RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	EGMONT WANGANUI HUNT MAIDEN 1400
DES DE JEU was a late scratching at 10.55am on veterinary advice. BLACK SOX began awkwardly losing ground. DANDEEDEE and ALL IN GLAMOUR were both slow to begin. BLACK SOX commenced to race ungenerously when being steadied in the early stages. GLENGOYNE raced wide without cover throughout. ISHINKTAATLEDO raced in restricted room making brief contact with GLENGOYNE approaching the 200 metres.	
Race 2	ULTRA SCAN MAIDEN 1200
STU was slow to begin. SOPHIA GRACE and THIRTYLOVE both began awkwardly losing ground. LOVETOKEEPHIM knuckled when leaving the barrier. FOXY POROTENE raced ungenerously when being restrained in the early to middle stages. LUCYINRIO made the bend awkwardly running wide making contact with VERGARA which was pushed wider on the track. HOTSHOT LASS had to change ground near the 100 metres to obtain clear running.	
Race 3	MITAVITE 1200

HOVER began awkwardly losing ground and was crowded shortly after.
MALACANTO was crowded when leaving the barriers and steadied.
SMOKE HOUSE BAY had to be eased off the heels of **STUMBLIN IN** near the 800 metres and when being steadied shifted in hampering **BISOU BISOU** and **ZANOTTI**.
HOVER made the bend awkwardly.
E Rayner reported that **RUSHIN** which finished some distance last would be retired.

Race 4 | **BRUCE CLIFTON BUILDING SERVICES MAIDEN 1650**

BELLE ZED dislodged Rider K McCulloch during the preliminary. Rider K McCulloch was uninjured. **BELLE ZED** then underwent a veterinary examination at the barrier and was passed fit to race.
CONFLAGRATION was removed from the barrier and underwent a veterinary examination after becoming fractious in its gate and was declared fit to run.
SKUFFLE blundered leaving the barrier.
MASTER PATRICK and **PICCOLO** were both slow to begin.
CONFLAGRATION was under pressure passing the 800 metres and was not persevered with in the home straight. A subsequent veterinary examination found the filly to be slightly lame in the near fore leg with a superficial abrasion.

Race 5 | **CLARENDON HOTEL 1650**

BETTER KEEPER began awkwardly losing ground but quickly recovered.
MISCHIEVOUS MIS raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.
CASSIE ANNE shifted out to obtain clearly running passing the 250 metres.

Race 6 | **LISA ALLPRESS THANKING ALL HER LOYAL SUPPORTERS 1650**

ONE OF THREE was crowded and steadied shortly after leaving the barrier to the inside of **EN SUITE** (K McCulloch) which shifted in. Rider K McCulloch was reprimanded by stewards and advised she must exercise greater care.
RANGATIRA raced in restricted room going into the first bend.

Race 7 | **FARM SOURCE 1650**

HAMILTONIAN, **SIR MANAWA** and **SILVER COURT** were slow to begin.
A RED PRINCE raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

Race 8 | **TOM ANDREWS CONTRACTING 2200**

SHARE THE BLAME was restrained leaving the barrier, settling back.
BAD BOY BROWN began awkwardly.
HARE BAWL was slow to begin.
When questioned regarding the performance of **HARE BAWL** Rider D Bradley advised the gelding had not been suited by today's track conditions which he described as holding.
R Myers was questioned regarding the performance of **BAD BOY BROWN** advising the gelding may not have been entirely comfortable in today's track conditions. **BAD BOY BROWN** underwent a veterinary examination which could not find any obvious abnormalities. Trainer K Zimmerman further reported that **BAD BOY BROWN** had been coughing consistent with having swallowed a clod of earth.

Race 9 | **SANDFORDS MAIDEN 2200**

MAX was slow to begin and then was further hampered.
RAISING PENNY began awkwardly losing ground.
ENTREAT was crowded shortly after leaving the barrier.
THE GREAT GURU made the crossing awkwardly near the 1,700 metres and blundered.
HARD TO BE HUMBLE was held up rounding the final turn obtaining clear running approaching the 300 metres.
