RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	Fell Engineering 2100
ZAFRENZY (S Weatherley) – crowded when leaving the barriers. Steadied passing the 800 metres when awkwardly placed inside the heels of SMEDLEY which lay in. Held up for a distance approaching the 400 metres.	
IRISH GEM (S Spratt) – raced wide until obtaining cover passing the 1400 metres.	
SMEDLEY (L Magorrian) – made contact near the 400 metres becoming briefly unbalanced.	
LORD AND MASTER (D Johnson) – lay in across heels near the 50 metres.	

Race 2	Polwarth Design 1600
<p>JUSTRUSH (R Scott) – dislodged Rider Apprentice R Scott when commencing the preliminary and galloped a distance before being late scratched on veterinary advice at 12.43pm. R Scott was uninjured.</p> <p>LIBRETTI (D Johnson) – hampered on jumping away, losing ground.</p> <p>THE TETIAN TITAN (A Sims) – hampered on jumping away.</p> <p>UPANDGO (A Collett) – hampered near the 1400 metres when crowded by SHARP ELLE (S Spratt) which shifted in abruptly. Rider S Spratt was reprimanded and advised she must exercise greater care.</p> <p>WHO DARES WINS (L Magorrian) – raced ungenerously in the early to middle stages when being steadied.</p> <p>ORTONA (S Weatherley) – Apprentice Rider S Weatherley reported that the saddle had shifted back during the running placing him in a disadvantage.</p> <p>ANGEL VAN HAARLEM – When questioned regarding the performance of the mare Rider G Cooksley could offer no excuses. ANGEL VAN HAARLEM underwent a subsequent veterinary examination which could find no obvious abnormality. Trainer P Williams advised that ANGEL VAN HAARLEM had got further back than intended.</p>	
Race 3	Harcourts Just Rentals 1000
<p>PRINCESS ANASTASIA (S Weatherley) – trainer Mr J Price was fined \$50 by the Judicial Committee after he presented the filly to race with the incorrect saddle cloth. PRINCESS ANASTASIA was a little slow to begin.</p> <p>COMMAND ROYALE (T Thornton) – was a little slow to begin</p> <p>ALWAYS EXPLOSIVE (A Schwerin) – was inclined to hang outwards when making the bend.</p> <p>ATTITUDZEVERYTHING (C Grylls) – raced greenly when placed under pressure in the final straight.</p> <p>PRIZED PINS (S Spratt) – inconvenienced near the 300 metres. Crowded and briefly steadied approaching the 200 metres by ALWAYS EXPLOSIVE (A Schwerin) which shifted out abruptly when the rider was changing her whip hand. S Spratt was reminded of her obligations and advised she must ride her horses out to the end of a race when there are circumstances that permit her to do so.</p>	
Race 4	Bear Morgan At Harcourts 1400
<p>VINCENT STREET (D Danis) – was slow away, crowded shortly after having to be steadied.</p> <p>IN FLIGHT (S Weatherley) - shifted out passing the 900 metres, made contact and then raced in restricted room for a short distance. Unable to obtain clear running in the final straight.</p> <p>ROCKNROLLA (U Holmquist) – attempting to improve into a marginal run to the inside of CHARLIE FARLEY approaching the 350 metres, and was then further crowded by IN FLIGHT (S Weatherley) which shifted out. As a result ROCKNROLLA had to steady when becoming awkwardly placed on heels and then shifted out to obtain clear running. Apprentice S Weatherley was severely reprimanded by Stewards and further advised a warning would be placed on his record.</p>	

Race 5	Cowleys Hire Centre 1200
<p>DAZZLING LADY (S Spratt) – became restless in the Parade Ring and reared over. The mare then underwent a veterinary examination when arriving at the barriers and was passed fit to race. Over-raced in the early and middle stages. S Spratt was questioned regarding the performance and could offer no tangible excuses with DAZZLING LADY undergoing a subsequent veterinary examination which could find no abnormalities.</p> <p>SEGENHOE (D Johnson) - made contact with the front of the barrier stalls and was removed to undergo a veterinary examination and was cleared fit to race.</p> <p>COUNTING HOUSE (B Hutton) – was slow away. Hampered when crowded near the 900 metres.</p> <p>LETMEGO (A Jones) – made the bend awkwardly near the 900 metres.</p> <p>I PACO (V Colgan) – hampered when crowded near the 900 metres.</p> <p>KILMAC (D Prastiyou) – got its head up when the pace steadied, making the 800 metre bend awkwardly.</p> <p>HONOUR PRINCESS (C Lammas) lay out under pressure in the final straight.</p>	
Race 6	Harcourts Optimize Group Open 1200
<p>RYAN MARK (M Coleman) – began awkwardly. When questioned regarding the performance of the gelding M Coleman advised that after beginning awkwardly RYAN MARK had got further back than intended and had finished the race off well before coming to the end of its run near the 100 metres.</p> <p>STOLEN DANCE (S Spratt) – over-raced in the early and middle stages.</p> <p>HASSELHOOF (M Cameron) – over-raced in the early and middle stages.</p>	
Race 7	Harcourts Bream Bay 1600
<p>SASANOF'S HERO (BR Jones) – slow away. Unable to obtain clear running until near the 250 metres.</p> <p>ANNABELINDA (L Magorrian) – slow away.</p> <p>SO IT GOES (S Spratt) – raced wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>CAMBRIDGE (M Cameron) – held up for clear running until near the 300 metres.</p> <p>GREENCAST (A Collett) – briefly held up passing the 300 metres.</p> <p>OPULENT (J Fawcett) underwent a veterinary examination after becoming tailed off in the home straight which could find no abnormality. The Stable undertook to report anything that may become apparent in days subsequent.</p>	
Race 8	Pierces Flooring Xtra 2100
<p>SO TRUE (B Hutton) – slow away (3L).</p> <p>TAMA AKARANA (Z Nor Azman) – began awkwardly, losing ground.</p> <p>FIAMETTE (L Innes) – got its head up when being steadied off heels leaving the straight on the first occasion. L Innes was questioned regarding the performance and was unable to offer any excuse. Co-trainer C Gibbs advised that the mare is unlikely to be persevered with as a racing proposition.</p>	

FINNS HALO (S Weatherley) – held up for a distance entering the final straight. When questioned regarding the performance S Weatherley was unable to offer any excuses other than being held up early entering the final straight. Co-trainer C Gibbs advised that the gelding's future career is likely to be as a jumper.

STOKED ME (A Sims)– Rider **A Sims** was fined \$100 under the Minor Infringement Schedule after failing to claim down to her published riding weight (published weight 52.5kg, rode 53.5kg - claimed 2kg). Miss A Sims was given permission to ride STOKED ME overweight after there was no suitable replacement rider.
