## RACE COMMENTS:

<b>Race 1</b>	<b>LION RED 2YO</b>
<p><b>MONGOLIAN WOLF</b> (M Cameron) was slow to begin.</p> <p><b>BOBTAIL</b> (C Lammas) began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p><b>MOOGHAMIR</b> (T Thornton) hung out and raced ungenerously when making the bend.</p> <p><b>SOUTHERN PRINCESS</b> (S McKay) had a tendency to lay out through the middle stages and rounding the final turn.</p> <p><b>BEWITCHED</b> (L Satherley) shifted inwards under pressure inconveniencing <b>MOOGHAMIR</b> passing the 100 metres. Rider T Thornton was unable to offer any excuses for the poor performance of <b>MOOGHAMIR</b>, but advised that she had recommended to the connections that the colt may benefit from the addition of blinkers.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the performance of <b>BOBTAIL</b> rider C Lammas advised that the filly had held its breath.</p>	
<b>Race 2</b>	<b>UNITED GAMING LTD 3YO</b>
<p><b>MOTUMAN</b> (V Gatu) began awkwardly, and when being corrected made contact with <b>WHISTLE BLOWER</b> (M Cameron).</p> <p><b>CAMEAHOTFRIDAY</b> (Z Nor Azman) had to be steadied when placed in restricted room passing the 800 metres then over-racing for a distance.</p> <p><b>AHJAY</b> (M Coleman) lay out rounding the final turn and early in the straight resulting in <b>MOTUMAN</b> being disappointed for a run to the outside of that runner having to shift ground outwards across the heels of <b>CAMEAHOTFRIDAY</b> to obtain clear running near the 250 metres.</p> <p><b>CAMEAHOTFRIDAY</b> lay out under pressure passing the 100 metres before being corrected by its rider inconveniencing <b>MOTUMAN</b> near the 50 metres.</p> <p>Following the race apprentice V Gatu the rider of the second placed horse <b>MOTUMAN</b> lodged a protest against the first placed horse <b>CAMEAHOTFRIDAY</b> alleging interference over the final 50 metres. After consideration the Judicial Committee dismissed the protest.</p>	
<b>Race 3</b>	<b>TAURANGA RSA-MT MAUNGANUI RSA 1600</b>

**BOWIE** (M Cameron) raced keenly when being restrained in the early stages.

**JOHN GRAY** (A Schwerin) raced keenly for a distance near the 1300 metres.

**Race 4 WHAKATANE RSA-WAIHI BEACH RSA 2150**

**FENDALTON** (C Lammas) shifted outwards leaving the barriers crowding **JIGSAW JANE** (E Smith), **SUMMER WARRIOR** (M Coleman) and **MR BEAN** (S Weatherley) with **MR BEAN** being hampered and losing ground. Contributing was inward movement from **JOE CARGO** (V Colgan) which raced ungenerously and shifted inwards away from **CRACKTHEGOODSTUFF** (T Thornton). **JOE CARGO** continued to race ungenerously through the early to middle stages.

**THAT'S HOW IT GOES** (K McCulloch) raced in restricted room passing the 2000 metres, and was steadied and commenced to race ungenerously for a distance.

**NAMBASSA** (M Cameron) raced ungenerously when making the first bend near the 1700 metres.

**FENDALTON** shifted inwards under pressure hampering the weakening **ATUA** (S McKay) near the 200 metres. C Lammas was issued with a warning.

When questioned regarding the performance of **ATUA** rider S McKay was unable to offer any excuses, but was of the opinion that the gelding may now benefit from a break.

M Cameron was unable to offer any excuses for the poor performance of **NAMBASSA**.

A post-race veterinary examination of **ATUA** did not reveal any abnormality with the trainer confirming that the gelding will now be sent for a spell.

A post-race veterinary examination of **NAMBASSA** revealed the mare to be showing signs of lameness with connections advising that it will now be retired from racing.

**Race 5 NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE**

Trainer Mr R Lang was issued with a warning after presenting his stable runners with incorrect gear.

**SWISSILICIOUS** (M Hills) began awkwardly losing ground (2L).

**DINAH LEE** (A Sims) and **BABOONSKI** (L Magorrian) came together shortly after leaving the barriers.

**MAKAROVA** (V Colgan) and **JUST SUGAR** (R Elliot) came together leaving the barriers with **JUST SUGAR** then shifting inwards further hampering **DEVIANT MISS** (Z Nor Azman) which had begun awkwardly.

**BABOONSKI** raced ungenerously in the early to middle stages.

**DEVIANT MISS** raced ungenerously when being restrained going into the bend near the 900 metres getting its head up and losing ground.

**BARCELONA BABY** (U Holmquist) commenced to hang out when making the bend near the 900 metres, and continued to do so for the remainder of the race.

**MAKAROVA** was steadied when placed in restricted room near the 450 metres with rider V Colgan advising that the filly, which was making its raceday debut, had been inclined to race greenly when amongst other runners.

**BARCELONA BABY** lay out rounding the final turn despite the efforts of its rider, and passing the 400 metres crowded **JUST SUGAR** which became awkwardly placed on the heels of **BARCELONA BABY** and shifted outwards abruptly hampering **KITTYKITTYBANGBANG** (M Cameron) and **DEVIANT MISS** (Z Nor Azman) which were both forced wider on the point of the home turn.

**Race 6 CLUB MT MAUNGANUI-OHOPE CHARTERED CLUB 1400**

**SABER** (S Olney) and **BRILLIANT MAGIC** (A Schwerin) came together leaving the barriers making solid contact badly unbalancing the rider of **SABER**.

Passing the 1200 metres **KEEPING TOM** (Z Nor Azman) lay in placing **DE KENSINGTON OVAL** (S McKay) in restricted room which was then steadied.

When questioned regarding the performance of **TRICKLE DOWN** rider M Cameron advised that the gelding had paraded in a fresh condition, but was otherwise unable to offer any excuses A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormality other than the gelding having pulled the left hind plate.

**Race 7 CITIZENS RSA TE PUKE-TAURANGA CITZ 1200**

**BATTLE PLAN** (L Magorrian), **WOOSTER** (S McKay) and **SENASSY** (Z Nor Azman) all began awkwardly losing ground.

**EMBRACEABLE YOU** (K McCulloch) lay outwards away from **ITS A KINDA MAGIC** (V Gatu) for a distance passing the 400 metres.

**ONLY IF** had a tendency to race greenly under pressure in the final straight with rider M Cameron reporting that the filly had held its breath during the running.

**GIRLSAREBACKINTOWN** (M Coleman) lost the right hind plate during the running.

**Race 8 TAURANGA CHRISTMAS RACES-BOOK NOW 1600**

During the preliminary the saddle slipped forward on **MIGHTY COLOMBO** with rider V Gatu having to dismount and requiring assistance from the Clerk of the Course. As a result the race ran approximately 5 minutes late.

**BLACKHAVEN** (R Elliot) was slow to begin.

**ALL BEST FRIENDS** (S McKay) and **SHEZA COLUMBIA** (L Satherley) were both slow to begin before being further hampered by **GOSHAWK** (C Lammas) which shifted outwards abruptly.

**RICH HABIT** (T Thornton) was held up for a distance passing the 600 metres.

**GOSHAWK** shifted outwards abruptly when struck with the whip passing the 500 metres making contact with **RICH HABIT**.  
**RICH HABIT** and **WANNABE ROYALE** (M Cameron) came together near the 300 metres.  
**GOSHAWK** lost the left hind plate during the running.
