## RACE COMMENTS:

<b>Race 1</b>	<b>MILL REEF MAIDEN</b>
<p><b>MASTER JACK</b> underwent a veterinary examination behind the barrier after and was passed fit to run.</p> <p><b>AL HOCKING (D Turner)</b> jumped out at the start and dictated the line of <b>MASTER JACK (T Johnson)</b> which shifted out hampering <b>SHIRLEY'S SECRET (D Bradley)</b> and <b>SHAMADANCE (M Tanaka)</b> which both settled back.</p> <p><b>TELL ME MORE (R Hannam)</b> was slow away.</p> <p><b>MY MAGICIAN (H Andrew)</b> had to be steadied going into the first bend and then shifted out off heels.</p> <p><b>MASTER JACK</b> raced three-wide without cover throughout.</p> <p><b>H Andrew (MY MAGICIAN)</b> and <b>D Turner (AL HOCKING)</b> were both reminded of their obligations with regard to their whip use prior to the 200 metres.</p>	
<b>Race 2</b>	<b>P&amp;C INSURANCE 3YO MAIDEN</b>
<p><b>AMORATA (R Myers)</b> began awkwardly and was slow away</p> <p><b>DAMANAKA (J Riddell)</b> was bumped at the start and settled back.</p> <p><b>PROSECCO (D Hirini)</b> commenced to over-race near the 800 metres and had to be steadied for a short distance.</p> <p><b>SNOWDRIFT (L Allpress)</b> was inclined to shift out under pressure over the final stages.</p> <p>A post-race veterinary inspection of <b>POSH LASS (R Goldsbury)</b> which faded in the final straight after leading up revealed no obvious abnormality</p>	

<b>Race 3</b>	<b>CARRFIELDS LIVESTOCK HANDICAP</b>
<p><b>IMPATIENT DREAMS (A Jones)</b> was slow to begin.</p> <p><b>CALL DOUBT (J Parkes)</b> dropped out of contention near the 600 metres and finished a distant last. Rider <b>J Parkes</b> could offer not tangible excuse. A post-race veterinary examination revealed lameness in the right hind leg and an arrhythmia. Trainer <b>G Hayward</b> was advised the gelding must undergo a veterinary clearance including the results of an ECG before next racing.</p>	
<b>Race 4</b>	<b>BLOODSTOCKAUCTION.COM HANDICAP</b>
<p><b>DREAM DANCER (D Turner)</b> raced greenly in the home straight and bumped with <b>MACHA (R Hannam)</b> near the 250 metres.</p> <p><b>TE TAIKA (L Allpress)</b> became awkwardly placed in restricted room in the home straight and went to the line untested.</p> <p><b>DEVON DOLL (D Mo)</b> did not respond when placed under pressure early in the home straight and dropped out to finish last. <b>D Mo</b> reported that he felt <b>DEVON DOLL</b> was not breathing comfortably. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormality.</p>	
<b>Race 5</b>	<b>CARPET KING HANDICAP</b>
<p><b>WRITTEN COMMAND (D Mo)</b> began very awkwardly and lost ground.</p> <p><b>MORSE CODE (M Tanaka)</b> began awkwardly.</p>	
<b>Race 6</b>	<b>POWER FARMING HANDICAP</b>
<p><b>RUNWAY (S Wyne)</b> was slow to begin and settled back.</p> <p><b>MERITAGGIO (L Allpress)</b> over-raced in the early stages.</p> <p><b>S Wynne</b> reported that <b>RUNWAY</b> was never travelling well throughout after the mare compounded in the final straight and finished in last placing. A post-race veterinary examination of <b>RUNWAY</b> revealed reduced airflow in the left side nostril. Connections have been advised that the mare should be scoped before next racing.</p>	
<b>Race 7</b>	<b>MANAWATU ITM ANZAC MILE - Listed</b>
<p><b>KINDALEICA (A Jones)</b> jumped out at the start hampering <b>THORN PRINCE (J Parkes)</b> which lost ground and settled back.</p> <p><b>BEL SORRISO (R Hannam), GWYNETHANNE (D Hirini)</b> and <b>CHAMBORD (C Johnson)</b> were slow to begin and settled back.</p> <p><b>D Bradley</b> reported that <b>PLATINUM WITNESS</b> hung out from the 800 metres. A post-race veterinary examination revealed mild lameness in the right hind leg. Trainer <b>L Latta</b> was requested to report to the Stewards should anything become apparent over the coming days.</p> <p><b>J Parkes</b> reported that the track was too firm for <b>THORN PRINCE</b>.</p>	
<b>Race 8</b>	<b>THE PAVEMASTERS HANDICAP</b>
<p>Rider <b>L Satherley</b> sought and was given permission to forgo her ride on <b>THATZ LOUIE</b> and was replaced by <b>S Wynne</b></p> <p><b>WINDERMERE LAD (R Goldsbury)</b> was slow to begin.</p> <p><b>PLATINUM SONG (D Mo)</b> blundered in its initial stride unbalancing the rider and losing ground.</p> <p><b>GLADSTONE BELLE (K Smith)</b> shifted in on jumping away as <b>CHOPPER (R Cuneen)</b> jumped out resulting in tightening to <b>ELUSIVE BOXERS (D Bradley)</b>.</p> <p><b>ANGELINBLUEJEANS (J Riddell)</b> raced three wide without cover throughout.</p> <p><b>J Parkes</b> admitted a charge of careless riding under Rule 638 (1) (d) in that he angled his mount <b>COPPER REIGN</b> out with approximately 500 metres to travel when not sufficiently clear of <b>GRAYZE ANATOMY (D Turner)</b> which was shifted out into the line of <b>ELUSIVE BOXERS (D Bradley)</b> which clipped the heel of that runner and dislodged the rider. After hearing all submission the JCA imposed a suspension from the close of racing today until the close of racing on 12<sup>th</sup> May ( 10 days). <b>D Bradley</b> was uninjured.</p> <p><b>GRAYZE ANATOMY</b> required veterinary attention to a hind leg.</p> <p>Also hampered in this incident was <b>CHOPPER</b> which had to take evasive action to avoid <b>ELUSIVE BOXERS</b>.</p>
