RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	SAFEWISE 1200
<p>INFINITE CHOICE (M Coleman) began awkwardly.</p> <p>ONSTAGE (L Satherley), DALLAS (S Spratt) and WONDER WOMAN (L Allpress) were all crowded leaving the barriers with DALLAS and WONDER WOMAN losing ground.</p> <p>MONGOLIAN LEGEND (M Cameron) had to be steadied to avoid the heels of IMPULSIVE HABIT (T Thornton) near the 1000 metres.</p> <p>INFINITE CHOICE commenced to over-race near the 1000 metres then having to be firmly restrained to avoid the heels of ONSTAGE.</p> <p>BELLA GIOIA (S Weatherley) raced three wide without cover.</p>	
Race 2	GARRARD'S HORSE AND HOUND 1400
<p>LEEDS (S McKay) began awkwardly.</p> <p>BISHOPBRIGGS (L Allpress) was a little slow to begin.</p> <p>MAESTRO TOM (S Spratt) began awkwardly bumping PLAYBOY PRINCE (B R Jones) which then lay out away from that runner crossing the junction onto the course proper.</p> <p>CONRWIN (A Schwerin) and BISHOPBRIGGS raced ungenerously approaching the 800 metres when the pace steadied.</p> <p>PLAYBOY PRINCE and ZORRALI (Z Moki) raced wide without cover.</p> <p>MAESTRO TOM had to be steadied when awkwardly placed on the heels of PLAYBOY PRINCE near the 350 metres.</p>	
Race 3	SKYCITY HAMILTON 1400
<p>ELUSIVE GOLD (M Cameron) raced a little ungenerously in the middle stages.</p> <p>SALAMANCA (K McCulloch) lay out inconveniencing OHOPE PRINCE (B R Jones) near the 350 metres.</p>	
Race 4	ALLIED SECURITY 2100
<p>BRAD THORN (S McKay) began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p>KING NERO (U Holmquist), REKA (S Weatherley) and SIR ELMO (C Lammas) all raced in restricted room approaching the 2000 metres to the inside of COLONEL CARRERA (L Allpress) which shifted in slightly.</p>	

