Race 1	SANTOFT STABLES 3YO MAIDEN 1600			
ALL IN GLAMOUR was slow away.				
TRIPLE JEOPARDY made the first corner awkwardly and had to be steadied when in restricted room.				
SASSY BRIDE had to improve its position four-wide rounding the turn.				
Apprentice Jockey H Andrew reported that ALL IN GLAMOUR hung outwards rounding the final turn and early part of the				
home straight and was not entirely comfortable in the testing going.				
Race 2	B CONNORS FAMILY CLAN MAIDEN HIGHWEIGHT 1600			
MRS WICKET and KING OBERON were slow away.				
HUTCH (I Lupton) over-raced shortly after the start bumping with IT'S MAGIC (G Walsh) for a short distance prior to the				
first bend. HUTCH then shifted inwards when being corrected resulting in IT'S MAGIC being checked turning into the back				
straight. After questioning riders and viewing coverage, I Lupton's explanation the gelding was inclined to race greenly first				
time in blinkers was accepted.				
IT'S MAGIC had to steady off the heels of HUTCH when that runner shifted inwards near the 800 metres.				
N Quinn admitted a charge of excessive use of the whip under Rule 638 (3) (b) (ii) and was fined the sum of \$250 and his				

licence to ride suspended for one day on 24 June.

Co-trainer C Bothwell had no tangible reason for the improved performance of **GORDYS GESTURE** but added he was of the opinion the gelding had a dislike for the 1,600 metre chute at Taranaki after two failures over that distance on the course, the last being on 14 May.

Race 3 **TURAKINA CLAN HIGHWEIGHT 1600** S Phelan reported that **SO IT GOES** over-raced when in front and was not entirely comfortable in the Heavy 10. D Miller reported that SKYSCRAPER was reasonably comfortable in the going and had no obvious excuse. Stewards ordered a veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality. Rider M Cropp reported that **BANG** was not comfortable in today's Heavy 10 track. **NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES 1340** Race 4 **ONEFORTHEDITCH** reared simultaneously as the gates opened losing ground (six lengths). AUXSOELUSIVE over-raced early. AUXSOELUSIVE was held up briefly near the 400 metres. VITALIA (S McKay) hung outwards rounding the turn and early part of the home straight. Rider S McKay said the mare was unsuited to the heavy going. D Hirini reported THAT'S FUNNY was unable to make up any discernable ground in the home straight after getting back in the early stages, adding the filly raced greenly in the testing going. Race 5 WICKHAM CLAN MAIDEN 1200 MASTER BEN was slow away. THE LAIRDS LADY over-raced in the early stages and hung outwards on the first turn tightening CRAFTY CRIM and ALY'S BELT. When questioned regarding the run of THE LAIRDS LADY Rider L Allpress advised the mare had little left at the finish after over-racing in the early and middle stages. SIDART was denied a run towards the outside fence near the 300 metres so was angled inwards in order to improve near the 200 metres. Rider J Parkes (CRAFTY CRIM) was spoken to regarding his ride in the home straight in particular over the final stages. J Parkes advised the mare had come to the end of its run after being well tried with the whip and he had ridden hands and heels over the final few strides in order to keep it balanced in the heavy going. Race 6 **GUDSELL CLAN 1200** PLEASURE PALACE and BEAUTIFUL MAN were slow away. NOM DE BOSS began awkwardly.

**PLEASURE PALACE** raced in restricted room in the early part of the home straight and was buffeted for a short distance. **PASS IT ON** was inclined to lug out under pressure in the home straight.

#### Race 7 THE WHANGAEHU O'LEARYS 2060

BAD BOY BROWN and MOUNTAIN PRINCESS were both slow away.

**CHONNEY** over-raced in the early stages.

Stewards ordered a post-race veterinary inspection of **TRONIC ROSE** which finished well back revealing lameless in the left fore limb. Connections were advised that a clearance is required prior to the mare's next start.
