable to offer any excuse.</p>	
Race 8	NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE 1200
<p>SO CHOOSY (L Innes) blundered leaving the barrier.</p> <p>KEELY BE (M Coleman) raced wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>MYLADYACHIEVER (O Bosson) and KEELY BE made brief contact approaching the 200 metres.</p> <p>Rider L Innes advised that after slipping at the start SO CHOOSY had failed to handle the existing track conditions.</p>	

CANTATA was inclined to shift out under pressure over the concluding stages.
Rider S Spratt reported that **CANTATA** had failed to handle the existing track conditions.
