RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	WAIPA HIRE 1150
<p>MAQUIS (T Thornton) began awkwardly shifting out, making contact with TRIUMPH (R Elliot) which was then crowded shortly after having to be steadied.</p> <p>EL SASKYLA (V Gatu) was slow to begin.</p> <p>WINTIME (M Hills) raced ungenerously approaching the 800 metres, becoming awkwardly placed on heels having to steady, shifting out on to MAQUIS which was hampered.</p> <p>STRIKING KAY (Z Nor Azman) commenced to over-race passing the 800 metres when awkwardly placed on the heels of SUM FAVOUR (S McKay) which was steadied.</p>	

LUCK BE A LADY (U Holmquist) shifted out approaching the 400 metres, simultaneously as **WINTIME** was shifting outside that runner's heels. As a result **WINTIME** then shifted out abruptly, forcing **KITTYKITTYBANGBANG** (A Schwerin) on to **SAINT LUCIA** (K McCulloch) and **NOTA BENE** (S Collett) which were both hampered and forced wider on the track. Riders U Holmquist and M Hills were advised that they must exercise greater care in similar circumstances. **EL SASKYLA** raced ungenerously hanging in badly throughout.

Rider I Sabol (**ST REGIS**) was reminded of his obligations that he must ride his horses out to the end of the race when circumstances permit him to do so.

A Schwerin (**KITTYKITTYBANGBANG**) dropped her whip near the 100 metres.

Race 2 | **HAPPY BIRTHDAY MARK IRWIN 1400**

BIG BEN (B R Jones) was slow to begin.

C Lammass (**GUMBOOTS**) was issued with a warning for using the whip in an excessive manner prior to the 200 metres.

Race 3 | **NEW ZEALAND FARRIER ASSOCIATION 1580**

SILVERADO (S McKay) was very slow to begin (8L). Trainer Mr G Brick was advised that a warning would be placed against the gelding's barrier manners.

PRO FUMO (V Colgan) knuckled on jumping away, losing ground.

SPUR STREET VIPER (R Elliot) became awkwardly laced on the heels of **BIG TONY** (V Ravikumar) which shifted out passing the 1400 metres, with **SPUR STREET VIPER** having to steady. **V Ravikumar** was reprimanded by Stewards and advised he must exercise greater care.

MR DAVINCI (E Farr) over-raced in the early stages.

BETTERBEGOOD (R Scott) was steadied passing the 1200 metres when awkwardly placed on heels.

SPUR STREET VIPER had to briefly steady passing the 300 metres when awkwardly placed.

R Elliot (**SPUR STREET VIPER**) was spoken to advisedly regarding his whip use prior to the 200 metres.

Race 4 | **QUINLAN ELECTRICAL 1580**

Trainer Mr P Coutts was issued with a warning after presenting **LOTUS LAUD** (A Schwerin) to race without notified gear (blinkers).

ROCKET QUEEN (M Hills) was slow to begin.

FAST CATCH (S Spratt) shifted in on jumping away, making contact with **WOOSTER** (S McKay).

LOTUS LAUD raced keenly in the middle stages having to be restrained off the heels of **WOOSTER** near the 1200 metres.

A Schwerin (**LOTUS LAUD**) was issued with a warning for unnecessary use of the whip on a horse that was out of contention.

Race 5 | **TONY FABISH PANELBEATER 1150**

MIHAIA (S Collett) began awkwardly, losing ground.

SUMMER DALE (V Gatu) was steadied when placed in restricted room near the 1100 metres to the inside of **PRINCESS NICOLE** (U Holmquist) which was taken in slightly by **SHEBANG** (B Hutton). Contributing was outward movement from **SENASSY** (Z Nor Azman). J Fawcett was advised that she must exercise greater care in similar circumstances.

BUFFALO LASS (A Collett) clipped a heel of **JUD STRUNK** (J Fawcett) near the 500 metres when attempting to shift ground outwards to obtain clear running.

Race 6 | **OTL GROUP 2000**

MONARCH CHIMES (V Colgan) lay out abruptly shortly after leaving the barriers, crowding **CARDON BOY** (T Wenn) and **SHE'S ALL CLANG** (R Elliot) on to the heels of **PENTIRE BABE** (T Thornton).

When questioned regarding the performance of **MONARCH CHIMES** rider V Colgan advised that the gelding may be feeling the effects of recent racing under the impost of 60 kilograms.
