Race 6 NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE (1400M)

The start of this event was a delayed approximately 7 minutes and 30 seconds due firstly to the saddle breaking on **QUEEN SERENE** requiring a replacement saddle and the rider to weigh out again prior to going around to the start area.

There was a further delay when **TAIERI WHISPER** refused to load with the mare being declared a late scratching at 4.05pm. The connections were advised **TAIERI WHISPER** must trial to the Stewards satisfaction prior to racing next.

There was yet a further delay when **OLDEN DAYS** refused to load with the filly being declared a late scratching at 4.07pm. The connections were advised **OLDEN DAYS** must trial to the Stewards satisfaction prior to racing next.

HEED THE FLAG and STAGE DOOR were both slow to begin.

FUN FAIR raced wide throughout.

**QUEEN SERENE** (M Chui) which had improved into a run to the outside of **RHYTHMINYAFEET** passing the 600 metres was badly crowded and checked when buffeted between **RHYTHMINYAFEET** which had made the bend awkwardly near the 500 metres and **HEED THE FLAG** (J Lowry) which was racing greenly on the point of the turn. After viewing the films and hearing evidence from the riders involved the Stewards were satisfied no one horse or rider could be held accountable with no further action deemed necessary.

**RHYTHMINYAFEET** made the bend near the 300 metres awkwardly when laying outwards.

HEED THE FLAG lay inwards near the 200 metres and had to be straightened.

**HEED THE FLAG** lay inwards again near the 100 metres placing **THAT'S MY PUSSYCAT** in restricted room momentarily. Rider **M Chui** admitted a breach of Rule 340 the particulars being that he misconducted himself after the finishing line when making physical contact with apprentice J Lowry. After hearing evidence and submissions on penalty from the Stewards and M Chui the JCA imposed a fine of \$400.

Apprentice J Lowry was reminded of his professional obligations following this event.

## Race 7 DUNCAN AGRICULTURE / WEIR CONTRACTING / BREEN HOMES (1400M)

There was a significant delay to the start of this event due to the horses arriving late to the barrier. **ELVERA**, **BEACONS** and **WAIPATIKI GIRL** were all slow to begin.

**SPITTING IMAGE** raced wide in the early stages.

ELUSIVE PETE made contact with the running rail near the 200 metres when tiring.
