RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 JO MCGARTLAND MEMORIAL MAIDEN HURDLES (3000m)

HIGHLY LIKELY and **AKAL** were hampered shortly after the start when **NEWS FLASH** shifted outwards and **TERELLE** lay inwards.

TO THE MAX and TERELLE raced keenly in the early stages.

DOUBLE TAP ran the third fence down.

NEWS FLASH made a poor leap at the third fence.

TWIST OF FATE raced keenly for some distance in the middle stages.

NEWS FLASH made a faulty leap at the fence near the 2200 metres, badly unbalancing rider J Lowry.

NEWS FLASH jumped indifferently throughout.

TO THE MAX made a poor leap at the jump near the 2000 metres and hampered AKAL.

TERELLE baulked at the fence near the 1400 metres, crashing through the inside wing and running rail, dislodging rider C Studd. Neither horse nor rider were injured in this incident. The connections of **TERELLE** were advised that the gelding must school again prior to jumping next.

NEWS FLASH made a poor leap at the jump near the 1400 metres, badly unbalancing rider J Lowry.

DOUBLE TAP hit the fence hard near the 1100 metres.

DOUBLE TAP made a faulty leap at the fence near the 600 metres

TWIST OF FATE landed awkwardly at the fence near the 600 metres, unbalancing rider S Karnicnik.

 $\ensuremath{\text{NEWS FLASH}}$ was retired from the event passing the 500 metres.

TO THE MAX made firm contact with the fence near the 300 metres.

HIGHLY LIKELY (A Kuru) shifted inwards near the 200 metres, placing **DOUBLE TAP** and **KINGIESSTAR** in restricted room. **KINGIESTAR** was steadied and shifted ground outwards to obtain clear running.

A Kuru was reminded of his obligations when shifting ground.

TWIST OF FATE and TERELLE both lost their left front plate during the running.

Race 2 MAURICE SMITH RESTRICTED OPEN HURDLES (3000m)

MAILLY and SIR MANAWA were restrained to the rear on jumping.

J Lowry, the rider of **HIGH FORTY**, lost the use of his inside iron for a short distance after jumping the first fence. **LOCALLY SAUCED** made a slow jump at the second fence.

LOOSE GOOSE became awkwardly placed inside the heels of MISS CITRON near the 2500 metres, contacting a heel and blundering.

ADDITUP raced ungenerously when restrained near the 2500 metres. **LOCALLY SAUCED** was hampered in consequence. **LOCALLY SAUCED** jumped indifferently throughout.

GOLD LEAF made a poor leap at the fence near the 2300 metres.

ADDITUP made firm contact with the fence near the 1100 metres.

REGALO REAAL made a poor leap at the fence near the 600 metres, badly unbalancing rider A Kuru.

SIR MANAWA made a poor leap at the second last fence.

Race 3 MCINTOSH CATERING SPRINT RATING 85 (1200m)

RIVERTAINE COUP began awkwardly and raced ungenerously in the early stages.

FLICKA OF GOLD shifted outwards on jumping hampering MOONOFKLAIRESSA and OVERNIGHTSENSATION.

KILLA QUESTION raced three wide without cover throughout.

KILLA QUESTION lay inwards in the straight when under pressure and had to be straightened.

Race 4 EQUINE VETERINARY SERVICES RST OPEN STEEPLECHASE (4280m)

ENCHANTER made a poor leap at the first fence, hampering **CECIL**.

ENCHANTER made a poor leap at the second fence, badly unbalancing rider E Goodinson.

RADINKA made a poor leap at the second fence.

ENCHANTER jumped indifferently throughout.

INDIAN BURT made a poor leap at the fence near the 3200 metres.

TAI HO made a slow leap at the fence near the 2800 metres.

TAI HO made a poor leap at the fence near the 2300 metres. TAI HO jumped indifferently from this point on.

CECIL made a poor leap at the fence near the 1200 metres and again at the fence near the 800 metres.

ENCHANTER was retired from the event after jumping the fence at the 600 metres.

CECIL lay outwards passing the 400 metres and had to be straightened. **CECIL** continued to lay outwards throughout the home straight.

Race 5 NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE F&M MAIDEN (1200m)

NAVA began awkwardly.

HEAVEN KNOWS, SUGGESTIVE LOOX and STORM CATCHER were slow to begin.

NAVA raced keenly in the early stages.

MAHORA BAY became awkwardly placed on heels between SUGGESTIVE LOOX and FAIRLIGHT near the 900 metres. SUGGESTIVE LOOX made the bend awkwardly, simultaneously to MAHORA BAY laying inwards. As a result MAHORA BAY clipped a heel and dislodged rider L Callaway. HOT DATE and QUICK ANSWER were hampered as a result. L Callaway was attended to by St John Paramedics and stood down from his remaining riding engagements. NAVA lay outwards passing the 400 metres.

