RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	BEN ALLEN TRANSPORT MILE (1600 metres)
<p>HIGH SPIRITS was outpaced in the early stages and got back.</p> <p>HIGH SPIRITS had to steady momentarily passing the 700 metres when awkwardly placed near the heels of TUI BABE, which shifted out.</p> <p>M Tanaka the rider of HIGH SPIRITS was reminded of his obligations with regard to use of the whip prior to the 200 metres.</p>	
Race 2	CENTRAL FM 1200 (1200 metres)
<p>JUDI ANNE was slow to begin.</p> <p>JANDAKOT shifted out on jumping crowding JED CLAMPETT, which lost ground.</p> <p>JUDI ANNE was obliged to race three wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>JANDAKOT returned to the enclosure with blood present in both nostrils. The course veterinarian confirmed JANDAKOT to have bled and as this was the second occasion the gelding had bled in races it is now permanently barred from racing in New Zealand.</p>	
Race 3	AEROSPREAD 1200 (1200 metres)
<p>OSCAR'S SHADOW began awkwardly and shifted out bumping with ROC 'N' IT.</p> <p>MAYARI raced three wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>ROC 'N' IT raced in restricted room passing the 200 metres and near the 150 metres was briefly held up when awkwardly near the heels of MY ISABELLA.</p>	
Race 4	CHB MAIL 1400 (1400 metres)

MADREKAY lay out when making the junction on to the course proper near the 1200 metres.
CAPTAIN LINCOLN over-raced near the 1000 metres so was taken out to sit adjacent to the leader.
SHAMROCK KING dipped momentarily near the 150 metres.
MADREKAY returned to the enclosure with blood in its mouth. A veterinary surgeon reported that this had resulted from a loose tooth.

Race 5	CENTRALINES/BAYLEYS 3YO 1400 (1400 metres)

MOSS JAZZ was fractious in the enclosure and dislodged rider D Bradley who was uninjured, with **MOSS JAZZ** having to return to the stabling area to have a bridle replaced.
BOOM BOOM DIDI and **KNIFE** were both slow to begin and settled back.
BIG MARNE (M Tanaka) had to be steadied near the 900 metres when **PERFECT SHOCK** (J Riddell) shifted in when only marginally clear. M Tanaka confirmed the official observation that his mount had over-reacted when being steadied. No further action was necessary apart from reminding jockey J Riddell to exercise care when in similar situations.
MARTY O'CEIRIN had to steady and shift ground out across the heels of **MOSS JAZZ** near the 150 metres to obtain clear running.
Rider D Bradley reported that **MOSS JAZZ** had hung throughout.

Race 6	CHB ANGUS BREEDERS 1400 (1400 metres)

BOYSWAY was slow in the early stages.
POPPAS DELIGHT was inclined to lay out rounding the turn passing the 800 metres and, near the 500 metres, when making the entrance to the final straight hung out badly losing ground.
MISS BENCI had difficulty in obtaining clear running passing the 200 metres.
LADY ZAFIRA lay out under pressure near the 150 metres crowding **TEMPLE TIGER** out on to **NOTIONANNAGINS**

Race 7	BEST TRAVEL WAIPUKURAU CUP (2100 metres)

SEALED BY A DANCE and **TEXAS YELLOW ROSE** both began awkwardly with **TEXAS YELLOW ROSE** settling back.
SILK CHARDONNAY (A Jones) had to be firmly restrained off the heels of **KALINGA** (M Tanaka) near the 1800 metres when over-racing. After questioning respective riders it was established that **SILK CHARDONNAY** had proved difficult to control at this point and had over-reacted when being crowded by **KALINGA** which was dictated inwards by **IRISH CHAT** (D Bradley) which shifted in. D Bradley was issued with a warning and firmly reminded of his obligations with respect to shifting ground.
SEALED BY A DANCE got its head up when being steadied near the 1100 metres and then made the turn near the 1000 metres awkwardly and shifted out dictating **IRISH CHAT** wider. **SEALED BY A DANCE** continued to prove difficult to control for some distance.
BALHAM was held up passing the 300 metres and near the 200 metres shifted out across the heels of **IRISH CHAT** to improve, with **BALHAM** then becoming awkwardly placed between **IRISH CHAT** and **O'CEIRINS WHISPER** when **IRISH CHAT** shifted out and away from **VICTORY DRIVE**, which was laying out under pressure.

Race 8	FARMLANDS MILE (1600 metres)

SAVARHYS struck the front of its barrier momentarily before the barriers were released and lost ground with **SAVARHYS** failing to recover any discernible ground due to the fast tempo of this event.
CLIFFORD lay out when under pressure near the 150 metres, with **KEEP US HAPPY**, which was to its outside, shifting out and away from **CLIFFORD**, simultaneously as **WAIT A SEC**, which was laying in under pressure, shifted in marginally. This resulted in **KEEP US HAPPY** having to be briefly steadied.
