RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 THE SPRAY RIG 2200

CENTILLY (M Cameron) lay in under pressure crowding **IAMALLOWEDTO** (B Hutton) near the 250 metres.

I'M ALL EARS (Z Nor Azman) returned to the enclosure with blood present in the right nostril. After undergoing a veterinary inspection it was found the gelding had a minor laceration inside the nostril.

The track was downgraded to Dead(4) retrospective to race one.

Race 2 DECOART 1600

JUST CALL ME MARG (G Cooksley) began awkwardly and then raced ungenerously when well back.

HEEZNOT (C Lammas) was crowded leaving the barrier losing ground.

LICAVOLI (V Gatu) over-raced through the early and middle stages shifting out passing the 1300 metres, and raced wide for the remainder of the race.

PERCY'S GEM (E Smith) raced ungenerously for a distance passing the 1400 metres making contact with the running rail. **HEEZNOT** raced ungenerously in the early and middle stages.

SUPER MARIO (O Bosson) got its head up when being steadied passing the 900 metres, and raced ungenerously for a

distance.

Passing the 700 metres **SHADOW TOWER** (R Elliot) had to be steadied when crowded between **LICAVOLI** and **SUPER MARIO** which was taken out by **EL ENCANTO** (M Hills).

JUST CALL ME MARG was not persevered with over the final 400 metres. Rider G Cooksley was unable to offer any reason

for the filly's performance. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

CHOCANTE (D Johnson) and **NO PUSHOVER** (L Allpress) came together passing the 200 metres when both runners shifted ground with **CHOCANTE** becoming briefly unbalanced.

NORTH OF THE WALL (L Innes) lay in under pressure in the final straight.

Race 3 NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE

CRAFTYEVA (O Bosson) began awkwardly, and then was crowded losing ground.

SNEAKY DARCI (C Lammas) was slow to begin.

CARDINAL SIN (B Hutton) began awkwardly crowding HOT TEMPO (E Smith) which lost ground.

Passing the 800 metres **CRAFTYEVA** ducked out abruptly hampering **QUINTESSENTIALLY** (D Johnson) which had to be briefly steadied.

Passing the 450 metres **ALMARIE** (C Grylls) shifted out making contact with **SNEAKY DARCI** with that runner then shifting out dictating **JAYLA MONET** (A Jones) wider on the track.

ALMARIE had to steady and shift out near the 400 metres when awkwardly placed on the heels of **SHAMADANCE** (L Allpress).

CARDINAL SIN raced wide without cover throughout.

QUINTESSENTIALLY lay in under pressure over the final 200 metres.

When questioned regarding the performance of the favourite **KEELY BE** rider L Innes advised the filly had raced greenly throughout, and was under pressure passing the 200 metres. He also felt the filly may be better suited to a shorter distance than today's race.

Race 4 SMART ENVIRONMENTAL LTD 1400

RED SHEERAN (S Collett) proved difficult to load into the barriers with a warning placed against the gelding.

STRYDA (M Du Plessis) was slow to begin, and then was hampered.

ALL SWEEPED UP (L Allpress) began awkwardly.

BOULTED INN (T Thornton) raced ungenerously when being restrained in the early stages becoming awkwardly placed on heels for a distance passing the 900 metres.

HYPERVELOCITY (M Cameron) was held up and shifted out across heels passing the 350 metres to obtain clear running.

RUB IT IN (S McKay) was unable to obtain clear running until near the 250 metres.

NOWHERE MAN (L Innes) lay out when placed under pressure in the final straight. Rider L Innes reported that the bit had shifted through the horse's mouth and had proved difficult to ride.

Trainer Mr G Rogerson advised **RED SHEERAN** would now be spelled.

Race 5 STEVE'S DISCOUNT NURSERY & GARDEN CENTRE 1200

ATUA (C Lammas) was crowded shortly after leaving the barriers and steadied.

HERSCHAL (M Du Plessis) began awkwardly and was steadied.

NEW THANG (S Collett) raced wide without cover.

MIGHTY ME (L Allpress) had difficulty obtaining clear running until near the 250 metres.

GOLDCHI (L Innes) was held up briefly passing the 250 metres then was quickly under pressure.

HERSCHAL lost the left front plate during the running.

Race 6 PIAKO RURAL SERVICES 1200

GARDONE (D Danis) was crowded shortly after jumping away.

STOCKTAKE (R Elliot) stumbled shortly after jumping away, and then became briefly unbalanced when **PENN 'N' TELLER** (B Hutton) shifted in making contact.

GARDONE over-raced for a distance passing the 700 metres.

GARDONE was briefly held up near the 100 metres when awkwardly placed on the heels of **COURTMASTER** (R Hannam).

CHACHAR (D Johnson) was inclined to lay inwards throughout.

Rider S Collett (EPROUVEZ) dropped her whip near the 50 metres.

Race 7 NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE 1600

THE SWEET ESCAPE (L Allpress) was slow to begin.

FANTASY JET (L Satherley) shifted out leaving the barriers crowding CAPRIELLA (L Innes) and RUBEE (M Hills).

FANTASY JET raced ungenerously when being restrained approaching the 1500 metres.

SOPRAFFINA (D Johnson) was steadied when crowded passing the 1500 metres.

IRRESISTABELLE (C Lammas) lay in approaching the 800 metres crowding **MAREEBA** (U Holmquist) which raced in restricted room, and then shifted in slightly crowding **FANTASY JET** which had made the bend awkwardly with **FANTASY JET** then racing in restricted room and being steadied. As a result **RUBEE** then became awkwardly placed on the heels of **FANTASY JET** and shifted out making contact with the hind quarters of **SOPRAFFINA** turning the mare inwards hampering **RUBEE** which had to be steadied.

MAREEBA returned to the enclosure with blood present in the right nostril. After undergoing a veterinary inspection MAREEBA was found to have a minor laceration inside the nostril.

RUBEE lost the right front plate during the running.
