## RACE COMMENTS:

<b>Race 1</b>	<b>Hydroflow 1400</b>
<b>HEAD OFFICE</b> (G Cooksley) and <b>THE BRAVE ONE</b> (S McKay) both began awkwardly losing ground. <b>PROCRASTINATE</b> (B Hutton) raced in restricted room for a distance passing the 1200 metres and then was obliged to race wide without cover.	

<b>HARDCASE</b> (A Collett) shifted out passing the 400 metres to obtain clear running making contact with <b>PROCRASTINATE</b> which became unbalanced. A Collett was advised she must exercise greater care when shifting ground.	
<b>Race 2</b>	<b>Ginde 1300</b>
<b>WILIJONMCBRIDE</b> (L Magorrian) began awkwardly making heavy contact with <b>RAQISA</b> (S McKay). <b>QUANTUM</b> (BR Jones) began awkwardly and then had to steady when crowded. <b>ASTARA</b> (S Collett) raced ungenerously when being steadied from near the 800 metres. <b>SHADOWS</b> (T Thornton) raced greenly throughout. <b>RAQISA</b> became awkwardly placed on the heels of <b>WILIJONMCBRIDE</b> which shifted out approaching the 600 metres. As a result <b>RAQISA</b> then shifted back on to <b>SHADOWS</b> which was hampered. <b>WILIJONMCBRIDE</b> continued to shift out making contact with <b>CAVALLUCCI</b> (D Turner) which was forced wider on the track. Apprentice L Magorrian was reprimanded by Stewards and advised he must exercise greater care when shifting ground. <b>QUANTUM</b> had to shift out approaching the 200 metres to obtain clear running.	
<b>Race 3</b>	<b>Adesso 2200</b>
<b>DOURO</b> (L Innes) was crowded soon after leaving the barriers. <b>OCEAN BOUND</b> (U Holmquist) commenced to over-race for a distance when awkwardly placed inside the heels of <b>PENTIRE BABE</b> (T Thornton) which shifted in passing the 2000 metres when not fully clear. Rider T Thornton was issued with a warning and advised she must exercise greater care when shifting ground. <b>OCEAN BOUND</b> then over-raced through the middle stages. When questioned regarding the performance of <b>DOURO</b> Rider L Innes was unable to offer any tangible excuses.	
<b>Race 4</b>	<b>Raymor 1600</b>
<b>RULE THE WORLD</b> (U Holmquist) lay out under pressure approaching the 100 metres inconveniencing <b>THUNDER DOWN UNDER</b> (Z Moki).	
<b>Race 5</b>	<b>Celebrating Rangipo 1600</b>
<b>PRINCE OF PASSION</b> (L Innes) was slow to begin. <b>SANTIAGO</b> (L Magorrian) shifted in passing the 1400 metres making contact with the hind quarters of <b>MAXIMUM HEIGHT</b> (A Jones) which became briefly unbalanced. As a result <b>SIERRA BEEL</b> (S Collett) had to briefly steady. Apprentice L Magorrian was advised to exercise greater care. <b>SOUND PROPOSITION</b> (S McKay) raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.	
<b>Race 6</b>	<b>Te Akau Racing Celebrates Heroic Valour 1200</b>
<b>MAKARIOS</b> (L Magorrian) lay in and away from <b>SCUSA</b> (L Innes) soon after leaving the barriers crowding <b>QIKCAT</b> (A Collett) on to <b>SHEZA FLOJO</b> (G Cooksley) which was hampered losing ground. Contributing was outward movement from <b>VITESSE</b> (S Collett). <b>SILENCER</b> (R Elliot) began awkwardly. <b>PARISDOTCON</b> (T Thornton) steadied away from the heels of <b>DE NIRO</b> (S McKay) approaching the 1100 metres. As a result <b>QIKCAT</b> was crowded on to <b>VITESSE</b> which had to steady. Rider S McKay was issued with a warning and advised that he must ensure he is clear when shifting ground. <b>SILENCER</b> was obliged to race wide early stages, before being asked to improve forward. <b>DE NIRO</b> shifted out under pressure hampering <b>PARISDOTCON</b> which was steadied near the 50 metres. Rider S McKay was severely reprimanded by Stewards issued with a warning. Apprentice Rider R Elliot was spoken to regarding his riding tactics adopted aboard <b>SILENCER</b> with R Elliot explaining he had been asked to ride <b>SILENCER</b> in a forward position and after beginning fairly he then tried to ride the mare forward becoming trapped wide. <b>SILENCER</b> lost the right hind plate during the running.	
<b>Race 7</b>	<b>80's &amp; 90's Party @ Ellerslie 23<sup>rd</sup> April 1200</b>
Trainers L O'Sullivan and A Scott were issued with a warning after <b>FASCINATION STREET</b> was presented to race with incorrect gear. There was a delay to the start of the running of this event due to <b>STATHAM</b> requiring farrier attention at the start. There was a further delay due to <b>BLACK MASCARA</b> (T Thornton) being removed from the barriers after becoming awkwardly positioned then refusing to re-enter, being a late scratching at 3.45pm. The connections were advised that <b>BLACK MASCARA</b> will be required to barrier trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing next.	

