<b>Race 1</b>	<b>VICTOR &amp; FRANK MATIJASIVICH OPN HURDLE</b>
<p><b>CANDIDLY</b> (D Miller) put in a poor jump at the second fence.</p> <p><b>MASTER MICHAEL</b> (M Gibbs-Manssen) raced wide throughout.</p> <p><b>NANCHO LASS</b> (C Studd) put in a poor jump at the fence near the 2200 metres.</p> <p><b>THENAMESBOND</b> (M Mitchell) hit the fence near the 2000 metres losing momentum.</p> <p><b>MASTER MICHAEL</b> knuckled on landing after jumping the third last fence.</p> <p><b>CANDIDLY</b> ran down the second last fence inconveniencing <b>MASTER MICHAEL</b>.</p> <p><b>NGATIRA GOLD</b> (A Kuru) lay out after jumping the final fence having to be corrected by its rider.</p> <p>M Gibbs-Manssen (<b>MASTER MICHAEL</b>) was issued with a warning for his use of the whip.</p> <p><b>ISTIMAGIC</b> (H McNeill) lost the right front plate during the running.</p>	
<b>Race 2</b>	<b>WAIHOU TAVERN HURDLES</b>
<p><b>MR ENTHUSIASTIC</b> (S Karnicnik) jumped the first fence poorly.</p> <p><b>ARAPUNI HEIGHTS</b> (M Gibbs-Manssen) raced ungenerously when being restrained in the early to middle stages and raced wide without cover throughout.</p> <p><b>MAESTRO</b> (D Miller) put in a poor jump at the fence near the 1300 metres.</p> <p><b>ARAPUNI HEIGHTS</b> was retired from the race prior to the third last fence after becoming tailed off. <b>ARAPUNI HEIGHTS</b> underwent a post-race veterinary inspection which did not detect any obvious abnormalities.</p> <p><b>TOP CHOICE</b> (E Farr) put in a poor jump at the second last fence and landed awkwardly.</p> <p><b>MR ENTHUSIASTIC</b> misjudged the second last fence.</p>	
<b>Race 3</b>	<b>NOTTINGHAM CASTLE HOTEL HURDLES</b>
<p><b>ST D'ORE</b> (M Mitchell) was crowded leaving the barriers.</p> <p><b>ABSOLUTE GEM</b> (D Miller) put in a poor jump at the second fence losing momentum.</p>	

<p><b>HE'S DAN</b> (A Phelan) hit the fence near the 2000 metres.</p> <p><b>RAP N TAP</b> (R Cole) put in a poor jump at the fence near the 2000 metres.</p> <p><b>THE BEST MAN</b> (H McNeill) jumped the fence near the 1000 metres awkwardly.</p> <p><b>IZZANORANGE</b> put in a poor jump at the final fence dislodging rider M Gibbs-Manssen who was uninjured.</p> <p><b>THE BEST MAN</b> lost the left front plate during the running.</p>	
<b>Race 4</b>	<b>TAURANGA CITIZENS CLUB PUNTERS 1000</b>
<p><b>BUFFALO ELLE</b> (Z Nor Azman) was slow away.</p> <p><b>LADYINTHEWOODS</b> (L Magorrian) jumped away awkwardly and shifted inwards making contact with the running rail.</p> <p><b>MISS PEGLET</b> (K McCulloch) was hampered shortly after leaving the barriers when <b>MOOGHAMIR</b> (S Spratt) lay out.</p> <p><b>MOOGHAMIR</b> made the turn awkwardly passing the 800 metres and lay out hampering <b>ELIZ GARDEN</b> (S Collett) near the 750 metres which had to be steadied as a result hampering <b>LEICA LADY</b> (B Hutton). <b>MOOGHAMIR</b> continued to lay out rounding the bend.</p>	
<b>Race 5</b>	<b>FRANK &amp; ANNIE MATIJASIVICH MEMORIAL OPN STEEPLE</b>
<p><b>SIR AL SYD</b> (S Karnicnik) put in a poor jump at the fence near the 1800 metres.</p> <p><b>ZED EM</b> (S Fannin) knuckled on landing after jumping the second last fence.</p>	
<b>Race 6</b>	<b>CHELTENHAM 2017 WITH WHEELS 2200</b>
