RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	WINSTONE WALLBOARDS MAIDEN STEEPLECHASE			
NELLS BELLE (E Goodinson) dipped on landing over the first fence				
M Gillies the rider of BEFOREUNOIT lost the use of his inside iron after jumping the first fence in the home straight on the				
final round. He regained the use of his iron prior to jumping the next fence.				
MAX put in a poor jump at the fence near the 1000 metres on the final occasion and dislodged rider I Lupton who was unhurt.				
TWENTYTHIRTYFOUR (S Fannin) landed awkwardly at the fence near the 600 metres.				
BUNKERED (S Karnicnik) blundered when jumping the second last fence almost unseating the rider and then put in a poor jump at the final fence when well back.				
AND THATZ SCOTTY (A Browne) was pulled up prior to entering the final straight when well back and out of contention.				
Race 2	TASMAN INSULATION / SENCO BRANDS MAIDEN HURDLE			
ONE KAY (S Phelan) and JITZU (M Mitchell) were slow to begin.				
JACK'S BOY (M Gillies) misjudged the fence near the 600 metres on the first round.				
ARMANDO (H McNeill) put in a poor jump at the first fence in the straight on the first round.				

HARD SHOT (E Goodinson) jumped out at the fence near the 1300 metres and shifted into the line of WILLY DUGGAN (S

Fannin) which was hampered.

ONE KAY raced wide without cover throughout.

BANTENEIGHTY (G Walsh) hit the fence near the 1000 metres.

JITZU did not jump the final two fences.

WHEELER FORTUNE (S Karnicnik) hit the last fence.

CULLISTER (E Farr) and **PERRY MASON (A Kuru)** were retired from the event prior to the final fence when well back. When questioned into the run of **WILLY DUGGAN**, **S Fannin** said the gelding over-raced and had little left at the finish but was nevertheless disappointing. A veterinary examination did not reveal any abnormalities.

Race 3 MANAWATU ITM AWAPUNI HURDLES – Feature Jumping Race

D'LLARO (A Kuru) was inclined to run down its fences throughout.

MY MAGICIAN (M Mitchell) hit the first fence in the back straight on the last occasion.

NGARIO (M Gillies) was inclined to shift out under pressure in the home straight and had to be shifted inwards in order to negotiate the final fence.

C Studd the rider of **SUPERTURF** was questioned by Stewards concerned with his apparent lack of vigour and urgency on his mount which became tailed off early and remained in that position throughout. He said it was his intention to ride the gelding quietly in the early stages as he believed **SUPERTURF** gave it's best late in a race if ridden that way having ridden it previously. He said that **SUPERTURF** jumped very well throughout but did hang out during the running and despite using tactics to encourage the gelding to hit out better his mount failed to respond and further added he was concerned with the breathing pattern of the gelding at times throughout the event. A post-race veterinary inspection of **SUPERTURF** did not reveal any abnormality.

C Studd admitted a charge under Rule 636 (1) (b) of failing to take all reasonable and permissible measures throughout to ensure his mount was given every opportunity to finish in the best possible placing. After hearing all evidence and submissions the JCA suspended Mr Studd's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Friday 24th June up to and including racing on Friday 8 July 2016 (2 weeks).

Race 4 CHELTENHAM WITH WHEELS HANDICAP

A ruling was requested from the JCA under Rule 632 (1) as to whether **BANNOCKBURN (L Hemi)** received a fair start after it appeared a starter's assistant mayhad hold of the gelding when the gates opened. After viewing the film and hearing from rider **L Hemi and starter G Phillips** the JCA declared **BANNOCKBURN** did receive a fair start.

YIN DRAGON (R Myers) was slow away.

MR CONDUCTOR (J Parkes) was inclined to shift out in the home straight under pressure and bumped with SLIMLINE (R Goldsbury) near the 100 metres.

Race 5 MANAWATU ITM OPEN STEEPLECHASE - Feature Jumping Race

NO QUOTA (A Kuru) hit the second fence in the home straight with around to go.

At the fence near the 1000 metres on the final occasion **SNODROPTWINKLETOES (M Gillies)** jumped out abruptly into the line of **WISE MEN SAY (I Lupton)** which was checked and lost ground.

NO QUOTA was pulled up prior to jumping the final two fences when well back. Trainer **P Nelson** advised that the gelding was sore and would now be retired.

Race 6 NELSON PINE HANDICAP

DRAGON BEAUTY (D Mo) over-raced in the early stages.

DRAGON BEAUTY improved onto the heels of the weakening **BRAD THORN (R Myers)** near the 50 metres and had to be steadied.

Race 7 IPL PLYWOOD HANDICAP

R Hannam reported that **GRACE WITH POWER** which finished tailed off may have held its breath.

Race 8 JAPAC HOMES HANDICAP

ONE OF THREE (D Mo), was steadied approaching the 1000 metres when racing keenly, shifted out hampering CARNABY (R Myers).

SPARCLING THYME (N Teeluck) was steadied when placed in restricted conditions passing 500 metres.

DE GAULLE (H Tinsley) was held up for some distance entering the final straight having to shift inwards approaching the 200 metres to find clear running

L Allpress reported that ACUTELYGOLD raced too keenly in the conditions.
