RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	STELLA ARTOIS 1400 (1400 metres)
<p>CASH (C Lammas) reared at the start after being fractious and began very awkwardly losing several lengths. Trainer Mr R McKenzie was advised that a warning would be placed against the gelding for its barrier manners.</p> <p>SERAPHIM (D Johnson) and WAIZ ONE (L Hemi) were slow away.</p> <p>Shortly after the start SUCHAPALAVA (D Turner) bumped with BLUSHING BELLE (M Cameron) and then in turn shifted out hampering the following runners MACROTH (M Hills), CALMBEFORETHESTORM (R Norvall) & MACHA (R Hannam).</p> <p>SUCHAPALAVA raced three wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>RUSTY IN MELBOURNE (S Johnson) was held up early in the final straight until obtaining clear running near the 200 metres.</p>	
Race 2	BEC, BRAD & RICHARD TURN 40 1300 (1300 metres)
<p>FAMILY SECRET (C Lammas) was slow away.</p> <p>KARAVALI (O Bosson) began awkwardly and got back.</p> <p>CAMINO ROCOSO (D Johnson) raced keenly when three wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>FAMILY SECRET and JACKSON ROAD (J Parkes) bumped near the 100 metres when FAMILY SECRET was angled outwards in search of a run.</p> <p>Over the final stages KARIOKKA (M Coleman) and BONNEVAL (M Cameron) bumped when KARIOKKA shifted out marginally.</p>	

J Parkes was reminded of his obligations with respect to his whip use prior to the 200 metres.	
Race 3	DUNSTAN FEEDS AUTUMN SPRINT SERIES QUALIFIER (1200 metres)
<p>JACKOFALL (J Riddell) began awkwardly unbalancing its rider losing ground.</p> <p>PROUD ZOE (D Bradley) shifted outwards abruptly at the start and in doing so hampered PADDY BOURKE (T Johnson).</p> <p>KONOHIKI (R Goldsbury) shifted outwards on jumping away tightening LYRIC'S WAY (H Tinsley) and CONJURING (Z Nor Azman).</p> <p>KONOHIKI raced three wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>WAY IN (O Bosson) was unable to obtain clear running for the majority of the final straight going to the line without being fully tested.</p>	
Race 4	NZB WEANLING, BROODMARE & MIXED BLOODSTOCK SALE 1300 (1300 metres)
<p>I'M BRONSON (C Lammas) shifted out abruptly after the start tightening TAIPA TIGER (M Coleman) and MAESTRO TOM (R Grant).</p> <p>MAESTRO TOM had to be steadied off the heels of DOCKET (J Riddell) shortly after the start when DOCKET shifted inwards when not clear. After questioning riders J Riddell was issued with a warning.</p> <p>MAESTRO TOM then commenced to over-race for some distance and made the first bend awkwardly shifting out forcing WHATZ OCCURRING (D MO) over extra ground.</p> <p>XCUSES XSUSES (M Du Plessis) over-raced in the early and middle stages.</p> <p>BELLE CADEAU (L Hemi) raced three wide without cover from near the 800 metres and failed to finish the race off. Rider L Hemi advised that after being three wide from the 800 metres the mare had little to offer at the finish. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a superficial cut to a hind leg.</p> <p>COURT IN THE ACT (D Bradley) lay in near the 300 metres becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of MISS DAISY and when being corrected shifted out and jostled NOTIONANNAGINS (R Hannam). COURT IN THE ACT was not persevered with after rider D Bradley considered something amiss with the gelding. A subsequent veterinary examination was clear.</p>	
Race 5	BETAVET 2500 (2500 metres)
<p>D Turner was unable to make the carded weight for DEZIGNATOR and was fined the sum of \$100. Due to there being no suitable rider D Turner was permitted by the stewards to ride DEZIGNATOR 1 kg over.</p> <p>SILK CHARDONNAY (R Grant) was tightened at the start and settled back.</p> <p>MENDOZA (C Lammas) had to steady shortly after the start when in restricted room.</p> <p>O'CEIRINS WHISPER (J Parkes) was slow away.</p> <p>VOLKSWOOD (D Mo) race three wide throughout and hung badly resulting in the bridle becoming displaced placing rider D Mo at a disadvantage.</p> <p>M Cameron (BLUE FLAG) was advised to exercise more care when he angled his mount out near the 800 metres forcing VOLKSWOOD over extra ground.</p> <p>TICKET CLIPPER (D Johnson) was held up for some distance early in the home straight.</p> <p>HEISTHEONE (C Johnson) required veterinary attention following the race after being galloped on during the running to the right hind leg.</p>	
Race 6	FASTTRACKINSURANCE HAWKE'S BAY GOLD CUP (2200 metres)
<p>CHENILLE (D Johnson) began awkwardly and settled back.</p> <p>MAYGROVE (M Cameron) had to be steadied off heels when racing keenly near the post on the first round and shifted outwards slightly crowding NYMPH MONTE onto the hind quarters of SILVERDALE (D Bradley).</p> <p>NYMPH MONTE (L Hemi) raced three wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>When questioned into the run of MAYGROVE rider M Cameron was of the opinion the 60kg carried proved detrimental to its chances after racing keenly early.</p> <p>M Coleman rider of GUARANTOR advised that the gelding may have got his tongue back and choked down during the running.</p> <p>Connections of KING KAMADA which finished back advised the gelding would be spelled.</p>	
Race 7	NZB FINANCE SPRINT (1200 metres)
<p>SPEECHCRAFT (D MO) blundered at the start unbalancing the rider.</p> <p>DESIGNATED DRIVER (R Hannam) over-raced in the back straight.</p> <p>NATUZZI (C Johnson) made the bend near the 800 metres awkwardly when over-racing.</p> <p>BARBARIC (J Riddell) had to be steadied when on heels approaching the 100 metres.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the run of SILVER ECLIPSE rider M Cameron had no real excuse other than the mare raced keenly in blinkers. Co trainer MS J Ritchie advised that the mare was likely to be spelled.</p>	
Race 8	BROKERWEB RISK SERVICES HB 1400 (1400 metres)
<p>SKYWKA (D Johnson) was a late scratching behind the barrier at 4.21pm on veterinary advice. Trainer T Pike was advised that the mare would require a clearance prior to racing again.</p> <p>LADY ZAFIRA (M Du Plessis) began awkwardly and lost ground.</p> <p>A short distance after the start SHEZGORGEIOUS (C Johnson) and COLONEL KEV (J Riddell) came together when racing in</p>	

restricted room between **MAE WEST** (R Hannam) and **CHARLESTOWN** (J Parkes) which both shifted ground.

LADY ZAFIRA had to be steadied off heels shortly after the start and in doing so got its head up and became unbalanced.

ONLYAROSE (R Grant) hung in approaching the 200 metres and when being corrected shifted out and hampered **COLONEL KEV** which was improving to its outside. **COLONEL KEV** then bumped with **CHARLESTOWN**.

Rider R Grant was advised to exercise greater care when in similar circumstances.

SHEZGORGEIOUS was held up in the early part of the home straight.
