Race 1	GLUYAS MOTOR GROUP RATING 75 (1600m)
<p>HUNGRY EYES was buffeted between LAAFFAIRE and NIGHT NURSE shortly after the start and got back.</p> <p>TERELLE, FERGIE and JOE BONANNO raced wide in the early stages.</p> <p>CRACKLING ROSIE had to steady near the 600 metres.</p> <p>TERELLE was held up in the early stages of the run home when awkwardly placed to the inside of the tiring JOE BONANNO.</p>	
Race 2	FULTON HOGAN 3&4YO SW (1600m)
<p>LOCHAN ORA began awkwardly and got back.</p> <p>BELLE BOY was buffeted between TOMM JONES and AMUN RA shortly after the start.</p> <p>AMUN RA raced wide in the early stages.</p> <p>LOCHAN ORA made the bend awkwardly near the 900 metres shifting outwards making contact with GOTTAGETMYWOOHOO.</p> <p>TOMM JONES and BELLE BOY raced wide throughout.</p> <p>AMUN RA shifted outwards under pressure near the 200 metres momentarily inconveniencing FLAG THE GROOM which had to steady.</p> <p>TOMM JONES lay inwards over the concluding stages.</p>	

Rider K Kalychurun (LOCHAN ORA) was warned under Rule 638(3)(c) for his use of the whip.	
Race 3	JJ LIMITED MAIDEN (1400m)
<p>CRYSTAL HARMONY began awkwardly and got back.</p> <p>KWEZI began awkwardly.</p> <p>CAPE KRAKEN was placed in restricted room shortly after the stat when RAPID RISE was taken inwards by BERNIE RULES.</p> <p>SIENAMOSA and MAHER MOMENT raced wide throughout.</p> <p>RAPID RISE was placed in restricted room near the 900 metres when KWEZI shifted inwards and BERNIE RULES made the bend awkwardly.</p> <p>BERNIE RULES gave ground from the 800 metres inconveniencing SHANTAHLIA EXPRESS and KWEZI.</p> <p>The connections of BERNIE RULES were advised that a racing manners warning had been placed against the gelding's record.</p> <p>BLUE POOL BLUR was held up for a short distance passing the 400 metres.</p> <p>On entering the home straight BLUE POOL BLUR was unbalanced when contacted from the outside by WINDERMERE LASS.</p> <p>Rider M Chui (SUGGESTIVE LOOX) was reminded of his obligations with respect to his whip use prior to the 200 metres.</p> <p>BLUE POOL BLUR lost the off hind plate during the running.</p>	
Race 4	ASHBURTON U-HIRE RATING 65 (1400m)
<p>ZIPPIN was hampered at the start when FINAL SAY shifted outwards and PEGGY'S CHOICE shifted inwards.</p> <p>BORN A ROYAL and STRALIS over-raced in the early stages.</p> <p>MAGGIE'S SECRET and HOT PANTS raced wide throughout.</p> <p>ZIPPIN and PEGGY'S CHOICE were both steadied at the 800 metres when awkwardly placed to the inside of MAGGIE'S SECRET (L Allpress). Rider L Allpress was reminded of her obligations when shifting ground.</p> <p>LINDIS PASS shifted outwards passing the 400 metres and made contact with MAGGIE'S SECRET.</p> <p>MAGGIE'S SECRET was steadied at the 200 metres when FLYING IBIS (B Moore) shifted outwards. Rider B Moore was reminded of her obligations when shifting ground.</p> <p>FINAL SAY lay outwards from the 100 metres and brushed with PRINCE RANSOM passing the 50 metres.</p> <p>LINDIS PASS shifted inwards over the concluding stages.</p>	
Race 5	SPEIGHTS MID STRENGTH RATING 65 (2100m)
<p>MIO KIWI was hampered as the start was effected and got back.</p> <p>SWEET TIME raced wide in the early stages.</p> <p>MISS MIA raced wide in the early and middle stages.</p> <p>MORGAN BET raced wide throughout.</p> <p>VILLA ELBA blundered near the 500 metres and lost momentum.</p> <p>Rider K Mudhoo (PERFECT SECRET) was reminded of his obligations regarding his use of the whip on a runner out of contention.</p>	
Race 6	RD PETROLEUM OPEN HANDICAP (2100m)
<p>RAPT IN RED stood flat footed as the start was effected losing several lengths.</p> <p>KEEP THE COURAGE was slow in the early stages.</p> <p>UMSHINI WAMI gave ground rapidly from the 800 metres.</p> <p>COME FLY WITH ME lay inwards near the 300 metres and had to be straightened inconveniencing LUCILLE momentarily.</p> <p>PHEASANT was eased down over the concluding stages.</p> <p>Post-race veterinary examinations of UMSHINI WAMI and PHEASANT revealed no apparent abnormalities for either runner.</p> <p>Stewards questioned apprentice T Jonker, in the presence of apprentice jockey mentor W Harnett, in relation to her ride on UMSHINI WAMI. In particular Stewards concerns centred from the 1700 metres to the 1300 metres where the opportunity was present to restrain the gelding. Miss Jonker advised that she had been unaware of the distance between herself and the second horse near the 1700 metres and that the gelding was travelling well within itself. Stewards also questioned trainer K Hughes who advised that the instructions given were to take up a forward position after the start and near the 1500 metres try to ease the horse and give it some respite prior to commencing the gelding's run to the finish from the 600 metres. Mr Hughes advised that he was disappointed with the gelding's efforts today and he undertook to notify Stewards if anything comes to light in subsequent days which could have contributed to today's performance. After considering their explanations and given Miss Jonkers' limited experience, Stewards advised Miss Jonker that she had erred in her judgement by not allowing the gelding greater respite earlier in the race. Stewards also advised Miss Jonker that she was to show better judgement in future and was referred to the jockey mentor.</p>	
Race 7	ROBBIES BAR & BISTRO ASHBURTON RATING 65 (2100m)
<p>SPECIAL BID and SHEZATOUCHA began awkwardly.</p> <p>FINAL SHINKO raced keenly in the early stages.</p>	

PAW PATROL raced ungenerously in the early stages.

HE AIN'T HEAVY raced wide in the early stages.

SHE'S PAYBACK raced wide throughout.

ANGEL FALLS was steadied near the 1800 metres when awkwardly placed inside the heels of **OPERA KNIGHT** (T Moseley). Rider **T Moseley** was reminded of his obligations when shifting ground.

SHE'S PAYBACK and **LUKANDER** bumped near the 900 metres.

PENNYS FROM HEAVEN made the bend awkwardly near the 400 metres shifting outwards. **PENNYS FROM HEAVEN** continued to lay outwards in the final straight.

Rider **B Moore** (RUBY TUESDAY) admitted a breach of Rule 638(3)(b)(ii) in that she used her whip excessively prior to the 200 metres with the JCA imposing a fine of \$300.

WILD JACK and **BLUE PRINT** jostled shortly after the start when placed in restricted room as **HEARTS OF STONE** shifted inwards.

ESSDEE raced wide throughout.

WHAMMY KISS gave ground from the 900 metres. A post-race veterinary inspection revealed no abnormalities. Trainer D Crozier was advised that the mare would have to trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing next.

HEARTS OF STONE was steadied near the 300 metres and placed in restricted room near the 200 metres when awkwardly placed to the outside of **SCANDALO**.
