RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	HAWKE'S BAY HUNT MAIDEN HURDLE (2500 metres)
<p>SKYSCRAPER (D Miller) raced keenly in the early and middle stages. When questioned rider D Miller advised the gelding had little left at the finish after racing keenly and hitting two fences in the back straight.</p> <p>YARDSTICK (S Karnicnik) landed awkwardly at the second last fence.</p> <p>HE'S DAN (S Phelan) hung rounding the final turn placing the rider at a disadvantage and did not complete the course. Rider M Gillies reported WIGGLE jumped indifferently throughout but should take natural improvement with the run.</p>	
Race 2	CHELTENHAM 2017 WITH WHEELS MAIDEN HURDLE (2500 metres)
<p>RUNNY HONEY (A Kuru) jumped away awkwardly hampering PLATINUM SONG (I Lupton) which settled back.</p> <p>JEDI KNIGHT (D Miller) fell at the fence near 1300 metres. RED MAFIA (M Mitchell) was unable to avoid the fallen runner and was brought down. Both riders were attended to by paramedics and cleared to fulfil their remaining engagements. Also affected in the incident was JACK'S BOY (M Gillies) which was hampered.</p> <p>JEDI KNIGHT fractured its near front leg and was humanly euthanised.</p> <p>Rider H McNeill (MASTER THOMAS) dropped his whip after jumping the third last fence.</p>	
Race 3	TE WHANGAI ROMNEYS HAWKE'S BAY HURDLE (3100 metres)
<p>GAGARIN (M Gillies) and WEE BISKIT (M Cropp) were slow away and settled back.</p> <p>NGATIRA GOLD (K Walters) hit the fence near the 1300 metres.</p> <p>JUST ISHI dislodged rider G WALSH at the fence near the 1000 metres. G Walsh was uninjured.</p> <p>NGATIRA GOLD hit the fence hard flattening the panel at the 600 metres.</p>	

O OEE (A Kuru) and JUST GOT HOME (E Farr) had to momentarily steady to avoid the riderless horse immediately prior to jumping the second last fence.	
SAN PEDRO (S Fannin) slipped behind losing momentum after jumping the last fence.	
Race 4	BIRCHLEIGH POLO CLUB AMATEUR (2100 metres)
VICTORIA HEIGHTS (H Cushing) was slow to begin.	
KING SAMBO (A McDonald) commenced to over-race in the home straight the first time near the 100 metres and when being steadied shifted out simultaneously as OURS (J Reid) shifted in. This resulted in tightening to ASCOMANNI (M Northcott) which was buffeted for several strides, which when being corrected shifted out dictating EPINEAUX (C Myers) outwards into the line of KINGIESSTAR (B Rogerson) which clipped that runners heels and blundered.	
A short distance further KING SAMBO again shifted outwards when being restrained resulting in DAL DUNVEGAN (A Wallace) being tightened.	
EPINEAUX had to change ground to improve near the 150 metres.	
Race 5	TARADALE CLUB 2100 (2100 metres)
BEL SORRISO (J Parkes) began awkwardly.	
DANZA LAD (K Smith) raced keenly in the early and middle stages.	
Race 6	JUST A SWAGGER HAWKE'S BAY HUNT MAIDEN CHASE (4000 metres)
BANTENEIGHTY (G Walsh) ran down its fences badly losing ground throughout.	
KANGAROO (S Fannin) fell at the fence near the 1400 metres.	
SIR AL SYD (D Miller) was unable to avoid the fallen runner and dislodged rider D Miller who required medical treatment. D Miller was stood down for his remaining ride and was taken to hospital with a possible fractured collar bone.	
MENDOZA (S Karnicnik) and PUDDLE ALLEY (M McNelis) both lost considerable ground when attempting to avoid the fallen runner.	
Rider S Fannin when regaining his feet, was hit and knocked to the ground by PUDDLE ALLEY .	
BEFOREUNOIT (M Gillies) put in a poor jump at the fence near the 800 metres and fell.	
AL MUNROE (H McNeill) was unable to avoid the fallen runner and was brought down. M Gillies was injured and was stood down for his remaining ride. Rider H McNeill was uninjured.	
BEFOREUNOIT incurred a hematoma in the incident and connections were advised that the gelding will need a clearance prior to next racing.	
Race 7	ANIMAL HEALTH DIRECT HAWKE'S BAY STEEPLECHASE (4800 metres)
STRAIGHT FURROW (S Phelan) put in a poor jump at the first fence in the straight on the second round.	
THE FOX (E Farr) put in a poor jump at the fence near the 900 metres when tiring.	
When questioned into the disappointing run of I'VE GOT THIS rider S Fannin said the gelding jumped indifferently throughout and was generally disappointing. A subsequent veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality.	
Race 8	BAY FORD NZ PUNTER OF THE YEAR OCTOBER 1ST 1400 (1400 metres)
ELAMO (N Teeluck) was slow away after being tightened.	
ABSOLUTELY PEACHES (E Smith) was slow away.	
ELAMO made the first bend awkwardly.	
RAZZLE DAZZLE MAN (J Bassett) made the home turn four wide without cover.	
PROSECCO (R Myers) had to change ground near the 200 metres when both PRAISE DAN (K Smith) and OOPS TOMMY (D Bradley) shifted ground.	
K Smith (PRAISE DAN) was reminded of his obligations to ride his mounts out fully to the line should circumstances permit. On this occasion stewards were satisfied his finishing position was not compromised.	
Race 9	FASTTRACKINSURANCE 1400 (1400 metres)
STRATOSPHERE (D Bradley) jumped outwards hampering KITTYKITTYBANGBANG (M Pos).	
KININMONT (R Hannam) was slow to begin	
PRO FUMO (N Senari) was held up for a short distance approaching the 200 metres and had to be angled outwards to improve.	
TOULOUSE (R Goldsbury) was inclined to lay out under pressure throughout the home straight.	
MAGNIFICENT TIME (R Myers) was unable to take advantage of a run near the 200 metres so was then angled out to improve.	
Race 10	WAIROA WANDERERS 1400 (1400 metres)
THE BOUNCER (J Bassett) underwent a veterinary inspection at the start and was cleared to start after hitting the parade ring rail on two occasions when fractious.	
SCAMP (E Smith) raced wide without cover throughout.	
IRISH CALL (S Wynne) shifted in near the 200 metres resulting in ASTRID (R Myers) and SULTAN OF SWING (J Parkes) being dictated inwards. This resulted in FIGURAC (M Tanaka) having to steady off the heels of SULTAN OF SWING . M Tanake advised that FIGURAC was under pressure to maintain its position some distance out and would expect the gelding to take natural improvement with the run.	

E Smith (**SCAMP**) was shown footage of her ride and was advised that she is expected to straighten her mount sooner than she did on this occasion after she allowed her mount to shift in tightening **WHATWEDO** (E Farr) and **LUCKY FEATHER** (D Danis) near the 200 metres.

OLIVIA MARY (T Johnson) shifted out under pressure near the 200 metres had to be straightened.