**SHEZHARDOATCH** (L Satherley) was crowded when leaving the barriers, losing ground.  
**CAELLUM** (A Collett) began awkwardly.  
**AAJA NACHLE** (Z Nor Azman) was steadied passing the 1100 metres when in restricted room to the inside of **PROCUREMENT** (L Magorrian) which shifted in. L Magorrian was advised to exercise greater care.  
Approaching the 1000 metres **FASCINATION STREET** (S Collett) was steadied when racing in restricted room to the inside of **FULLY FUNDED** (BR Jones).  
**STATHAM** (G Cooksley) raced wide without cover throughout.  
**SHEZHARDOATCH** became awkwardly placed passing the 400 metres when attempting a run to the inside of **AAJA NACHLE** which shifted in simultaneously. **SHEZHARDOATCH** was then steadied and shifted to the outside of **AAJA NACHLE** to obtain clear running.  
**SPOKE TO CARLO** (L Innes) lay in when placed under pressure early in the final straight.  
**FULLY FUNDED** was briefly held up when looking to obtain clear running near the 200 metres.  
**PROCUREMENT** shifted out under pressure over the final 100 metres.

<b>Race 8</b>	<b>Mico 1600</b>

**DALEZINGA** (D Turner) began awkwardly.  
**NAILED IT** (L Satherley) became awkwardly placed on heels when the pace steadied passing the 1100 metres and shifted back on to **UNDISCOVERED** (G Cooksley) which had to shift off that runner's heels and was obliged to race three wide.  
**WAIPIPI LAD** (BR Jones) over-raced in the middle stages.  
When shifting out to obtain clear running approaching the 200 metres **SNOW SECRET** (B Hutton) made brief contact with **DALEZINGA** which shifted in slightly.

<b>Race 9</b>	<b>Auckland Co-op Taxis 1400</b>

**SISTERHOOD** (T Thornton) was crowded soon after leaving the barriers.  
**MIGHTY ME** (BR Jones) was slow to begin.  
**COHABITATE** (D Turner) was hampered when leaving the barriers.  
**ANNABELINDA** (S McKay) commenced to over-race when being steadied passing the 1200 metres and continued to race ungenerously through the middle stages.  
**OPERA KNIGHT** (R Elliot) over-raced for a distance passing the 1200 metres.  
**BONNY EMILIA** (G Cooksley) and **SISTERHOOD** both raced keenly through the middle stages.  
**YOUWANTMORE** (S Collett) raced ungenerously in the early and middle stages.  
**SISTERHOOD** was held up rounding the final turn and early in the final straight, shifting out passing the 200 metres to obtain clear running.  
**HEART OF TH'CASTLE** (A Collett) commenced to give ground appreciably when placed under pressure approaching the 400 metres with **HEART OF TH'CASTLE** then laying in passing the 350 metres simultaneously as **BITETHEBULLET** (L Magorrian) shifted in to avoid that runner's heels. As a result **BITETHEBULLET** shifted into the line of **ALL THE ANSWERS** (Z Moki) which clipped a heel and blundered and when recovering, then clipped a heel of **HEART OF TH'CASTLE** and blundered again. **HEART OF TH'CASTLE** was then eased down and underwent a veterinary examination following the race which found the filly to have suffered from cardiac arrhythmia with Trainer W Larsen being advised that he must provide a clear ECG for **HEART OF TH'CASTLE** following a trial.  
Following the race a veterinary examination of **BITETHEBULLET** revealed abrasions of the right hind cannon.  
**ALL THE ANSWERS** underwent a veterinary examination following the race which could find no abnormalities.  
**HEART OF TH'CASTLE** lost the right hind plate during the running.  
**BONNY EMILIA** lost the right front plate during the running.
