RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	FASTTRACK INSURANCE RATING 65 (2100m)
<p>Rider T Moseley replaced S Collett on SKILLS due to transport difficulties.</p> <p>MISTER SPIDERMAN was slow to begin.</p> <p>HI YO UGO over raced in the early stages and lay in passing the 1800 metres placing SORLEY BOY in restricted room for a short distance.</p> <p>MISTER SPIDERMAN over raced in the early to middle stages and was allowed to improve to lead near the 900 metres.</p> <p>SHOW MACCOOL lay in passing the 300 metres becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of LION ROCK HILL having to be firmly retrained off that runner's heels.</p>	
Race 2	VETENT RIVERSIDE RATING 75 (1600m)
<p>DILLINGER began awkwardly and shifted in abruptly crowding CARBIDE which lost ground.</p> <p>ZERO TUA HUNDRED raced keenly through the early stages and had to be firmly restrained off heels passing the 1000 metres.</p> <p>DILLINGER lay in under pressure in the final straight.</p> <p>A post race veterinary inspection of MORGAN BET did not reveal any obvious abnormalities.</p>	

Race 3	WIN A TRIP TO THE MELBOURNE CUP WITH RD1 MAIDEN (1200m)
<p>FINAL SAY which was kicked in the parade ring prior to going to the start underwent a pre-race veterinary inspection at the barriers and was cleared to race.</p> <p>PASSAMAQUODDY was slow to begin.</p> <p>BUSHIDO blundered at the start.</p> <p>ANYA KURO began awkwardly and shifted in, momentarily crowding KIRRA BELLE.</p> <p>MOTHER SUPERIOR shifted in passing the 1000 metres crowding KIRRA BELLE which had to be steadied momentarily. As a result PASSAMAQUODDY also had to be steadied.</p> <p>I JUST ROCKED UP raced wide in the early stages.</p> <p>MOTHER SUPERIOR made the 900 metre bend awkwardly, running wide.</p> <p>FINAL SAY was held up early in the final straight and when shifting out to obtain clear running passing the 250 metres made contact with BUSHIDO.</p> <p>FLYTIME lay out under pressure over the final 150 metres.</p> <p>I JUST ROCKED UP lay out under pressure over the concluding stages placing VICAR'S DAUGHTER in restricted room.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the performance of the favourite VICAR'S DAUGHTER, rider L Allpress was unable to offer any tangible excuse. A post race veterinary inspection of VICAR'S DAUGHTER did not reveal any obvious abnormalities.</p>	
Race 4	SPEIGHT'S MID ALE RATING 75 (1200m)
<p>MADAME JAMAI lay in passing the 900 metres, momentarily crowding MELS EVIE which made contact with the running rail and then commenced to over race for a distance. Apprentice jockey K Mudhoo was issued with a warning under Rule 638(1)(d).</p> <p>MADAME JAMAI lay out under pressure over the final 100 metres inconveniencing MELS EVIE.</p>	
Race 5	NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE F&M MAIDEN (1400m)
<p>JUST AFLUTTER was slow to begin and tailed the field throughout.</p> <p>SWEET INDULGENCE began awkwardly.</p> <p>LAMBRETTA raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.</p> <p>LOS CABOS lay out under pressure in the final straight.</p> <p>ASHWINI was briefly held up early in the final straight.</p> <p>Approaching the 150 metres PERFECT SECRET (K Mudhoo) shifted in dictating FUN FAIR in onto SUNFLOWER which had to be checked when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of ASHWINI. Apprentice jockey K Mudhoo admitted a charge under Rule 638(1)(d) and was suspended to ride at race meetings for 2 days effective 14 March to 21 March inclusive.</p>	
Race 6	RD PETROLEUM RATING 90 (1400m)
<p>TOMA VALEA raced keenly through the early stages.</p> <p>MISS ALICE had to be steadied when awkwardly placed inside the heels of PEPPERMILL passing the 900 metres and then commenced to over race for a short distance.</p> <p>MISS ALICE again had to be steadied off PEPPERMILL passing the 600 metres.</p> <p>TOMA VALEA shifted in under pressure over the final 200 metres.</p>	
Race 7	ECOLAB DAIRY HYGIENE & TEAT CARE SPECIALIST R65 (1400m)
<p>RAPT proved difficult in the preliminary dislodging apprentice rider K Mudhoo, and galloping for a short distance before making contact with the fence. After undergoing a veterinary inspection RAPT was declared fit to race, with its tongue tie being removed.</p> <p>NOT AVAILABLE was slow to begin losing approximately 4 lengths.</p> <p>STORMY LASS shifted in at the start making contact with HE'S GOLD.</p> <p>CARMEN SANDIEGO got its head up a number of times in the early stages when being restrained to take cover.</p> <p>CARMEN SANDIEGO continued to race keenly through the early stages and had to be steadied off the heels of STORMY LASS passing the 1000 metres.</p> <p>NOT AVAILABLE lay in under pressure passing the 200 metres, making connect with ZAH GIRL.</p>
