**Bleeders:** Race 2 **NOVA SCOTIA** – stood down for mandatory three months.

#### **RACE COMMENTS:**

Race 1 LOWE SCHOLLUM & JONES LTD STAYER (2100m)

**ZEDBEE** (T Johnson) – slow to begin.

**KING OF ROCK** (R Goldsbury) - over-raced in the home straight on the first occasion and then jumped the crossing. **KING OF ROCK** continued to over-race in the back straight so was taken wide to avoid heels.

**HAMILTONIAN** (L Allpress) - shifted out under pressure over the final stages and had to be straightened.

**WINDERMERE LAD** (D Hirini) - hung inwards near the 200 metres and bumped with **BAD BOY BROWN** (R Myers), which shifted out.

Race 2 THE STEWARDS STAYER (2100m)

APLOMB (N Teeluck) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages when wide without cover.

**NOVA SCOTIA** (B Hutton) - finished some distance last. Rider B Hutton advised the saddle had slipped forward marginally. **Trainer S Brown** subsequently reported the mare had bled in the tie up stalls after the race so is subject to the mandatory three month stand down period. S Brown advised that **NOVA SCOTIA** will be retired.

The whip of **E Farr** (SELWYN) accidentally came into contact with **R Myers** (SANJARA) when both runners came together over the final stages.

**RED SUNSET** (L Hemi) had to be steadied going into the back straight when **APLOMB** (N Teeluck) shifted in. **N Teeluck** was advised to exercise care.

**SHARE THE BLAME** (Z Moki) - raced wide without cover throughout.

**ROCKY** (J Parkes) – When questioned into the disappointing run J Parkes was of the opinion the gelding did not see out the distance but nevertheless was disappointing. A subsequent vet check was clear.

Following Race2, after some drying and consultation with riders, the surface was upgraded to Heavy (10).

#### Race 3

#### **GAVELHOUSE.COM STAYERS (2100m)**

**CHOCOLATE FISH** (T Johnson) – was removed from the stalls and underwent and passed a veterinary inspection after several runners charged the gates prior to the start. Starter G Phillips advised stewards that he had failed to ensure the power source was engaged when attempting to effect a start. He was advised that in future he is expected to ensure that all necessary procedures are followed prior to the start.

**KIT** (Z Moki) - slow away.

CARAJEAN (R Goldsbury) - shifted out near the post on the first round and had to be straightened

**HAVATASTE** (R Myers) - shifted in when being steadied passing the post on the first round.

MA BELLE KATE (L Allpress) - shifted out abruptly to avoid heels near the 800 metres and in doing so dictated AWESOME PRINCESS (K Smith) wider.

**KINGS KITE** (B Hutton) – rider reported the gelding hung in throughout the race.

#### Race 4

#### **TARARUA ALLIANCE SPRINT (1200m)**

**DUCHESS DARCI** (E Farr) – slow away.

**DESTINY ONE** (R Elliot) - raced three wide without cover throughout.

# Race 5

# **SCANPOWER LTD SPRINT (1200m)**

**BEADLE** (N Teeluck) – slow away.

**LUCROR FESTINATIO** (R Elliot) - when questioned into the disappointing run, rider advised that the mare would be better suited to a more rain affected going.

MISS FI (T Johnson) – was obliged to make its run wide rounding the turn.

**WILDCARD** (D Bradley) - raced wide throughout in search of better footing.

#### Paco 6

# **BOTTLE-O PAHIATUA SPRING (1200m)**

**SAUVIGNON** (C-M Waddell) - began awkwardly and lost ground.

 $\textbf{GERONIMO} \; (\textbf{T Johnson}) - \textbf{slow away}.$ 

**TRENDING** (J Riddell) – began very awkwardly, unbalancing rider the rider.

**OKAY JACK** (H Tinsley) – raced wide throughout.

**NEMESIS** (S McKay) – when questioned into the disappointing run, rider advised that the gelding was unsuited to the holding going and may prefer more ground.

**STYLISH ACHIEVER** (R Elliot) – when questioned into the disappointing run, rider had no excuse. Connections reported on cooling down, the mare was showing signs of being in season and also tying up.

## Race 7

## THE PRESIDENTS 1400 (1400m)

KEILIB (H Andrew) - was hampered at the start and got back.

ITSA TRU STORY (M Singh) - shifted out abruptly on jumping away.

**PASS IT ON** (L Allpress) – rider reported the gelding did not feel comfortable in its action and was inclined to hang throughout. A subsequent vet check was clear.

**SABER** (R Elliot) – over-raced early, and was disappointing. The rider was of the opinion the gelding may be feeling the effects of recent racing. A post-race veterinary inspection revealed a slow recovery rate.

# Race 8 FARMLANDS PALMERSTON NORTH (1600m)

**MOUNTAIN PRINCESS** (L Allpress) was slow away. L Allpress was unable to offer any tangible excuse for the mare's poor performance.

OFF ROADING (R Elliot) - refused to load so was late scratched. Connections were advised that the gelding must trial.

**AMARONE** (S Collett) – was tightened at the start and got back, shifted in under pressure over the final stages bumping **DAL LAUREON.** 

**CUZZIE CHARLIE** (S McKay) – rider reported that the gelding was never comfortable in the holding track conditions.

**SUSSED** (E Farr) – hung inwards in the home straight and had to be straightened near the finish.

# Race 9 THE MARJORIE REICHENBACH MEMORIAL (1600m)

KING MAX (D Hirini) – was slow away.

**LUCKY SNIP** (M Tanaka) – raced wide without cover throughout. The rider reported the mare may be better suited to looser footing.

**H Andrew** (LOVETOKEEPHIM) - was issued with a warning under Rule 638(1)(d) after she allowed her mount to shift inwards shortly after the start tightening **EVADIR LA BALA** (Z Moki) which lost its position and **COOL SPIRIT** (S Collett) which was tightened.
