RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	ILES CASEY CHARTERED ACCOUNTANTS 2000
<p>MARGIN CALL (D Prastiyou), MATANGI BOY (U Holmquist) and BO YING (A Schwerin) were all slow to begin. BO YING was placed in restricted room passing the 1600 metres having to be steadied when racing keenly and dropped back onto LAEKEEPER (L Satherley) which ran wide.</p> <p>CARDINAL SIN (R Elliot) made the bend near the 1600 metres awkwardly.</p> <p>MIDNIGHT INK (A Collett) raced in restricted room near the 900 metres, and was briefly steadied.</p> <p>RUM'N'COKE (C Lammas) was briefly held up passing the 600 metres.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the performance of JIGSAW JANE rider M Cameron advised Stewards that the mare had failed to handle today's track conditions.</p>	
Race 2	COLCHESTER ENGINEERING 1200
<p>BEWITCHED (R Elliot), LUCKY DREAMER (L Magorrian) and VOLEUSE (A Collett) were all slow to begin.</p> <p>ALWAYS EXPLOSIVE (Z Nor Azman) was crowded passing the 1100 metres having to briefly steady.</p> <p>BEWITCHED commenced to race ungenerously when being steadied passing the 1000 metres, and then hung out making heavy contact with BOBTAIL (C Lammas) passing the 800 metres with BOBTAIL becoming unbalanced. BEWITCHED then continued to hang out running wide when making the final bend, and was not persevered with in the home straight. Trainers P and J Brosnan were advised that a warning would be placed against the filly's racing manners.</p>	
Race 3	COMAG 1200
<p>RUBY RUEBEN (Z Nor Azman) began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p>EDEN ROSE (A Collett) began awkwardly, and then blundered losing ground.</p> <p>JACKYCHAN (B R Jones) was slow to begin, and then was further hampered losing ground.</p> <p>MISS SILVERBACK (S Weatherley) was hampered soon after leaving the barriers and steadied.</p> <p>MISS SILVERBACK raced keenly in the early stages.</p> <p>MR DAVINCI (E Farr) raced ungenerously when being steadied in the early to middle stages.</p>	

When questioned into the performance of MISS SILVERBACK S Weatherley advised Stewards that the mare had raced greenly in the early stages, and in his opinion had failed to handle today's track conditions.	
Race 4	PETER HOWLAND'S BEAUREPAIRES MATAMATA 1200
<p>EPEE (C Lammas) and PERCYS STORM (K McCulloch) were both slow to begin. PERCYS STORM commenced to over-race passing the 900 metres becoming awkwardly placed on heels for a distance from near the 800 metres. When questioned regarding the performance of RON'S LAST S McKay advised Stewards that the gelding had got further back in running than intended and would benefit from a step-up in distance.</p>	
Race 5	K R BELL ELECTRICAL 1400
<p>DEAR DOUGLAS (Z Nor Azman), BIG BEN (B R Jones) and LADY CONTI (L Magorrian) were all slow to begin. EMPIRE STAR (S Spratt) and COTAI MASTER (S McKay) came together leaving the barrier. BIG BEN shifted out abruptly when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of EYES OF BOTH (E Farr) which was weakening near the 400 metres. GUMBOOTS (C Lammas) was inclined to lay in when placed under pressure in the final straight.</p>	
Race 6	WRIGHTWAY BUILDERS 1400
<p>ZAPALI (T Wenn) was slow to begin. KITTYKITTYBANGBANG (M Cameron) and JANE BLONDE (S McKay) both began awkwardly. R Elliot (TITANIUM LADY) was reprimanded by Stewards after he was observed to shake hands prior to weighing in.</p>	
Race 7	COLCHESTER ENGINEERING 1600
<p>LETMEBY (S Weatherley) began awkwardly. BOWIE (M Cameron) over-raced when being restrained in the early and middle stages. A post-race veterinary examination of ALL THE ANSWERS (S Spratt) did not reveal any abnormality.</p>	
Race 8	NZI INSURANCE 1600
<p>QUANTUM MAELSTROM (S McKay) and REAL WINNERS (M Cameron) both began awkwardly losing ground. SPECIAL UNIT (R Elliot) shifted out shortly after leaving the barriers making contact with the hind quarters of LADY MARILYN (Z Nor Azman) with that runner becoming unbalanced and laying in crowding SPECIAL UNIT which was steadied. A post-race veterinary examination of QUANTUM MAELSTROM did not reveal any abnormality.</p>
