RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 NORM BEVAN MEMORIAL MAIDEN STEEPLECHASE

WHITE FACE jumped indifferently throughout.

RIPDIDDLER (S Phelan) put in poor jumps at the double on the final occasion.

VENERATE (K Walters) dislodged the rider after landing awkwardly over the fence near the 600 metres. KINA

WIN (A Kuru) and BANTENEIGHTY (G Walsh) were hampered as a result. K Walters was uninjured.

VENERATE then crashed through the running rail resulting the gelding being treated by the veterinary surgeon for lacerations.

PUDDLE ALLEY (M McNellis) was pulled up and did not jump the final two fences.

OFF HAND (S Fannin) did not jump the final fence, being pulled up when well back.

E Goodinson (NELLS BELLE) dropped in her whip when racing through the centre on the final occasion.

Race 2 EKRAAR@LINWOOD PARK MAIDEN HURDLE

MAX (I Lupton) jumped the second fence poorly and fell. Both horse and rider were uninjured.

TWENTYTHIRTYFOUR (S Fannin) put in a poor jump at the second fence.

FRED FLINTSTONE (S Karnicnik) jumped indifferently throughout.

RED SUNSET (E Goodinson) blundered on landing over the fence near the 400 metres.

ZEDEEDUDADEEKO (C Studd) jumped the final fence only fairly.

KING VICTOR (C Perrett) did not jump the final 4 fences.

I'M ALL YOURS (S Phelan), DAL DUNVEGAN (G Walsh) and FRED FLINTSTONE did not jump the final 2 fences

E Goodinson (**RED SUNSET**) was questioned why she allowed her mount to establish a long lead in the early stages. She explained that the mare has a tendency to over-race when restrained so elected to let her run.

Race 3 ANUKA SMOKER WELLINGTON HURDLE – Prestige Jumping Race

MAHANADI (S Fannin) lost momentum over the first fence.

THATZ DAVID (A Browne) was inclined to run its fences down in the early stages.

Approaching the 3100 metres **OOEE** (**A Kuru**) shifted in crowding **JUST ISHI** (**G Walsh**) which was steadied. A Kuru was advised to exercise greater care.

JUST GOT HOME (E Farr) over-raced in the early and middle stages.

MY MAGICIAN (M Mitchell) blundered on landing at the fence near the 600 metres on the first occasion.

MAHANADI put in a poor jump at the fence near the 2000 metres.

MY MAGICIAN put in a poor jump at the fence near the 1200 metres and dislodged rider **M Mitchell** who was uninjured. **DERBY DAN (I Lupton)** which was following was badly hampered.

OOEE and **MAHANADI** made heavy contact after jumping the fence near the 1000 metres.

GARGARIN fell at the third last fence dislodging rider **M Gillies** who was then hit by **OOEE** (**A Kuru**) which was following. **M Gillies** was treated by ambulance personnel and transferred to hospital.

OOEE was badly hampered with rider A Kuru becoming unbalanced and losing the use of his iron for some distance. **OOEE** was retired from the race at that point.

JUST GOT HOME put in a poor jump at the fence near the 400 metres and then again at the penultimate fence, knuckling on landing on that occasion.

DERBY DAN (I Lupton) put in a poor jump at the fence near the 400 metres then did not jump the final two fences. **D Walsh** reported that **JUST ISHI** hung throughout and proved a difficult ride.

Race 4 CENTRAL GROUP FORKLIFTS & TRUCKS PREMIER

WHATWEDO (E Farr) began awkwardly.

PADDY BOURKE (T Johnson) raced ungenerously for a short distance after the start.

WHATWEDO (**E Farr**) raced keenly in the early and middle stages becoming awkwardly placed on heels passing the 1000 metres crowding **PADDY BOURKE**.

BANNOCKBURN (R Hannam) ducked out passing the 150 metres inconveniencing SLIMLINE (R Goldsbury).

BANNOCKBURN was slightly lame following the race. Connections were advised a clearance is required.

Race 5 LONE STAR PETONE PARLIAMENTARY HANDICAP

DANZA LAD (J Riddell) raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

R Hannam (MR COOL BOY) was issued with a warning for his use of the whip prior to the 200 metres.

Race 6 GRANT PLUMBING WELLINGTON STEEPLECHASE – Prestige Jumping race

GET FLASH (S Fannin) over-raced in the early stages.

TOM'S MYTH mixed his jumping in the middle stages putting in a poor jump at the 5th last fence dislodging rider **S Phelan** who was transferred to hospital for further treatment.

THE FOX (E Farr) put in a poor jump at the 4th last fence.

AMANOOD LAD (S Pateman) hit the first of the double on the last occasion hard. **S Pateman** reported that the gelding failed to respond following that poor jump.

ERIC THE VIKING (M Cropp) put in a poor jump at the 2nd last fence.

OLD REDFEATHER (A Browne) was pulled up after jumping the fence at the 600 metres.

MR MOR (**M Mitchell**) attempted to run off at the final fence and then jumped the fence awkwardly dislodging rider **M Mitchell** who was not injured.

After jumping the final fence **WISE MEN SAY** (**I Lupton**) had to briefly steady off the heels of the weakening **GET FLASH.**

Race 7 THE HANLEY FORMULA WHYTE HANDICAP

This race ran approx 2 mins late due to a delay in the ambulance returning from an incident in the previous race.

SIR KINGSWOOD (**R Myers**) lay out under pressure approaching the 200 metres with **JOBY** (**L Hemi**) shifting out and away from that runner briefly crowding **FARCE** (**L Allpress**).

Apprentice rider **A Syahir** was issued with a reprimand and advised that a warning would be placed on his record for the manner in which he used his whip on **DUFFERS CREEK** in the home straight. He was further advised that he would be referred to the riding master for further education.

Race 8 WELLINGTON SEAMARKET PREMIER

MASTER PLATINUM (J Riddell) and BEADLE (N Teeluck) were both slow to begin.

MASTER PLATINUM shifted out to obtain clear running near the 250 metres inconveniencing the weakening FIERTE (D Bradley)

SUSSED (R Goldsbury) had to change ground near the 250 metres to avoid the tiring **FIERTE**.

D Bradley reported that FIERTE raced fiercely early and had nothing left when asked to produce later in the race. **L** Allpress reported that TITANIUM LADY travelled well throughout but when asked for an effort near the 600 metres, failed to respond. A subsequent veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities. L Allpress was to recommend to connections a tongue tie be applied to the mare.