COLONEL CARRERA clipped a heel of JOCHEN RINDT (S Spratt) and blundered near the 1700 metres when crowded for room between JOCHEN RINDT which shifted outwards marginally when being steadied away from the heels of LANDLORD (T Thornton), and KING NERO which lay in.	
Race 5	PRINT HOUSE 1200
<p>MACKENZIE KATE (T Thornton), ARCTURUS (M Cameron) and FREEWHEELER (Z Moki) were crowded leaving the barriers with FREEWHEELER making contact with the hind quarters of ANY GLORY (S Weatherley) unbalancing that runner with ARCTURUS and FREEWHEELER losing ground.</p> <p>SCOOTER O'REILLY (C Lammas) began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p>WHO DARES WINS (S Spratt) raced ungenerously when making the bend near the 900 metres.</p> <p>ANY GLORY raced ungenerously rounding the bend near the 800 metres.</p> <p>ANY GLORY lost the right hind plate during the running.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the poor performance of ANY GLORY which was eased down over the final 250 metres, apprentice S Weatherley advised that the filly had made abnormal breathing noises. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormality other than having pulled a plate.</p>	
Race 6	DUNSTAN FEEDS 1600
<p>BACHRO (S McKay) was slow to begin.</p> <p>JASMINE MAREE (M Coleman) shifted inwards abruptly leaving the barriers hampering BLACKHAVEN (R Elliot).</p> <p>THREE KINGDOMS (T Thornton) was crowded at the start.</p> <p>BALLERINE (S Weatherley) over-raced when being steadied in the early and middle stages.</p> <p>DANIECE (U Holmquist) lay in having to be steadied away from the heels of THE HEAT IS ON (C Lammas) near the 1200 metres.</p> <p>BALLERINE raced wide without cover.</p> <p>DANIECE was briefly held up near the 350 metres.</p> <p>BELLA BLUE (L Magorrian) lay in under pressure in the final straight.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the performance of SUGGESTIONS rider L Allpress was unable to offer any excuses other than in her opinion the filly not seeing out the 1600 metre distance of today's race.</p> <p>Apprentice S Weatherley the rider of BALLERINE advised that after over-racing in the open the filly had been unable to finish the race off when placed under pressure in the final straight.</p>	
Race 7	FAIRVIEW MOTORS 1600
<p>NAILED IT (M Coleman) and MISS ELEGANTE (C Lammas) both began awkwardly and came together losing ground.</p> <p>IRRESISTABELLE (Z Moki) began awkwardly.</p> <p>PROMISES (L Allpress) raced keenly through the middle stages.</p> <p>PROMISES and OPULENT (M Cameron) came together near the 350 metres.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the performance of SORORIA rider S McKay advised that the mare had not felt entirely comfortable in today's conditions, and in his opinion would be better suited by deeper track conditions.</p> <p>FLANDERS (T Thornton) returned to the enclosure with blood present in the left nostril. After undergoing an endoscopic examination it was established that FLANDERS had not bled from the lungs so is not classified as a bleeder.</p>	
Race 8	J SWAP 1400
<p>The start was delayed due to HEEZA DREIMER (T Wenn) requiring farrier attention after casting a plate in the back parade ring.</p> <p>HEEZA DREIMER, TAVIS STAR (H Noorman), BEACH BEAUTY (S Saejorhor) and MANDALAY (C Lammas) all began awkwardly losing ground with TAVIS STAR stumbling shortly after jumping away.</p> <p>ROCKET QUEEN (L Magorrian) was slow to begin.</p> <p>MANDALAY raced ungenerously for a distance passing the 1000 metres.</p> <p>HEEZA DREIMER commenced to over-race near the 900 metres then making the bend near the 850 metres awkwardly hampering BEACH BEAUTY.</p> <p>Also near the 850 metres JOUET CUVÉE (S Spratt) lay in on the point of the bend crowding KEEP ON COMING (L Allpress) onto PENTIRE BABE (T Thornton) which was forced inwards resulting in TAVIS STAR having to be steadied near the 800 metres when crowded for room between PENTIRE BABE and HEEZA DREIMER which shifted outwards when continuing to make the bend awkwardly.</p> <p>TAVIS STAR lost both front plates during the running.</p>	
Race 9	TE RAPA NEW WORLD 1400
<p>ROSEANA'S SPIRIT (S McKay) began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p>MAREEBA (Z Nor Azman), BROWN GIRL (L Allpress) and BUBBLEBUBBLE POP (D Prastiyau) came together leaving the barriers with BUBBLEBUBBLE POP then shifting outwards crowding NO NEED (V Gatu) onto DOUBTLESS PRINCESS (R Elliot) which had shifted inwards leaving the barriers. BROWN GIRL, BUBBLEBUBBLE POP, NO NEED and DOUBTLESS PRINCESS all continued to come together for a distance with BUBBLEBUBBLE POP and NO NEED being severely crowded. The saddle on BUBBLEBUBBLE POP shifted backwards in this incident placing rider D Prastiyau at a disadvantage.</p>	

JACQUI ICKX (S Spratt) and **BROWN GIRL** came together near the 1200 metres when **BROWN GIRL** shifted away from **BLACKBIRD** (L Magorrian). **MAREEBA** which was following **BROWN GIRL** then shifted outwards to avoid that runner's heels forcing **NO NEED** wider on the track.

Passing the 1200 metres **BUBBLEBUBBLE POP** shifted outwards abruptly hampering **DOUBTLESS PRINCESS**.

BROWN GIRL, **MAREEBA** and **IFFITEL** (T Thornton) all over-raced in the middle stages approaching the bend near the 800 metres.

BUBBLEBUBBLE POP was eased down in the final straight finishing a distant last. **BUBBLEBUBBLE POP** underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

M Cameron reported that his mount **ARANMORE** had felt indifferent in its action. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormality. Trainer Mr R James was advised to report anything that may become apparent in days subsequent.

Race 10	WEALLEANS 2100

ANGEL IN BLUEJEANS (K McCulloch) and **BEE TEE JUNIOR** (L Allpress) began awkwardly severely crowding **SO TRUE** (S McKay) which lost ground. **BEE TEE JUNIOR** which was unbalanced when making contact with **SO TRUE** was further hampered by **DOMEROVA** (R Elliot) which shifted inwards leaving the barriers.

CAN YOU HEAR ME (L Magorrian) and **BUGLE CALL** (M Cameron) both over-raced when being restrained approaching the 1800 metres.

BUGLE CALL shifted outwards under pressure crowding **BEE TEE JUNIOR** on to **TWILIGHT OFFER** (T Thornton) near the 300 metres.

TWINKLES (M Coleman) was inclined to lay in under pressure in the final straight inconveniencing **NINA ARORA** (A Collett).
