Race 1	MILL REEF MAIDEN				
MASTER JACK underwent a veterinary examination behind the barrier after and was passed fit to run.					
AL HOCKING (D Turner) jumped out at the start and dictated the line of MASTER JACK (T Johnson) which shifted out					
hampering SHIRLEY'S SECRET (D Bradley) and SHAMADANCE (M Tanaka) which both settled back.					
TELL ME MORE (R Hannam) was slow away.					
MY MAGICIAN (H Andrew) had to be steadied going into the first bend and then shifted out off heels.					
MASTER JACK raced three-wide without cover throughout.					
H Andrew (MY MAGICIAN) and D Turner (AL HOCKING) were both reminded of their obligations with regard to their whip					
use prior to the 200 metres.					
Race 2	P&C INSURANCE 3YO MAIDEN				
AMORATA (R Myers) began awkwardly and was slow away					
DAMANAKA (J Riddell) was bumped at the start and settled back.					
PROSECCO (D Hirini) commenced to over-race near the 800 metres and had to be steadied for a short distance.					
SNOWDRIFT (L Allpress) was inclined to shift out under pressure over the final stages.					
A post-race veterinary inspection of POSH LASS (R Goldsbury) which faded in the final straight after leading up revealed no obvious abnormality					

Race 3

CARRFIELDS LIVESTOCK HANDICAP

IMPATIENT DREAMS (A Jones) was slow to begin.

CALL DOUBT (J Parkes) dropped out of contention near the 600 metres and finished a distant last. Rider **J Parkes** could offer not tangible excuse. A post-race veterinary examination revealed lameness in the right hind leg and an arrhythmia. Trainer **G Hayward** was advised the gelding must undergo a veterinary clearance including the results of an ECG before next racing.

Race 4

BLOODSTOCKAUCTION.COM HANDICAP

DREAM DANCER (D Turner) raced greenly in the home straight and bumped with MACHA (R Hannam) near the 250 metres.

TE TAIKA (L Allpress) became awkwardly placed in restricted room in the home straight and went to the line untested. **DEVON DOLL (D M**o) did not respond when placed under pressure early in the home straight and dropped out to finish last. **D Mo** reported that he felt **DEVON DOLL** was not breathing comfortably. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

Race 5 CARPET KING HANDICAP

WRITTEN COMMAND (D Mo) began very awkwardly and lost ground. MORSE CODE (M Tanaka) began awkwardly.

Race 6 POWER FARMING HANDICAP

RUNWAY (S Wyne) was slow to begin and settled back.

MERITAGGIO (L Allpress) over-raced in the early stages.

S Wynne reported that **RUNWAY** was never travelling well throughout after the mare compounded in the final straight and finished in last placing. A post-race veterinary examination of **RUNWAY** revealed reduced airflow in the left side nostril. Connections have been advised that the mare should be scoped before next racing.

Race 7 MANAWATU ITM ANZAC MILE - Listed

KINDALEICA (A Jones) jumped out at the start hampering THORN PRINCE (J Parkes) which lost ground and settled back. BEL SORRISO (R Hannam), GWYNETHANNE (D Hirini) and CHAMBORD (C Johnson) were slow to begin and settled back. D Bradley reported that PLATINUM WITNESS hung out from the 800 metres. A post-race veterinary examination revealed mild lameness in the right hind leg. Trainer L Latta was requested to report to the Stewards should anything become apparent over the coming days.

J Parkes reported that the track was too firm for THORN PRINCE.

Race 8 THE PAVEMASTERS HANDICAP

Rider L Satherley sought and was given permission to forgo her ride on **THATZ LOUIE** and was replaced by **S Wynne WINDERMERE LAD (R Goldsbury)** was slow to begin.

PLATINUM SONG (D Mo) blundered in its initial stride unbalancing the rider and losing ground.

GLADSTONE BELLE (K Smith) shifted in on jumping away as **CHOPPER (R Cuneen)** jumped out resulting in tightening to **ELUSIVE BOXERS (D Bradley)**.

ANGELINBLUEJEANS (J Riddell) raced three wide without cover throughout.

J Parkes admitted a charge of careless riding under Rule 638 (1) (d) in that he angled his mount **COPPER REIGN** out with approximately 500 metres to travel when not sufficiently clear of **GRAYZE ANATOMY (D Turner)** which was shifted out into the line of **ELUSIVE BOXERS (D Bradley)** which clipped the heel of that runner and dislodged the rider. After hearing all submission the JCA imposed a suspension from the close of racing today until the close of racing on 12th May (10 days). D Bradley was uninjured.

GRAYZE ANATOMY required veterinary attention to a hind leg.

Also hampered in this incident was CHOPPER which had to take evasive action to avoid ELUSIVE BOXERS.
