RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 ULTIMATE MOTOR GROUP 1200

SAMMY'S BOY (A Collett) – slow to begin, and then was further hampered shortly after.

BOLD WARRIOR (S Spratt) – slow to begin, and then crowded shortly after having to be steadied.

LITTLE RIPPER (S Weatherley) – crowded shortly after the start losing ground.

ST REGIS (I Sabol) – began awkwardly laying in abruptly.

LONE WARRIOR (S Collett) – Trainer **D Wiles** was fined \$300 By the Judicial Committee after he presented **LONE WARRIOR** to race without the lead bag. **LONE WARRIOR** began awkwardly and lost ground. Was inclined to lay out rounding the bend.

MCCULLUM (Z Nor Azman) – the saddle on **MCCULLUM** shifted forward passing the 1000 metres placing the rider at some disadvantage for the remainder of the race.

Race 2 BAYLEYS REAL ESTATE 1200

BEWITCHED (K McCulloch) – began awkwardly losing ground.

ELIZ GARDEN (S Spratt) – raced keenly when being restrained near the 1000 metres.

BLUEBERRY SWEET (C Grylls) – raced greenly becoming unbalanced passing the 750 metres.

Race 3 TEAM PRYOR – BAYLEYS 2160

HOLD THE DREAM (S Goodman) – began awkwardly losing ground. Apprentice S Goodman was questioned in the presence of her employer, Mr R Manning, with regard to the riding tactics adopted in the race. R Manning advised that Ms Goodmans' instructions had been to ride the gelding in a rear-ward position, and further advised that she had been instructed to go to the outside of the field and improve around the final turn, as he believed this was the better part of the track. Ms Goodman confirmed she had ridden to instruction. Stewards reminded S Goodman of her obligation with regard to whip use prior to the 200 metres.

EL BANDIDO (R Elliot) – over-raced in the early and middle stages.

CARDON BOY (T Wenn) – raced keenly in the middle stages.

SPAWN OF ELAIA (C Grylls) – when questioned regarding the performance of the mare rider C Grylls could offer no excuse. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormality. Trainer G Opie undertook to advise Stewards if anything should become apparent in the days subsequent. Further adding it was their intention to continue on with the mare's current preparation.

Race 4 MARKS EWEN AND ASSOCIATES 1400

RUSSIAN ROULETTE (S Collett) - slow to begin.

CREY ROSE (R Scott) – began awkwardly.

CALL ME BOB (K McCulloch) – began awkwardly. Lost left front plate during the running.

INTO THE MYSTIC (A Collett) – began awkwardly. Raced greenly when placed under pressure in the final straight.

RIDDLE (A Schwerin) – raced keenly in the early stages.

Race 5 CAPITAL TRACTORS 1400

TITANIUM LADY (R Elliot) – steadied passing the 400 metres when placed in restricted room. When questioned regarding the disappointing performance rider R Elliot advised Stewards that **TITANIUM LADY** had raced keenly in the early and middle stages, and this may have had a negative effect on the mare finishing her race off. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any apparent abnormality. Trainer G Rogerson advised Stewards that the mare would now be spelled.

PRAIRIE CREEK (C Grylls) - lay out when placed under pressure in the final straight.

Race 6 WAIKATO BRANCH NZ FARRIERS ASSOCIATION 1600

WHISTLE BLOWER (A Collett) – slow to begin.

HONOURABLE DRAGON (T Thornton) – began awkwardly making contact with REMIND ME AGAIN and becoming unbalanced.

KEEN TO KEEPER (U Holmquist) – over-raced in the early stages.
