RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	Cowley's Hire Centre 2100
JUST GOT HOME (A Sims) and SMEDLEY (L Magorrian) were slow away.	
Race 2	Ford Fiesta 1400
FORTIUS (M McNab) was slow away when beginning awkwardly making contact with SEATTLE (L Magorrian).	

SPIDER (T Thornton) was crowded passing the 1100 metres to the inside of **SECLUDED** (M Cameron) which shifted in when not fully clear. As a result **SPIDER** then commenced to race ungenerously and shifted back on to **BALLERINE** (L Innes) which also commenced to race ungenerously. Rider **M Cameron** was reprimanded by Stewards and advised that a warning would be placed on his record.

SPIDER raced three wide without cover from near the 800 metres.

BACHRO (S McKay) raced wide without cover throughout.

FANNY BLANKERS (S Weatherley) had difficulty obtaining clear running for the majority of the final straight.

THE CHIEF (D Prastiyau) shifted out off heels passing the 200 metres.

UPANDGO (A Jones) was held up over the final 100 metres.

When questioned regarding the performance of **CAMAROSO** Rider M Coleman was of the opinion that the gelding had held its breath.

Race 3	Fell Engineering Open 1600

Trainer **K Rae** was fined \$50 after presenting UPPLAND to race in gear which had not been notified (blinkers).

LATE DECISION (M Coleman) was slow away.

IRISH GEM (S Spratt) raced three wide without cover throughout.

THUNDER DOWN UNDER (T Thornton) shifted out to obtain clear running passing the 300 metres.

LATE DECISION was held up passing the 200 metres and could not obtain clear running until the 50 metres.

Race 4	Ford Focus 1400

ABADDON (M McNab) began awkwardly, crowding **OPULENT** (M Cameron) on to **TRAVEL WISE** (L Magorrian) which was forced on to the hind quarters of **HE'S CAVALIER** (T Thornton) which became unbalanced. **TRAVEL WISE** then lay in and away from **HE'S CAVALIER** further crowding **OPULENT** and **ABADDON**. **HE'S CAVALIER** then shifting in slightly before being straightened immediately by its rider, with **TRAVEL WISE** then laying in badly, further crowding **OPULENT** on to **ABADDON** which was checked, losing ground. With Stewards taking into account the racing manners of **TRAVEL WISE** Rider T Thornton was reprimanded by Stewards and advised she must exercise greater care.

ROCKNROLLA (S Weatherley) lay in passing the 900 metres, crowding **DRAMATIST** (S Spratt) before being corrected by its rider. As a result **DRAMATIST** was steadied losing ground. Contributing was outward movement from **PLAYBOY PRINCE** (BR Jones).

TRAVEL WISE shifted out passing the 400 metres, crowding **PROMISES** (S Collett) on to **ABADDON**.

ROCKNROLLA was inclined to lay in when placed under pressure in the final straight.

When questioned regarding the improved performance of **ROCKNROLLA** D Logan advised that the mare had not been suited by tracks at its previous two starts which she had described as holding. D Logan further advised that **ROCKNROLLA** was racing today on her home track and with the addition of blinkers as well as the weight allowance she was expecting an improved performance.

Race 5	Pierces Flooring Xtra 1600

Trainer **M Murdoch** was warned after saddling IRRESISTABELLE with the wrong saddle cloth, with this error being rectified prior to the horse being presented to race.

YOU ARE AMAZING (M Coleman) was very slow to leave the barriers (5L). Co-trainer P Gerard was advised that a warning would be placed against the mare.

FINNS HALO (S Collett) shifted inwards when jumping away, inconveniencing **CELTIC BOY** (Z Nor Azman).

CAMBRIDGE (M Cameron) commenced to over-race near the 1100 metres and continued to do so in the middle stages.

RISING SON (S McKay) raced three wide without cover.

FINNS HALO was held up rounding the final turn.

CELTIC BOY had some difficulty obtaining clear running passing the 300 metres.

CAMBRIDGE shifted in approaching the 200 metres inconveniencing **DYNAMO** (M McNab).

