SATIN JITTERBU	G began awkwardly making contact with ONCE A KNIGHT.				
ONCE A KNIGHT	over raced in the middle stages.				
ST MALO raced	wide when attempting to improve forward from the 1000 metres.				
ONCE A KNIGHT	made the bend awkwardly crowding SATIN JITTERBUG onto LOCALLY SAUCED near the 600 metres.				
DREAM DIVINE	was held up near the 400 metres and when improving into a marginal run shortly after forced ST MALO				
over extra grou	nd. SATIN JITTERBUG and CONSOLIDATE were both also taken wider as a result.				
ANCIENT lay in i	n the early stages of the home straight.				
When questione	ed regarding the performance of SWEET INDULGENCE rider M Cameron was unable to offer any excuses				
other than in his	opinion the mare possibly feeling the effects of recent racing. A post-race veterinary examination did not				
reveal any obvio	bus abnormality.				
Race 2	M SUGAR LTD RATING 80 2200M				
COMMANDING	OAK lay outwards rounding the bend from the 800 metres and continued to lay out into the final straight				
making contact	with OOR WULLIE on several occasions.				
Apprentice P Sh	aikh (COMMANDING OAK) dropped his whip near the 600 metres.				
When questione	ed regarding the performance of CLAREVILLE FLIGHT apprentice K Kalychurun advised that the mare is				
better suited to	more rain affected footing.				
Race 3	SPORTS CENTRAL BREWHOUSE RATING 80 1400M				
RIC O'SHEA knu	ckled leaving the barriers losing ground.				

TOMM JONES shifted outwards to obtain clear running rounding the turn near the 350 metres making contact with **TERELLE** which was unbalanced. Apprentice G Jogoo was advised to exercise greater care.

TOMM JONES lay inwards in the final straight.

M Cameron was unable to offer any excuses for the performance of **FLIRTY GERTEY** other than the increased weight carried today. Co-trainer Mr J Richards advised that there would now be consideration given to retiring the mare.

Race 4 BRACKENS PRINT LTD MAIDEN 1200M

LIZZIE BORDON was declared a late scratching at 12.09 pm on veterinary advice as it was showing signs of lameness in the right hind leg requiring veterinary treatment.

Trainer Mr K James was issued with a warning under Rule 616(2) after failing to notify an item of gear for **PICKUP** by the required time.

KWEZI and SUGGESTIVE LOOX were slow away.

BERNIE RULES lay in shortly after leaving the barriers forcing **BLACK ESTATE** across the heels of **RAPID RISE** with **BLACK ESTATE** having to be steadied.

BENS LASS raced wide without cover.

PICKUP was steadied near the 800 metres going back onto MORRIE MAC which also had to steady.

RAPID RISE lay out rounding the bend.

BLACK ESTATE shifted outwards under pressure in the final straight inconveniencing **RAPID RISE** near the 150 metres. **FLYING SARDINE** lay out early in the home straight.

Following this race the track was downgraded to Slow(7).

Race 5 MACKENZIE SUPPLIES LTD RATING 65 1200M

TAPPY'S BEST was a late scratching on veterinary advice at 1.42 pm after rearing and becoming cast in the barriers. Cotrainer Mr I Taplin was advised that **TAPPY'S BEST** must now barrier trial to the satisfaction of the Stipendiary Stewards prior to racing next. Mr Taplin indicated that **TAPPY'S BEST** was unlikely to be persevered with as a racing proposition. **ELUSIVE BOXERS** which was in an adjacent barrier stall was removed to undergo a veterinary inspection before being passed fit to run.

POP HIT, TWICKENHAM and **ELUSIVE BOXERS** were slow to begin. When attempting to recover from its poor beginning **TWICKENHAM** became awkwardly placed on the heels of **SHESELUSIVE** then having to be checked going into the bend near the 1000 metres. **FINAL SAY** raced ungenerously when being steadied near the 1000 metres.

EL BEE DARCI raced three wide without cover.

CELTIC CROSS had a tendency to lay inwards when struck with the whip in the final straight.

M Cameron was unable to offer any excuses for the performance of **LOVE ACTUALLY**. **LOVE ACTUALLY** underwent a veterinary inspection which did not reveal any abnormality.

Rider T Direen reported that **SHESELUSIVE** had felt sore on pulling up. **SHESELUSIVE** underwent a veterinary examination which revealed the mare had sustained a suspected ligamentous or tendinous injury requiring veterinary treatment. Trainer Mr S Tyler was advised that a veterinary certificate of fitness would be required prior to **SHESELUSIVE** racing again.

Race 6 OLT – SUPPORTING THE OAMARU COMMUNITY MAIDEN 1600M

CAPER CALEB was slow to begin.

AREYOUWITHME raced ungenerously when being restrained in the early and middle stages.

PACO RABANNE raced three wide without cover.

Following this race the track was further downgraded to Slow(8).

Race 7 SPIVEY AC REAL ESTATE MAIDEN 1600M

APACHE KID was slow away.

MYSTIC POWER raced ungenerously for a distance passing the 1200 metres.

FUN FAIR was steadied when becoming awkwardly placed inside the heels of **DONT ARGUE** passing the 600 metres. **FUN FAIR** then shifted outwards across the heels of the weakening **DONT ARGUE** forcing **RED TEMPEST** wider on the track.

Race 8 MCKEOWN GROUP LTD RATING 65 1600M

ROYAL DOLLAR began awkwardly and got back.

TELL THE WORLD was slow to begin.

SLICK NICKEL was crowded shortly after jumping away losing ground.

HIGH VIZ was held up rounding the turn passing the 500 metres behind the weakening **JEAN'S WAY** and could not obtain clear running until near the 300 metres.

ROYAL DOLLAR was inclined to shift ground under pressure in the final straight.

S Muniandy rider of **SHANZOU** reported that the gelding had not felt comfortable in today's track conditions.

Race 9 CROMBIE & PRICE LTD 65 1600M

AVOW, FRANCONI and GOLDEN CASTLE were slow to begin.

MIDNIGHT CAPPA and **PACIFIC TAP** raced keenly in the early stages with **PACIFIC TAP** continuing to over-race into the middle stages.

Rider M Cameron was unable to offer any excuses for the poor performance of **OUR DRAHMA QUEEN**.
