## RACE COMMENTS:

<b>Race 1</b>	<b>INTERISLANDER SUMMER FESTIVAL – 27 DECEMBER 1230</b>
<p><b>OUR MYSTERE</b> (L Innes) and <b>DAPHNE</b> (C Lammas) both jumped away awkwardly causing crowding to <b>RED PIRATE</b> (L Allpress), <b>HEART OF GRACE</b> (R Elliot) and <b>MIK JAGGER</b> (L Magorrian).</p> <p><b>COOL SPIRIT</b> (A Schwerin) and <b>OPEN ALL HOURS</b> (C Grylls) had to be steadied when crowded for room to the inside of <b>OUR MYSTERE</b> which shifted away from <b>DASHA</b> (A Collett) near the 1100 metres.</p> <p><b>RAROONEY</b> (T Thornton) got its head up and raced ungenerously passing the 1100 metres when racing three wide without cover, and was unable to obtain cover for the remainder of the race.</p> <p><b>DAPHNE</b> commenced to over-race passing the 1000 metres getting its head up, and continued to do so through the middle stages.</p> <p><b>COOL SPIRIT</b> lay in approaching the 400 metres with <b>RED PIRATE</b> having to be steadied when becoming awkwardly placed on heels.</p> <p><b>DASHA</b> was inconvenienced passing the 250 metres when crowded to the inside of <b>RAROONEY</b> which lay in.</p> <p><b>OPEN ALL HOURS</b> shifted out to obtain clear running near the 200 metres making contact with <b>RAROONEY</b> which was then inconvenienced passing the 100 metres by <b>DAPHNE</b> which lay in under pressure.</p>	
<b>Race 2</b>	<b>CAMPBELLS INFRASTRUCTURE 3YO</b>
<p><b>HUNGRY EYES</b> (L Hemi) began awkwardly.</p> <p><b>DOWRY DUTY</b> (Z Nor Azman) had to be firmly restrained to avoid the heels of <b>VOLKS LIGHTNING</b> (M McNab) near the 1000 metres.</p> <p><b>DELTA DE LAGO</b> (M Coleman) raced three wide without cover.</p> <p><b>BAMURRU</b> (L Allpress) had to be restrained when awkwardly placed on heels passing the 850 metres, then making the bend awkwardly and shifting out inconveniencing <b>NIAMH ELIZABETH</b>.</p> <p><b>HUNGRY EYES</b> and <b>BAMURRU</b> came together entering the final straight with <b>BAMURRU</b> becoming slightly unbalanced.</p>	

