RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	TWO TONES CATERING HURDLE
<p>JUSTA CHARLIE (K Walters) put in a poor jump at the third fence. MR BEAN (A Kuru), RAP N TAP (R Cole) and IZZANORANGE (M McNelis) were all pulled up prior to jumping the third last fence when well beaten. MONI NUI (S Phelan) jumped outwards at the fence passing the 1000 metres crowding MASTER MICHAEL (S Karnicnik).</p>	
Race 2	TE AROHA SUPPORTERS CLUB HURDLE
<p>KINGS KITE (G Walsh) put in a poor jump at the final fence in the front straight on the first occasion. TOP CHOICE (S Phelan) and ABSOLUTE GEM (R Cole) both jumped the fence near the 1100 metres poorly. KINGS KITE and THE BEST MAN (C Perrett) put in poor jumps at the fence near the 1000 metres. Hampered as a result was KENTUCKY SON (E Farr). ABSOLUTE GEM was retired from the race prior to the third last fence. THE BEST MAN refused at the third last fence when well beaten, and was retired from the race. KENTUCKY SON put in a poor jump at the final fence and fell. KENTUCKY SON lay on the track for a period whilst winded before regaining its feet, with a post-race veterinary inspection not revealing any abnormalities. Rider E Farr was uninjured.</p>	
Race 3	CHELTENHAM 2017 WITH WHEELS 2200
<p>ARMANDO (M Northcott) blundered leaving the barriers. CRASH BANDICOOT (S MacNab), BORDER REIVER (J-L Lupton) and ATTILA (B Rogerson) all jumped away awkwardly losing ground.</p>	
Race 4	TE AROHA VETERINARY SERVICES STEEPLE
<p>MCCULLEY (K Walters) put in a poor jump at the first fence and landed awkwardly. MCCULLEY then mixed its jumping for the remainder, and was retired from the race prior to the second last fence when well beaten. The gelding underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality. GOOSEBUMPS (S Phelan) misjudged the fence near the 1000 metres. AMANOOD LAD (E Farr) knuckled badly on landing after jumping the second last fence.</p>	
Race 5	TE AROHA STALLION PLACEMENT SCHEME STEEPLE
<p>STAGEHAND (S Phelan) was slow to begin. STAGEHAND jumped indifferently at the rear in the early to middle stages. VENERATE (K Walters) put in a poor jump at the third fence, and when landing awkwardly was bumped by FAIR SCRIPT (M Mitchell). BIG MEADSY (C Perrett) knuckled on landing after jumping the first fence in the home straight on the first occasion. BIG MEADSY misjudged the fence near the 1700 metres. NELLS BELLE (E Goodinson) also put in a poor jump at that fence. MAHARISHI (G Walsh) and NELLS BELLE both landed awkwardly after misjudging the fence near the 1600 metres. FAIR SCRIPT hit the fence near the 1300 metres. GLAMOUR BOY (E Farr) badly misjudged the fence near the 1300 metres and fell. GLAMOUR BOY underwent a post-race veterinary examination which found the gelding to be lame in the left foreleg. Rider E Farr was uninjured. BIG MEADSY knuckled on landing after jumping the second last fence and fell. BIG MEADSY underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed a small wound to the right hind pastern. Rider C Perrett was uninjured.</p>	
Race 6	NORWOOD FARM MACHINERY CENTRE 2200
<p>E Farr admitted a breach of careless riding in that she permitted her mount REEPERBAHN to shift outwards from near the 350 metres forcing HENRY TUDOR (A Kuru) off its rightful line of running, and was suspended from the conclusion of racing on 9 July up to the conclusion of racing on 15 July, 3 riding days. CANDIDLY (G Walsh) lost the left front plate during the running.</p>	
Race 7	MARAMARUA & WAIKATO HUNT 1600
<p>FIREWATER (G Walsh) jumped away awkwardly. INTO THE MYSTIC (E Farr) jumped outwards at the start making contact with MAKE MY DAY (S Karnicnik). DEEBEE BLACK (A Tata) shifted inwards near the 1400 metres crowding SUFFICE TO SAY (H McNeill), MODEL AYE (S Phelan) and WHO CAN TELL (K Veenendaal) with WHO CAN TELL having to be steadied losing ground. A Tata was issued with a warning. KINGS GRAVE (T Harris) had to be steadied when placed in restricted room passing the 800 metres. E Goodinson the rider of SO KEEP EM admitted a breach for excessive use of the whip and was fined the sum of \$300.</p>	

Race 8	DON PATERSON FAREWELL 1600
<p>PAID PRIORITY (A Tata) lay out leaving the barriers crowding ROC'S ARE DIAMONDS (E Farr) on to GOODN'TARG (H McNeill).</p> <p>JEM RUNNER (S Phelan) lay in under pressure, and when being corrected near the 150 metres shifted out crowding SHE'S ALL CLANG (M Mitchell) which had to shift out abruptly across the heels of BORNINASANDPIT (A Kuru).</p> <p>A Tata the rider of PAID PRIORITY admitted a breach for excessive use of the whip and was fined the sum of \$350.</p>
