RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 Graeme Thomson Antique Jewellery 1600

HANDLES (T Wenn) began awkwardly and was slow away.

DAS BLUES (C Grylls) jumped away awkwardly before being further hampered and crowded losing ground.

HANDLES over-raced when being restrained near the 1200 metres. **DAS BLUES** then had to be steadied to avoid the heels of **HANDLES**.

NAMBASSA (S Spratt) shifted inwards away from **HIGH FINANCE** (G Cooksley) making contact with the hind quarters of **QUAALUP** (M Coleman) passing the 1000 metres.

HIGH FINANCE raced three wide without cover.

HOUGHTON (A Collett) shifted out under pressure making contact with **NAMBASSA** with that runner shifting away making contact with **DAS BLUES** forcing that runner wider on the track passing the 250 metres. **HOUGHTON** then continued to lay

out for the remainder of the race.

Race 2 AJC Members 2100

BE YOURSELF (Z Moki) jumped away awkwardly, getting its head up losing ground.

GOSHAWK (R Jones) over-raced in the early stages.

CENTILLY (A Collett) lay out rounding the turn near the 600 metres.

GOSHAWK had to be steadied when held up near the 500 metres and shifted inwards briefly crowding **READY TO RUMBLE** (A Sims).

KAURI MAN (U Holmquist) was held up until shifting in across heels to obtain clear running passing the 300 metres.

READY TO RUMBLE and FOUR DEGREES (S McKay) were held up early in the final straight.

SUPER MARIO (M Cameron) shifted outwards under pressure over the final 100 metres making slight contact with **FOUR DEGREES** just short of the finish.

When questioned into the performance of **BE YOURSELF** Rider Z Moki advised that the gelding had lay in throughout the race and had proved difficult to ride but could offer no other reason for the gelding's performance.

GOSHAWK lost the left hind plate during the running.

Race 3 Avondale Sunday Markets 2100

THENAMESBOND (Z Nor Azman) over-raced outside the leader in the early and middle stages.

DEVIANT MISS (A Collett) had to be firmly restrained passing the 1100 metres when awkwardly placed inside the heels of **MAASHKA** (H Moki).

THE SNOW QUEEN (M Cameron) shifted outwards near the 600 metres forcing **TIARA CONCERTO** (S Collett) over extra ground.

BOMBER JET (L Innes) was briefly held up early in the final straight.

MISS PARETO (E Smith) was held up near the 200 metres having to shift ground outwards to obtain clear running.

When questioned into the performance of **TIARA CONCERTO** Rider S Collett) advised that the mare was disappointing and was unable to offer any other reason. The trainer advised that the mare is likely to be spelled prior to racing again.

Race 4 Stewards 1200

L Innes, the rider of MONEY TRAIL, lost his whip when leaving the barriers.

BERNETTA (L Magorrian) and SHONALI (M Coleman) were slow away.

JANE BLONDE (S Collett) jumped away awkwardly before being further hampered by **ULYSSES** (T Thornton) which was taken outwards by **AUCTIONEER** (S McKay).

ITS OUR SHOWTIME (M Cameron) over-raced in the early and middle stages when racing greenly. When questioned Rider M Cameron advised that the filly may derive some benefit from today's race and was unable to offer any other reason.

Race 5 Mullins Tyres Pearl Series Fillies Classic

FULLY PUMPED (C Grylls) was declared a late scratching at 3.23pm after refusing to enter the barriers. Trainer Mr R Yuill was advised that **FULLY PUMPED** must barrier trial to the satisfaction of a Stipendiary Steward prior to racing next.

MISS PROTOCOL (S McKay) jumped away awkwardly.

SAVE THE STARS (L Magorrian) and SPINDLE (S Spratt) were slow away.

ONSTAGE (M Coleman) was buffeted between **GANGSTERS LASS** (B Hutton) and **PINCANTO** (M Cameron) shortly after leaving the barriers.

SPINDLE (S Spratt) raced three wide without cover.

IRISH MISSILE (A Collett) made the bend near the 900 metres awkwardly.

IRISH MISSILE lay out throughout the race and was unable to be fully ridden out in the final straight.

MYSTERY SHOW (L Innes) hung out around the bend passing the 600 metres and continued to in the final straight.

Race 6 Rosebank Business Association Governor General's Cup

SIERRA BEEL (A Schwerin) began awkwardly and shifted inwards abruptly hampering **LETMEBY** (S Collett) and inconveniencing **AL PACINO** (C Grylls).

IRISH GEM (S Spratt) jumped away awkwardly.

AL PACINO raced keenly outside the leader in the early to middle stages.

SIERRA BEEL raced three wide without cover throughout.

BANBURY LAD (A Collett) was held up early in the final straight and was unable to obtain clear running until near the 100 metres. When shifting outwards passing the 100 metres **BANBURY LAD** inconvenienced **LETMEBY**.

Race 7 Precinct Realty 1400

MEDICINE MAN (S Collett) and THE KAIHU KID (Z Moki) were slow away.

MIGHTY MAK (M Du Plessis) began awkwardly hampering ESPRIT DE CORPS (M Cameron) which lost ground.

NAKURU (T Thornton) began awkwardly hampering **O'CAROL** (M Coleman).

BRIGHT DIAMOND (A Schwerin) jumped away awkwardly and raced ungenerously in the early stages when being restrained.

NOVELTY (S Spratt) had to be firmly restrained when awkwardly placed inside the heels of **NINA ARORA** (L Tiley) which shifted in when not fully clear near the 1200 metres. Rider L Tiley was advised to exercise care when shifting ground. As a

result MIGHTY MAK (M Du Plessis) had to be firmly restrained and dropped back on to MEDICINE MAN which got its head up when being firmly restrained. **MEDICINE MAN** continued to over-race badly for the majority of the race.

BRIGHT DIAMOND had to be steadied off the heels of **MEDICINE MAN** passing the 1100 metres.

Passing the 800 metres MIGHTY MAK got its head up when being steadied making the bend awkwardly.

Passing the 500 metres NINA ARORA lay out until into the final straight.

Near the 400 metres NOVELTY was held up and when shifting out to obtain clear running hampered THEIA (A Collett) and then continuing to shift out made contact with ESPRIT DE CORPS which became badly unbalanced losing ground. Rider S Spratt admitted a breach of careless riding under Rule 638(1)(d) and was suspended from the conclusion of racing on 30 April 2016 up to and including racing on 14 May 2016, 5 riding days.