<b>Race 3</b>	<b>SPEIGHTS 3YO</b>
<p><b>LANCIATO</b> (O Bosson) and <b>SWISS BOUQUET</b> (L Allpress) were both slow to begin.</p> <p>Passing the 1000 metres <b>DIVINITY CROSS</b> (U Holmquist) was steadied when crossed by <b>BRILLEAUX</b> (L Magorrian).</p> <p><b>LANCIATO</b> then shifted outwards to avoid the heels of <b>DIVINITY CROSS</b> resulting in <b>BEACH BEAUTY</b> (V Colgan) being placed in restricted room approaching the bend near the 900 metres. <b>BEACH BEAUTY</b> then had to be checked after <b>LANCIATO</b> got its head up and made the bend awkwardly shifting outwards. When being checked <b>BEACH BEAUTY</b> made contact with <b>LAUBERHORN</b> (M Hills).</p> <p><b>LAUBERHORN</b> raced wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>Following the race when returning to scale <b>LAUBERHORN</b> shied and made contact with the running rail of which a portion was dislodged. <b>BLUES BREAKER</b> (T Thornton), <b>LANCIATO</b> and <b>IVY'S GOLD</b> (D Johnson) all then reacted and dislodged their respective riders. All horses and riders were uninjured.</p>	
<b>Race 4</b>	<b>HAVE YOUR FUNCTION AT ARAWA PARK 3YO</b>
<p><b>WILDFLOWER</b> (C Grylls) was slow to begin.</p> <p><b>BELLA'S EDGE</b> (B R Jones) was steadied losing ground near the 1200 metres when placed in restricted room to the inside of <b>LOLA JANE</b> (D Johnson).</p> <p><b>ALMARIE</b> (M McNab) made the bend near the 800 metres awkwardly shifting out and hampering <b>SUNNY SHINE</b>.</p> <p><b>SUNNY SHINE</b> (K Myers) raced wide without cover.</p>	
<b>Race 5</b>	<b>KIDS STAY &amp; EAT FREE @ RYDGES ROTORUA 2200</b>
<p><b>ASYLUM SEEKER</b> (M McNab) and <b>ROCK ROSE</b> (L Allpress) were slow to begin.</p> <p><b>LUCKY AFFAIR</b> (U Holmquist) over-raced when being restrained in the early stages.</p> <p><b>SUM FAVOUR</b> (D Hain) improved forward near the 1200 metres, commenced to hang badly rounding the final bend and was not persevered with. A post-race veterinary examination of <b>SUM FAVOUR</b> did not reveal any abnormality. As <b>SUM FAVOUR</b> has previously displayed unruly racing manners when racing on left-handed tracks trainer Mrs K Nicholson was advised that if the gelding was to race left-handed again it must first trial satisfactorily the left-handed way of going.</p> <p><b>ASYLUM SEEKER</b> shifted out near the 450 metres making firm contact with the hind quarters of <b>MARKWOOD</b> (L Magorrian) with <b>MARKWOOD</b> becoming unbalanced for a distance. Rider M McNab was issued with a warning.</p> <p><b>WILANZA</b> (M Cameron) had to be restrained when weakening and became awkwardly placed on the heels of <b>ASYLUM SEEKER</b> which shifted in to obtain clear running entering the final straight.</p>	
<b>Race 6</b>	<b>PLATINUM HOMES ALPHA SERIES 1400</b>
<p><b>GOLDANDDIAMONDPARK</b> (L Innes) was slow to begin.</p> <p>Rider M McNab admitted a breach of careless riding in that he permitted his mount <b>HANNIBAL LECTER</b> to shift inwards when not sufficiently clear of <b>PANELLA</b> (M Coleman) which was forced inwards crowding <b>APACHE MOON</b> (R Elliot) and <b>MR DAVINCI</b> (V Colgan) which were both checked near the 1000 metres. Also hampered as a result were <b>GOLDANDDIAMONDPARK</b> and <b>TREVITA</b> (C Lammas) which then raced ungenerously for a distance. After hearing all relevant evidence M McNab's licence to ride in races was suspended from the conclusion of racing on 22 November up to and including racing on 29 November, 5 riding days.</p> <p><b>JEDI KNIGHT</b> (B R Jones) raced wide without cover.</p> <p><b>TREVITA</b> became awkwardly placed on the heels of the weakening <b>JEDI KNIGHT</b> for a distance passing the 500 metres.</p> <p><b>MR DAVINCI</b> which was weakening was checked and blundered badly near the 450 metres. After viewing film footage at length and questioning riders V Colgan and L Innes, the rider of <b>GOLDANDDIAMONDPARK</b>, which had been racing to the outside of <b>MR DAVINCI</b>, it was found that although in the Stewards' view <b>MR DAVINCI</b> had been placed in restricted room to the inside of <b>GOLDANDDIAMONDPARK</b> a major contributing factor to the incident had been the racing manners of <b>MR DAVINCI</b>.</p>	
<b>Race 7</b>	<b>MILLENNIUM HOTELS ROTORUA 1400</b>
<p><b>PIPI BEEL</b> (O Bosson) and <b>OUR KING SWAY</b> (L Innes) were both slow to begin.</p> <p><b>ORANGE PEEL</b> (M Coleman) raced three wide without cover throughout.</p> <p><b>STACCATO</b> (C Grylls) was denied clear running passing the 200 metres having to be steadied.</p>	
<b>Race 8</b>	<b>CANTER FOR CANCER 1950</b>
<p><b>KAKAHU NELL</b> (C Grylls) and <b>IDAHO'S CHOICE</b> (S McKay) made contact on jumping away.</p> <p><b>ASCOMANNI</b> (L Allpress) over-raced in the middle stages.</p> <p><b>HAYLEY ANN</b> (K Myers) raced ungenerously when being restrained near the 1450 metres.</p> <p><b>SACRED WIND</b> (L Innes) and <b>CHAPRISE</b> (A Collett) came together entering the final straight.</p> <p>Approaching the 200 metres <b>CHAPRISE</b> had to steady momentarily when <b>HAYLEY ANN</b> shifted out.</p> <p><b>ASCOMANNI</b> and <b>CRIMSON PRINCE</b> (S Olney) raced in restricted room when weakening over the concluding stages.</p>	
<b>Race 9</b>	<b>PLATINUM HOMES ROTORUA 1950</b>
<p><b>JASMINE MAREE</b> (C Grylls) began awkwardly shifting in inconveniencing <b>LADY OONA</b> (D Johnson) which had been slow to begin.</p> <p><b>LACUSTRE</b> (K Myers) began awkwardly making contact with the hind quarters of <b>EBONY AYES</b> (T Thornton).</p>	

**SHEEMA** (C Lammas) and **INTO THE MYSTIC** (A Collett) came together on jumping away.

**EBONY AYES** had to be steadied when awkwardly placed on the heels of **JUBILANT** (M Cameron) near the 1700 metres.

**INTO THE MYSTIC** raced wide rounding the first bend.

Near the 450 metres **INTO THE MYSTIC** stepped in and made contact with the weakening **EBONY AYES** which then clipped a heel of **CRUSHER COLLINS** (L Magorrian), which was laying out, and blundered badly with **EBONY AYES** dropping back on to **ZEUS** (V Colgan) and **LADY OONA** (D Johnson) which were both badly hampered. Both **LADY OONA** and **EBONY AYES** were not persevered with for the remainder of the race.

**LACUSTRE** had a tendency to lay in when making the final bend.

When questioned regarding the performance of **SHEEMA** rider C Lammas could not offer any tangible excuse for the mare's performance but did advise that **SHEEMA** had made abnormal breathing noises on pulling up.