<p>Upon application trainer Mr D Wiles was granted permission to remove the blinkers from <b>GLOBAL WARRIOR</b> due to today's heavy track conditions and the amount of kick-back being experienced.</p> <p><b>VICEROY</b> (S MacNab) had to be steadied near the 2000 metres when placed in restricted room to the inside of <b>BORNINASANDPIT</b> (M Roustoby).</p> <p><b>MISS CITRON</b> (C Waddell) ran wide rounding the first turn.</p> <p><b>BIG 'N' RICH</b> (H Fleming) clipped a heel of <b>NEWSTEAD</b> (L Wheeler) and blundered near the 500 metres badly unbalancing its rider.</p> <p><b>REEPERBAHN</b> (L Calitz) lay out under pressure in the final straight.</p>	
<b>Race 7</b>	<b>NEW WORLD MORRINSVILLE 2200</b>
<p><b>SO TRUE</b> (S Collett) was crowded shortly after leaving the barriers losing ground.</p> <p><b>PERMESSO</b> (L Magorrian) and <b>WHITTAKER</b> (S McKay) raced ungenerously when being steadied in the early stages.</p> <p><b>ANA</b> (S Spratt) lay out under pressure in the final straight.</p>	
<b>Race 8</b>	<b>DAVE, FRED &amp; MICHAEL LAURICH 1400</b>
<p><b>CHAMPAGNE TILLY</b> (A Collett) began awkwardly shifting outwards then when being corrected by its rider shifted inwards crowding <b>LA VAMOS</b> (E Farr), <b>TWO THIRTY</b> (T Wenn) and <b>GRANDEUR</b> (M Cameron) which was steadied losing ground.</p> <p><b>PRIZE LORD</b> (S Weatherley) lay in under pressure in the final straight. When questioned regarding the performance of <b>GRANDEUR</b> M Cameron advised that after suffering interference at the start the gelding had felt disinterested in today's heavy track conditions.</p> <p>M McNab advised that <b>DARCI DENIRO</b> had not felt comfortable in today's track conditions.</p>	
<b>Race 9</b>	<b>STEVE LUNJEVICH CONTRACTING 1400</b>
<p><b>SILVERADO</b> (T Thornton) was slow to begin.</p> <p><b>ROAD TRIP</b> (K McCulloch) was slow to begin before being further hampered when crowded.</p> <p><b>HERSCHAL</b> (M McNab) began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p><b>HOT WIRE</b> (L Magorrian) raced ungenerously when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of <b>ESPRIT DE CORPS</b> (M Cameron) near the 1300 metres.</p> <p>Apprentice A Sims (<b>SO KEEP EM</b>) dropped her whip passing the 600 metres.</p> <p><b>HERSCHAL</b> shifted out passing the 400 metres when placed under pressure making contact with <b>SHARE THE WONDER</b> (Z Nor Azman) which was laying in. <b>HERSCHAL</b> and <b>SHARE THE WONDER</b> again came together approaching the 200 metres.</p>	
<b>Race 10</b>	<b>KARL DAVIS BAYLEYS REAL ESTATE 1600</b>
<p><b>OSCARLITO</b> (S Weatherley) shifted outwards abruptly leaving the barriers severely crowding <b>FAST CATCH</b> (B Hutton), <b>HAYLEY ANN</b> (A Jones) and <b>SHE'S ALL CLANG</b> (A Collett) with <b>FAST CATCH</b> and <b>SHE'S ALL CLANG</b> being checked losing ground.</p> <p><b>KALINDA</b> (A Sims) was slow to begin.</p> <p><b>BEYOND REACH</b> (S Spratt) shifted inwards abruptly leaving the barriers crowding <b>I'M BRONSON</b> (J Fawcett) and <b>DOIKNOWYOU</b> (M McNab) which lost ground.</p> <p>Apprentice A Jones (<b>HAYLEY ANN</b>) was issued with a warning for her whip use in the final straight.</p> <p>When questioned, rider M Cameron was unable to offer any excuses for the poor performance of <b>BUBBLEBUBBLE POP</b>. A post-race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality.</p>
