RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	ANZAC MAIDEN (1200m)
SWEET TIME was hampered at the start and got back.	
KEEPITASECRET was inclined to get its head up when being restrained in the early stages.	

<p>WEEDY and RAPID RISE raced keenly in the early stages.</p> <p>WEEDY was held up for clear racing room in the early stages of the run home.</p> <p>BENS LASS was unbalanced when awkwardly placed on the heels of RAPID RISE and ELLERSTINA which was laying outwards near the 400 metres.</p> <p>FINAL SAY lay inwards at the 400 metres making contact with KEEPITASECRET.</p> <p>BONAPARTE was inclined to lay out over the concluding stages.</p>	
Race 2	SPEIGHT'S MID ALE RATING 75 (2000m)
<p>HI YO UGO was slow to begin.</p> <p>A BEAUTIFUL KNIGHT and COMMANDING OAK raced ungenerously when being restrained in the early stages.</p> <p>HI YO UGO raced keenly in the middle stages.</p> <p>GO GO GONZO raced ungenerously in the middle stages.</p> <p>ROSHEEN was held up for a short distance passing the 400 metres.</p> <p>COMMANDING OAK made contact with TAKE FIRE near the 175 metres, with TAKE FIRE being awkwardly placed on the heels of SOUTHERN RAIDER momentarily, having to shift wider to obtain clear running.</p> <p>T Direen (GO GO GONZO) was warned under Rule 638(3)(b)(i) for unnecessary use of the whip on a runner out of contention.</p>	
Race 3	RUDKIN RACING STABLES TWO-YEAR-OLD (1000m)
<p>STROWAN began awkwardly inconveniencing CHOUX MANIA.</p> <p>LA DIOSA began awkwardly and got back.</p> <p>DISTURBANCE was inclined to lay inwards in the early stages.</p> <p>DISTURBANCE was held up for some distance passing the 500 metres and made contact with WAIPARI LAD near the 450 metres, racing ungenerously for a short distance.</p> <p>HELLO SAILOR was held up for some distance near the 400 metres.</p> <p>LA DIOSA was held up for a short distance near the 200 metres when awkwardly placed on the heels of ZIGWIG.</p> <p>When spoken to regarding the performance of favoured runner DONTPOKETHETIGER, rider T Moseley advised that the filly felt indifferent in its action crossing the junction and failed to improve when placed under pressure.</p> <p>A post race veterinary inspection of DONTPOKETHETIGER including an Endoscopy revealed a superficial abrasion to the gums, mucous in the trachea and ulcers on arytenoid cartilages. Trainer P Rudkin undertook to keep Stewards informed of any developments in coming days.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the performance of CHOUX MANIA, rider S Wynne advised that the filly was unsuited to the tempo of the race but found the line well, and in her opinion would take natural improvement from today's race.</p>	
Race 4	HORNBY WORKING MEN'S CLUB OPEN HANDICAP (1200m)
<p>COUP DARCI BE began awkwardly and got back.</p> <p>EL CHICO was slow in the early stages.</p> <p>TOMA VALEA and BATMAN over raced in the early stages.</p> <p>KING MONTROSE lay out near the 300 metres and had to be straightened.</p> <p>A post race veterinary inspection of RIDING SHOTGUN did not reveal any obvious abnormalities.</p>	
Race 5	CHARLES BURRELL HAPPY 80TH BIRTHDAY RATING 65 (1400m)
<p>Apprentice J Lowry was warned under Rule 619(b) for changing gear after weighing out.</p> <p>FUGAWI shifted outwards on jumping hampering ADMIRAL ROUS.</p> <p>INIS ROSE bounded at the start and lost ground.</p> <p>BEAUTY ACE began awkwardly.</p> <p>JAKOB GAMBINO and OPERA KNIGHT made contact on jumping.</p> <p>STAR OF GREENBEEL raced keenly in the early stages.</p> <p>PATRICIO raced wide throughout.</p> <p>JAKOB GAMBINO (D Chin) improved forward to sit outside the leader near the 1100 metres</p> <p>PRINCE BRUNO commenced to over race passing the 1000 metres. PRINCE BRUNO and JAKOB GAMBINO raced some lengths in front of the field. Apprentice D Chin, in the presence of apprentice mentor W Harnett, was advised by the Stewards that he must show greater judgment when contesting the lead in future.</p> <p>ZIPPIN was not afforded clear running from the 350 metres and raced in restricted room until the 50 metres.</p> <p>OPIHI RANGER became awkwardly placed on heels near the 200 metres, shifting inwards near the 75 metres to obtain clear running.</p>	
Race 6	NEW ZEALAND BLOODSTOCK WARSTEP STAKES (2000m)
<p>MILLY QUE began awkwardly and got back.</p> <p>ALYTH raced fiercely in the early stages.</p> <p>MILLY QUE raced keenly and ungenerously in the early stages, proving difficult for apprentice rider R Cuneen to steer. The</p>	

connections were advised that a racing manners warning had been placed against **MILLY QUE**.

QUEEN SERENE raced wide throughout.

ALYTH continued to over race in the middle stages.

MILLY QUE raced wide from the 1500 metres.

POETIC AFFAIR (S Wynne) improved to sit outside the leader **GOODSAV** (L Allpress) near the 1500 metres. Passing the 1400 metres the pace was slowed excessively resulting in **DE CHINE, NO PUSHOVER, ALYTH, QUEEN SERENE, TWILIGHT REBEL** and **PRINCESS DAVONE** all over racing, and **LITTLE HAAST** having to be steadied and losing ground. Riders **L Allpress** and **S Wynne** were warned for slowing the pace excessively.