Race 6	Ford Kuga 1200

WINDBORNE (D Prastiyau) jumped away awkwardly, making contact with **DIAMOND ROSE** (M Coleman) which was forced outwards, further hampering **ASTRID** (J Fawcett) which had been slow to begin.

LEWIS CAROLL (S McKay) jumped away awkwardly, getting its head up.

HUNAPO (S Spratt) was slow away.

Shortly after leaving the barriers **ASTRID** was angling inwards abruptly, making heavy contact with the running rail and losing ground. Apprentice Rider **J Fawcett** was shown footage of her ride in the presence of her employer and the riding mentor.

SUPER LETHAL (S Weatherley) lay out soon after leaving the barriers and continued to do so in the back straight, shifting out near the 1000 metres forcing **DIAMOND ROSE** wider on the track.

LEWIS CAROLL shifted in passing the 1000 metres to obtain a position closer to the running rail with **LEWIS CAROLL** then racing ungenerously when being steadied and laying away from **DIAMOND ROSE** making the bend awkwardly. As a result **WINDBORNE** which was following, was steadied.

LEWIS CAROLL shifted out to obtain clear running approaching the 350 metres making brief contact with **BEACON OF HOPE** (M McNab) which then lay out, inconveniencing **SHILLELAGH** which was shifting out to obtain clear running.

SUPER LETHAL lay out under pressure over the final 200 metres.

LEWIS CAROLL was briefly inconvenienced when racing in restricted room passing the 100 metres.

When questioned regarding the performance of **WINDBORNE** Apprentice Rider D Prastiyu advised that in his opinion the filly had not performed well under the impost of 58kg. Trainer J Richards advised that **WINDBORNE** and **BEACON OF HOPE** are now likely to be spelled.

Race 7	Ford Everest 1600

Co-trainers **D Logan & C Gibbs** were fined \$50 after presenting **LORD AND MASTER** with an item of gear which had not been notified.

LATIN ROSE (M Cameron) raced three wide without cover.

FIAMETTE (S Collett) had to be steadied to avoid the heels of **ROC DE BANK** (V Gatu) which shifted inwards approaching the 1200 metres when not fully clear. Apprentice Rider **V Gatu** was reprimanded by Stewards and advised that a warning would be placed on her record.

KOENIGSEGG ONE (V Colgan) raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

When questioned regarding the performance of **LATIN ROSE** Rider M Cameron advised that after being trapped wide throughout this had been telling when placed under pressure in the final straight.

When questioned regarding the performance of **BOWIE** Rider M Coleman advised that the gelding may prefer further easing of the ground.

Race 8	Ford Ranger Open 1200

Trainer **S Cole** was fined \$50 by the Judicial Committee after presenting **BELIAL** to race with the incorrect saddle cloth.

CHERRY VAIN (S Weatherley) began awkwardly, getting its head up and losing ground.

SHEZHARDOCATCH (D Prastiyu) was slow to begin.

CLOVELLY PARK (S McKay) was steadied when crowded leaving the barriers.

SHEZHARDOCATCH had to shift out passing the 300 metres to obtain clear running.

FIRST CLASS (R Elliot) shifted out passing the 300 metres making, brief contact with **CHERRY VAIN** which was then inclined to lay in under pressure over the final 200 metres, making contact with **FIRST CLASS** on a number of occasions.

SHEZHARDOCATCH shifted in over the concluding stages, with **TO BE SURE** (S Collett) shifting away from that runner, crowding **CHERRY VAIN**.

TAKEN THE LIBERTY (Z Nor Azman) was slow away.

INA CANTA (M McNab) began awkwardly, losing ground.

WAWRINKA (R Elliot) was steadied when placed in restricted room near the 1000 metres. As a result **WAWRINKA** shifted back on to **MONEY TRAIL** (S Spratt) which was also placed in restricted room and steadied.

TAKEN THE LIBERTY was held up rounding the final turn and when shifting out to obtain clear running made contact with **HEEBY JEEBY** (L Innes) near the 300 metres.

INA CANTA was unable to obtain clear running over the final 250 metres.
