## RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	TRINITY HILL 3YO 1200 (1200 metres)
<p><b>AMORATA</b> began awkwardly and was then badly hampered by <b>EPEE</b> which shifted out leaving the barriers.</p> <p><b>BOB'STHEJOB</b> over-raced when being restrained in the early stages.</p> <p><b>ARTEMIS RISING</b> raced ungenerously when being restrained off the heels of <b>ROYAL RUBY</b> which shifted in when passing the 600 metre bend.</p> <p><b>SIDART</b> raced keenly in the early and middle stages.</p> <p><b>EPEE (C Lammas)</b> had a tendency to lay out in the final straight.</p> <p><b>HE'S RESOLUTE</b> shifted out to obtain clear running approaching the 200 metres with <b>BOB'STHEJOB</b> shifting away from that runner and forcing <b>ROYAL RUBY</b> wider on the track.</p> <p><b>SIDART</b> shifted in under pressure becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of <b>MARCONI</b>, which shifted out approaching the 50 metres.</p>	

<b>Race 2</b>	<b>FASTTRACKINSURANCE 1200 (1200 metres)</b>
<p><b>MALACANTO</b> was slow to begin.</p> <p><b>ELUCIDATE</b> was steadied shortly after the start when racing in restricted room to the inside of <b>AMBITIOUS UNICORN</b> (S Spratt) which shifted in. <b>AMBITIOUS UNICORN</b> continued to shift in when not fully clear of <b>THE BANDITO</b> which was crowded and then commenced to race ungenerously, going back on to <b>STORMY RAY</b>, which was hampered. With Stewards taking into account the racing manners of <b>THE BANDITO</b>, rider <b>S Spratt</b> was issued with a warning.</p> <p><b>THE BANDITO</b> was then crowded passing the 1000 metres to the inside of <b>ELUCIDATE (M Tanaka)</b> which raced ungenerously when laying in and away from <b>DAVEY CROCKETT</b>, which shifted in slightly. M Tanaka was advised to exercise greater care when in similar circumstances.</p> <p><b>ELUCIDATE</b> and <b>THE BANDITO</b> then made the bend awkwardly when racing ungenerously passing the 800 metres.</p> <p><b>THE BANDITO</b> continued to race ungenerously through the middle stages becoming awkwardly placed on heels approaching the 600 metres.</p> <p>Passing the 400 metres <b>SYDNEY'S SHOT</b> improved into a marginal run to the inside of <b>DAVEY CROCKETT</b> making contact with the hind quarters of that runner, with <b>DAVEY CROCKETT</b> becoming unbalanced and then shifting out making contact with <b>FIVE OFF THE TEE</b>.</p> <p><b>FLYING FETCH</b> shifted in when placed under pressure in the final straight, inconveniencing <b>ELUCIDATE</b> near the 250 metres.</p> <p><b>STORMY BAY</b> had to shift out approaching the 200 metres to obtain clear running.</p>	
<b>Race 3</b>	<b>NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE (800 metres)</b>
<p><b>M Tanaka (MAROTIRI LASS)</b> advised stewards following the event that he had broken his whip and it was unable to be used throughout the race.</p> <p><b>GAMEPLAN</b> was slow to begin and was further hampered by <b>BREAK MY STRIDE</b> which had begun awkwardly, shifting in.</p> <p><b>DANGER DEE</b> was slow to begin.</p> <p><b>O'REILLY'S CHOICE</b> began awkwardly and then was hampered by <b>COASTING</b> which shifted out abruptly leaving the barriers.</p> <p><b>HEAVENLY GOLD</b> commenced to hang out when linking on to the course proper near the 600 metres crowding <b>BREAK MY STRIDE</b>, which was badly checked losing ground near the 500 metres.</p> <p><b>O'REILLY'S CHOICE</b> and <b>MAROTIRI LASS</b> both raced wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>Over the concluding stages <b>HEAVENLY GOLD</b> improved on to the heels of <b>O'REILLY'S CHOICE</b> which shifted in, with <b>HEAVENLY GOLD</b> being steadied.</p>	
<b>Race 4</b>	<b>"JJ" TURNS 60 TODAY 1400 (1400 metres)</b>