MILLY QUE was unbalanced near the 500 metres when awkwardly placed between **PRINCESS DAVONE** which shifted inwards and **POETIC AFFAIR** which shifted outwards. **QUEEN SERENE** was steadied in consequence.

DEEDEE PANACHE was held up for racing room throughout the run home.

TWILIGHT REBEL was not afforded complete clear running from the 350metres.

TWILIGHT REBEL was held up near the 150 metres when attempting a run to the inside of **NO PUSHOVER** and was hampered and unbalanced when **DEEDEE PANACHE** (T Moseley) attempted a marginal run to its' inside.

GOODSAV was unbalanced near the 100 metres when tiring, when contacted from the outside by **DEEDEE PANACHE** which had continued to jostle with **TWILIGHT REBEL**. **T Mosley** was warned under Rule 638(1)(d) for the manner in which he attempted to shift ground.

When questioned regarding the performance of winner **ALL IN VOGUE**, stable representatives advised that the filly had been suited to drawing wider and receiving an uninterrupted run throughout.

When questioned regarding the performance of **GOODSAV**, rider L Allpress reported that after working around the field early, in her opinion the filly had failed to see out the distance of today's race.

Race 7	NZ TAX REFUNDS RATING 65 (2000m)
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CLEM was slow to begin.

CANTINA began awkwardly and was further hampered after the start and got back.

FREIGHT TRAIN raced ungenerously in the early stages.

AMUN RA was steadied momentarily passing the 1700 metres when awkwardly placed on the inside of **DOUBLE TAP**.

BOOTYFUL raced wide in the early and middle stages.

FREIGHT TRAIN raced keenly in the middle stages.

FREIGHT TRAIN raced wide from the 1200 metres.

SUZERAIN over raced and was steadied near the 1000 metres, with the trailing **GALLANT BABE** also steadied.

GALLANT BABE was steadied again near the 900 metres.

MONTE CINTO was held up by the tiring **BOOTYFUL** near the 500 metres and had to be heavily restrained off heels.

SATIN GURU shifted inwards to obtain clear running near the 400 metres.

AMUN RA was placed in restricted room when **I'LLBEYOURPLATINUM** shifted inwards and away from the improving **CANTINA** near the 250 metres. **AMUN RA** was further held up when **FREIGHT TRAIN** lay outwards and forced **LA MUSIQUE** out onto **AMUN RA**.

LA MUSIQUE (S Wynne) shifted inwards near the 100 metres forcing **FREIGHT TRAIN** inwards onto **GALLANT BABE** which was steadied and buffeted against **LION ROCK HILL**. Apprentice rider **S Wynne** was advised to exercise greater care in future when shifting ground.

Race 8	COCA-COLA CANTERBURY GOLD CUP (2000m)
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NO EMOTION shifted in on jumping and dictated **MAYGROVE** onto **MISS THREE STARS** which was hampered.

FIVE KINGS began awkwardly and got back.

TIMY TYLER and **KAHARAU** raced keenly in the early stages.

REVELATOR raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

SCAPOLO over raced for some distance in the middle stages.

NO EMOTION over raced in the middle stages.

FIVE KINGS improved forward from the 1200 metres.**FIVE KINGS** raced wide from that point on.

NASHVILLE was held up for some distance entering the home straight.

NO EMOTION had to steady at the 500 metres when awkwardly placed to the inside of **MISS THREE STARS** and to the outside of **KAHARAU** which shifted outwards.

BENZINI was held up in the early stages of the run home and shifted ground outwards to obtain clear running, making contact with **REVELATOR** near the 400 metres.

BENZINI (R Myers) lay inwards passing the 100 metres and placed **MOTORBOAT MIKE** in restricted room near the 50 metres with **MOTORBIKE MIKE** having to steady. R Myers was reminded of her obligations when shifting ground.

SUREASYOUWEREBORN was not persevered with over the concluding stages, finishing a distant last. A post race veterinary inspection of **SUREASYOUWEREBORN** did not reveal any obvious abnormalities. Trainers N and B Blatch will be spoken to in coming days regarding their plans for **SUREASYOUWEREBORN**. The connections were advised that the mare must trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing next.

Apprentice **P Shaik** was warned under Rule 638 (3)(b)(i) for unnecessary use of the whip after the winning post.

Race 9	RACECOURSE HOTEL & MOTOR LODGE RATING 75 (1600m)
<p>BOOTS 'N' ALL was slow to begin.</p> <p>GOLD ALLURE and BRAH SPRING were hampered at the start when SECRET POWER shifted out.</p> <p>LIBETTO raced wide throughout.</p> <p>CARBIDE lay outwards at the 800 metres and had to be straightened.</p> <p>BOOTS 'N' ALL was held up momentarily passing the 500 metres.</p> <p>GOLD ALLURE was held up for racing room momentarily passing the 300 metres.</p> <p>BIG HOSS gave ground from the 300 metres, eventually finishing in last position. The connections were advised that the gelding must trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing next. The connections of BIG HOSS advised that the gelding would be retired from their stable as a racing proposition.</p> <p>BOOTS 'N' ALL (S Wynne) shifted in near the 250 metres and made firm contact with CARBIDE. BOOTS 'N' ALL continued on an inward movement severely checking CARBIDE and GOLD ALLURE. Apprentice S Wynne admitted a breach of Rule 638(1)(d), and after hearing all relevant submissions the JCA suspended her licence to ride at race meetings for 3 weeks effective 1 May to 22 May inclusive.</p>
