RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 CHANUI IRISH BREAKFAST MAIDEN HURDLE

OURS (I Lupton) had to steady after jumping the last fence in the back straight after **BANTENEIGHTY (G Walsh)** shifted in on landing over the fence.

OFF HAND (A Kuru) did not jump the final two hurdles and was withdrawn from the race when well back and out of contention.

M Gillies reported that **SCARAMOUCHE** may have held his breath during the running and had little left at the finish. **I Lupton** reported that **OURS** was not suited by the testing track conditions.

Race 2 RURAL TRADING POST HURDLE

E Goodinson (PUDDLE ALLEY) became unbalanced after jumping the first fence.

PUDDLE ALLEY put in a poor jump at the fence near the 600 metres.

The winner OOEE (A Kuru) made a poor jump at the final fence and lost a little momentum.

SHARE THE BLAME (M Mitchell) over-raced in the early and middle stages going out to a long lead before tiring rounding the final bend and finishing at the rear. **M Mitchell** advised he was unable to restrain the gelding.

GOOSEBUMPS (H Bognuda) put in a poor jump at the second fence, unbalanced the rider and lost ground as a

consequence.

KINA WIN (M Mitchell) dipped on landing over the first fence in the middle on the final round.

THE BIG OPAL (S Fannin) and CRASH BANDICOOT (M Gillies) slipped making the southern bend into the middle on the final round

H Bognuda became unbalanced on landing over the final fence in the middle on the last occasion.

GOOSEBUMPS (H Bognuda) dislodged the rider at the final fence. H Bognuda was uninjured. NO QUOTA (A Kuru) and MISTER DEEJAY (S Karnicnik) had to take evasive action to avoid the fallen rider.

BALLY HEIGHTS lost the off front plate during the running.

Race 4 CHANUI EARLY GREY TEA AMATEUR

ZEDEEDUDADEEKO (H Cushing) and MCCULLEY (C Myers) were tightened at the start and got back.

MR COOL BOY (K McKay) and THATZ DAVID (S Barlow) bumped when both runners shifted ground when under pressure near the 200 metres.

M NORTHCOTT reported RAISAFUASHO was unsuited to the testing conditions.

Race 5 CHANUI PURE CEYLON TEA 2YO MAIDEN

L Hemi replaced **D Turner** on ZE **ONE** after D Turner was kicked in the birdcage. **D Turner** received attention from the medical personnel on duty asked to be stood down from his mount in race 7 and cleared by paramedics to fulfil his remaining engagements in races 8 and 9.

R Goldsbury was dislodged from **ROSEWOOD** when parading which then galloped for a short distance prior to being captured. Both horse and rider were cleared to compete.

ZE ONE (L Hemi) began awkwardly and settled back. **ZE ONE** then commenced to over-race for some distance when being steadied.

Race 6 CHANUI ORGANIC GREEN TEA HANDICAP

NORTH AND SOUTH (R Hannam) began awkwardly.

Race 7 CHANUI ENGLISH BREAKFAST TEA HANDICAP

YIPSON (T Johnson) over-raced when being restrained in the early stages.

DERBY DAN (J Lowry) raced in restricted room over the final 50 metres.

MONARCH CHIMES (J Riddell) was inclined to lay in down the home straight and had to be straightened.

SUSSED (R Hannam) had to change ground near the 50 metre mark when **MONARCH CHIMES (J Riddell)** shifted in under pressure. **J Riddell** was reminded of his obligations when shifting ground.

Race 8 CHANUI GINGERNUT BISCUITS MAIDEN

WENTWORTH (D Turner) was slow away.

MASTER PLATINUM (J Riddell) had to be steadied and lost momentum near the 450 metres when TOULOUSE (R Goldsbury) shifted in when being straightened.

TOULOUSE was inclined to shift out under pressure over the final 200 metres and had to be straightened.

MASTER PATRICK (L Hemi) lay in under pressure over the final stages having to be straightened in order to continue to improve.

J Parkes reported that GLENGOYNE was never comfortable in the track conditions.

Race 9 CHANUI ANZAC BISCUITS HANDICAP

CLAPATHUNDA was a late scratching at 3.58pm on veterinary advice after being kicked behind the barrier.

THIRD TIME LUCKY (D Hirini) and VERACIOUS (R Goldsbury) were both slow away.

H Andrew reported that **TALK THE TORQUE** did not handle the track conditions.