<p><b>DOUBLE DOWN</b> was slow to begin.</p> <p><b>PROSECCO</b> was crowded shortly after jumping away.</p> <p><b>RAWHIDE</b> began awkwardly.</p> <p><b>SAVATAG</b> raced ungenerously approaching the 800 metres</p> <p><b>TAKE THE TRICK</b> over-raced for a distance when awkwardly placed on heels near the 800 metres.</p> <p><b>LIBRETTI</b> raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.</p> <p>Entering the final straight <b>SAVATAG</b> (M Tanaka) lay out when placed under pressure, crowding <b>SHOWYOUHOW</b> on to <b>LOVETOKEEPPHIM</b>, which were both hampered. Contributing was inward movement from <b>LIBRETTI</b>. Rider M Tanaka was nevertheless advised that he is expected to straighten his mount sooner than he did on this occasion.</p> <p><b>BLACKMAGICWOMAN</b> raced greenly in the final straight and was inconvenienced near the 250 metres when shifting across heels.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the disappointing run of <b>PROSECCO</b>, rider S McKay could offer no tangible excuse.</p> <p>When questioned into the run of <b>SHOOT TO KILL</b> R Myers had no excuse. A post race veterinary examination was clear.</p>	
<b>Race 5</b>	<b>CHELTENHAM 2017 WITH WHEELS 2200 (2200 metres)</b>
<p><b>NOVA SCOTIA</b> was slow to begin.</p> <p><b>ZEDBEE</b> and <b>BAD BOY BROWN</b> were slow to begin.</p> <p><b>TAIPA TIGER</b> and <b>RUNNY HONEY</b> raced in restricted room approaching the 2000 metres to the inside of <b>BANG</b>, which was taken in by <b>MASH (H Andrew)</b>. H Andrew was shown footage of the incident and advised to exercise greater care.</p> <p><b>TWILIGHT OFFER</b> raced ungenerously when being steadied off heels near the 1800 metres, shifting out and racing wide for the remainder of the race.</p> <p><b>BANG</b> was denied a narrow run near the 200 metres when attempting to improve to the inside of <b>FAZED</b> then had to be angled outwards to improve.</p> <p><b>BAD BOY BROWN</b> lay out passing the 400 metres crowding <b>MASTER THOMAS</b>.</p> <p>When questioned into the run of <b>EKAROSA</b>, which finished the race off only fairly, rider S Collett was of the opinion the mare felt a little flat. Trainer P Mirabelli advised <b>EKAROSA</b> would spell.</p> <p><b>SNEDDON</b> ran wide making the final turn and was dismounted on pulling up. Following the race <b>SNEDDON</b> underwent a veterinary inspection which revealed a tendon injury to the left foreleg.</p>	

Stewards ordered a veterinary examination of <b>TWILIGHT OFFER</b> which did not reveal any abnormalities.	
<b>Race 6</b>	<b>EMIRATES MELBOURNE CUP TOUR IN HB 23 JULY 1650 (1650 metres)</b>
<p><b>PICCOLO</b> and <b>GARCON DEUX</b> were slow to begin with <b>GARCON DEUX</b> then being crowded, losing further ground. <b>GARCON DEUX</b> over-raced in the early stages. <b>GARCON DEUX</b> continued to race ungenerously through the middle stages and raced wide without cover from the 800 metres.</p> <p><b>MISTY MUSIC (M Tanaka)</b> was held up for clear running early in the final straight, shifting in passing in the 300 metres to obtain clear running, making contact with <b>PIER ELEVEN</b> which was forced across the heels of <b>SHARP ELLE</b> which was inconvenienced as a result. M Tanaka was advised to exercise greater care when shifting ground.</p> <p><b>S Spratt (SHARP ELLE)</b> was questioned into her ride, in particular near the 200 metres where she took hold of her mount for several strides. <b>Miss Spratt</b> advised stewards that her mount commenced to hang from the 600 metres resulting in the bit being pulled through its mouth and near the 200 metres stopped riding when the filly hung outwards. A subsequent veterinary examination of <b>SHARP ELLE</b> did not reveal any abnormalities.</p>	
<b>Race 7</b>	<b>MAKFI CHALLENGE STAKES-DAFFODIL RACEDAY AUG 27 (1650 metres)</b>
<p><b>TROUP ROAD</b> and <b>KININMONT</b> were slow to begin.</p> <p><b>REAL THIRSTY</b> and <b>TARIHIRA</b> came together near the 200 metres when both runners shifted ground.</p>	
<b>Race 8</b>	<b>BAY FORD NZ PUNTER OF THE YEAR OCTOBER 1<sup>ST</sup> (1650 metres)</b>
<p><b>SHANKLY, BLAME DE ANGELS</b> and <b>ONE KAY</b> were slow away.</p> <p>When questioned into the improved performance of the winner <b>ALCADESA</b>, Trainer T Bambry reported that the filly had been hit in the eye by a clod at its previous start which was reported and was suited to the better conditions under foot today.</p>