MOTHER SUPERIOR (J Morris) shifted inwards when struck by the whip passing the 300 metres, placing **NAVA** in restricted room. Rider **J Morris** was reminded of her obligations when shifting ground.

NAVA which had continued to lay outwards raced in restricted room to the inside of **MOTHER SUPERIOR** and had to steady near the 150 metres, shifting outwards near the 100 metres to obtain clear running.

ELLERSTINA was inclined to lay outwards throughout the final straight and had to be straightened on a number of occasions.

When spoken to regarding the performance of favoured runner **FAIRLIGHT**, rider T Moseley reported that the filly had lay outwards throughout and when placed under pressure had been disappointing.

Race 6 D'CASH DASH RATING 65 (1200m)

GOOD CHOICE was restrained to the rear on jumping.

PARISDOTCON raced keenly in the early stages.

Passing the 1000 metres **RIPE** shifted away from **MR TYPHON** which lay outwards and forced **PARISDOTCON** and **BLACK ESTATE** wider on the track. **PARISDOTCON** and **BLACK ESTATE** raced wide from that point on.

SAN MICHELE was held up for a short distance passing the 400 metres.

BLACK ESTATE lay in approaching the 200 metres and made contact with **PARISDOTCON**. **PARISDOTCON** was then steadied when awkwardly placed on the heels of **RIPE**. Shortly thereafter **BLACK ESTATE** was steadied when awkwardly placed to the inside of **STRALIS** (M Chui) which shifted inwards. **M Chui** was reminded of his obligations when shifting ground.

ALL ASPECTS PAINTING & DECORATING MILE RATING 65 (1600m)

FAIRY CAKE underwent a pre race veterinary inspection and was cleared to race.

SIR JACK REMINGTON raced keenly in the early stages and was steadied near the 1400 metres, hampering

Race 7

BOOTYFUL raced wide throughout.

CASTUP was inclined to lay inwards throughout the home straight, with the rider swapping whip hands near the 300 metres.

ITS NO SECRET was placed in restricted room for a short distance passing the 200 metres.

SPIDER LILY lay outwards in the early stages of the home straight with the rider swapping whip hands. When questioned regarding the improved performance of winner **LOTTERIO**, trainer J Parsons advised that the gelding had appreciated the step up in distance today and was aided by the removal of blinkers for this start.

Race 8 SHAWEIGH MAIDEN (1600m)

PINNACLE BAY was slow to begin.

UNONUTUDELERE began awkwardly and got back.

ONTHESAUCE raced wide throughout.

HANNIBAL LECTER raced keenly in the middle stages and hung outwards throughout.

PINNACLE BAY and SO GALLANT raced in restricted room over the concluding stages.

Race 9 PORT FM 1600 MAIDEN (1600m)

WAYLEGGO and APACHE KID were slow to begin.

CLARISFORD raced keenly in the early stages.

CLARISFORD raced ungenerously near the 1400 metres for a short distance when awkwardly placed to the inside of **SHE'S GALVANISED** before being taken forward to the lead.

MIRAGE raced ungenerously for some distance passing the 1300 metres, getting its head up on a number of occasions. **SHE'S GALVANISED** raced wide through the middle stages.

I SEE FIRE raced wide without cover from the 1000 metres

CLARISFORD gave ground from the 600 metres, with **MIRAGE** and **PACO RABANNE** being inconvenienced near the 500 metres as a result.

PACO RABANNE became awkwardly placed inside the heels of SHE ROCKS near the 250 metres.

CONSOLIDATE lay inwards in the final straight and near the 100 metres placed **SHE ROCKS** and **PACO RABANNE** in restricted room, with **BAD JELLY** having to steady momentarily as a result.

WAYLEGGO underwent a post race veterinary inspection and was found to be lame in the left front leg. The connections were advised that a veterinary clearance is required prior to the gelding racing next.

When spoken to regarding the performance of favoured runner I SEE FIRE, apprentice rider S Wynne could offer no tangible excuses.

J Morris (BAD JELLY) was issued a warning under Rule 638(3)(b)(ii) for excessive use of the whip prior to the 200 metres.

Race 10 ONCEUPONATIME HANDICAP RATING 85 (1600m)

KEEP THE COURAGE was slow to begin.

UPPLAND raced keenly through the early and middle stages when leading.

Race 11 TAS ANSWERING SERVICES MILE RATING 65 (1600m)

HABITUDE contacted a heel and blundered shortly after the start.

MASTER KARSTEN was slow to begin.

REDESDALE was restrained to the rear after jumping.

STONEMASON raced wide without cover throughout.

MILLY QUE raced keenly for a short distance passing the 1400 metres.

FERAL ICE made the bend near the 1350 metres awkwardly, shifting outwards and hampering **HABITUDE**, **ZAH CHAMP** and **STONEMASON**.

When spoken to regarding the improved performance of winner REDESDALE, stable representative R Hampton reported

that the gelding which had been working well had appreciated the step up in distance today and the addition of a tongue tie.
