RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	SUNSET POINT BAR AND BISTRO STAYERS
<p>CATHEDRAL COVE (M McNab) jumped away awkwardly contacting the hindquarters of MISS DRAMA QUEEN (A Collett) which was unbalanced.</p> <p>WON TON (D Hirini) got its head up when being restrained in the early stages.</p> <p>AMPERAGE (M Cameron) over-raced in the lead through the early and middle stages.</p> <p>HANDLES (S Collett) raced wide rounding the first bend until being improved to race adjacent to the leader near the 1300 metres.</p> <p>WON TON raced wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>LIPSIPSUC (L Allpress) clipped a heel and blundered badly near the 450 metres dislodging its rider. L Allpress was attended to by Ambulance Personnel and stood down from her remaining rides with a possible rib injury. L Allpress is now required to provide a medical clearance prior to riding next. LIPSIPSUC was humanely euthanased after suffering a fractured shoulder. M McNab defended a resultant charge of careless riding in that he permitted his mount CATHEDRAL COVE to shift outwards when not sufficiently clear of LIPSIPSUC. After considering evidence and submissions the Judicial</p>	

Committee found the charge to be proven suspending M McNab's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Thursday 3 March until the conclusion of racing on Monday 21 March 2016, 14 race days. SO TRUE (A Jones) was inclined to lay in once placed under pressure in the final straight.	
Race 2	WAIROA BUSINESS SUPPORTERS SPRINT
Trainers S Autridge and J Richards were fined \$50 after presenting LATIN ROSE with an incorrect saddlecloth number. KAGE IS KING (M McNab) was slow to begin. KEEPING TOM (A Collett) had to shift outwards across the heels of TIEBREAKER (R Elliot) to obtain clear running approaching the 150 metres.	
Race 3	VISTA MOTOR LODGE DASH
IMA ALLSTAR (L Magorrian) was declared a late scratching at 2.20pm after taking charge of its rider and attempting to jump the outside fence during the preliminaries. LINCHPIN (M Cameron) and MATTEO (D Nolan) came together leaving the barriers. CELEBRATEDACHIEVER (R Elliot) over-raced in the early stages having to be firmly restrained to avoid the heels of YA THINK (BR Jones) near the 800 metres and continuing to over-race for a distance. CARMENIZE (S Collett) was unable to be fully ridden in the final straight when hanging outwards. Rider S Collett advised that the filly had hung throughout the race. CELEBRATEDACHIEVER shifted outwards under pressure hampering HOSKINS (M McNab) passing the 100 metres.	
Race 4	BETAVET DASH
OUR MYSTERE (A Jones) was slow away. JUDI ANNE (D Hirini) made contact with JAIDES JEWELL (S Collett) near the 800 metres with JAIDES JEWELL then commencing to over-race badly making the bend awkwardly. MONTEGO BAY (J Parkes) raced three wide without cover. JUDI ANNE shifted outwards to avoid the heels of LIGHT MINDED (BR Jones) inconveniencing LADY MARILYN (R Myers) near the 500 metres. THEDEPOT (M Cameron) hung outwards rounding the final turn and continued to do so in the straight hampering ELUSIVE KITTY (R Elliot) passing the 200 metres. OUR MYSTERE had to be steadied to shift outwards across the heels of THE BANDITO (J Riddell) approaching the 100 metres.	
Race 5	KENILWORTH PLUMBING DISTANCE
CASEY MARIE (R Myers) was slow away. Apprentice D Hirini admitted a charge of careless riding in that she permitted her mount CHOP SUEY to shift inwards when not sufficiently clear of AMUN RA (D Nolan) which was checked near the 1400 metres. After hearing submissions Miss Hirini was suspended by the Judicial Committee from the conclusion of racing on Sunday 28 February until the conclusion of racing on Friday 4 March, 3 riding days. ONE O EIGHT (A Jones) raced three wide without cover until improving to sit outside the leader near the 800 metres. CHOP SUEY was held up rounding the final turn having to be firmly restrained off the heels of MURDOCH for a distance approaching the 400 metres and continued to be badly held up when MURDOCH commenced to weaken being shuffled back through the field until obtaining clear running to the inside of MURDOCH passing the 200 metres. AMUN RA shifted outwards marginally inconveniencing WAIT A SEC (M McNab) just short of the finish.	
Race 6	WAIROA STUD BREEDERS SPRINT
WAWRINKA (J Parkes) and CELTIC BOY (U Holmquist) were slow to begin. YIPSON (D Hirini) raced wide without cover throughout. CELTIC BOY was steadied when placed in restricted room near the 100 metres.	
Race 7	PGG WRIGHTSON CUP TRIAL
ASCOMANNI jumped away awkwardly. CASINO JACK (M McNab) was retired from the race after going amiss when racing free from interference passing the 800 metres hampering BROADWALK (M Cameron) and TEDDYTWINKLETOES (R Myers) both of which were forced over extra ground. CASINO JACK was attended to by the Course Veterinarian suffering a suspensory injury in the left foreleg. Trainer Mr P Campbell advised that the gelding would now be retired.	
Race 8	K9 PETFOODS SPRINT
ENYANNA MARIE (R Myers) was slow away. INDY (A Collett) ducked inwards abruptly crossing the junction onto the course proper passing the 1200 metres and raced ungenerously for a distance losing ground. Trainer Mr S Manning is to be advised that a warning will be placed on record for its racing manners. INDY then over-raced in the middle stages and had to be steadied when attempting to improve into a marginal run to the outside of ZEDSATIONAL (D Nolan) which then shifted outwards to avoid the heels of MY PALOMA (BR Jones) near the 600 metres. LENIN THE BROWN (J Riddell) was dismounted after pulling up following the race and attended to by the Veterinarian suffering from a tendon injury in the left foreleg. Trainer Mr J Bary advised that the gelding would now be retired.
