<b>Race 1</b>	<b>DAIRYMASTER / ELTHAM VETERINARY SERVICES DN 1200</b>
<p><b>POPCORN</b> was slow away.</p> <p>Shortly after the start <b>GERONIMO</b> (T Johnson) clipped a heel of <b>ART DECO</b> which was on an inward movement, blundered resulting in apprentice T Johnson being dislodged. T Johnson was uninjured. Also affected was <b>POPCORN</b> (D Turner) which had to take evasive action to avoid the loose horse.</p> <p>R Hannam admitted a breach of Rule 638(1)(d) in that he permitted his mount <b>ART DECO</b> to shift ground near the 1000m when not the required distance clear, causing T Johnson (GERONIMO) to become dislodged. The JCA suspended R Hannam's licence to ride from 18.7.16 to 6.8.16 inclusive (12 days)</p> <p>R Hannam admitted a breach of Rule 638(1)(d) in that he permitted his mount <b>ART DECO</b> to shift ground near the 1000m when not the required distance clear, causing R Myers (GLORIOS) having to check her mount.</p> <p>The JCA suspended R Hannam's licence to ride from 7.8.16 – 12.8.16 inclusive (4 days).</p>	
<b>Race 2</b>	<b>CENTRAL TYRES AUTOMOTIVE</b>
Trainer <b>K Buttimore's</b> explanation regarding her late declaration for <b>SKUFFLE</b> was accepted by the Stewards.	

<p><b>LET HER GO</b> was slow away.</p> <p><b>PUT THE BILLY ON</b> made the first bend awkwardly when in restricted room and was steadied.</p> <p><b>DREAM LOVER</b> was not persevered with in the home straight. Rider L Allpress said the filly was exhausted in the testing going. A vet check proved clear.</p> <p><b>DREAM LOVER</b> which finished well back underwent a veterinary inspection which was clear.</p>	
<b>Race 3</b>	<b>NATHAN BOLTON LIVESTOCK / ELE 1480M</b>
<p><b>I SUGGEST</b> was slow away.</p> <p><b>SILVER COURT</b> lost both back plates during the running.</p>	
<b>Race 4</b>	<b>RAVENSDOWN AND SPREADERS 2000M</b>
<p><b>CARTAGENA</b> was slow to begin and settled at the rear.</p> <p><b>ITSALLBELT</b> and <b>SAVAROSE</b> did not finish and were retired from the race when well back and out of contention.</p>	
<b>Race 5</b>	<b>KEANO@SENTRY HILL</b>
<p><b>SHARE THE BLAME</b> began awkwardly and was slow away.</p> <p><b>DO I KNOW YOU</b> lost an off fore plate during the running and was examined by the veterinary surgeon revealing a minor laceration.</p> <p>Subsequent to the race the connections of <b>HONEY QUEEN</b> requested a veterinary inspection of the mare which revealed an elevated heart rate.</p>	
<b>Race 6</b>	
<p><b>RED FOX</b> shifted out abruptly at the start resulting in <b>IN A TRANCE</b> being tightened and getting back.</p> <p><b>EYEFUL TOWER</b> was dictated wider going into the first turn when <b>ZED CASE</b> shifted out.</p>	
<b>Race 7</b>	
<p><b>PADDY JO</b> (Z Moki) escaped riderless for a short distance prior to being captured and cleared to race. Z Moki was unhurt.</p> <p><b>MR INK</b> made the first turn awkwardly and had to be steadied in restricted room.</p> <p><b>PADDY JO</b> raced wide without cover throughout.</p>
