Race 1	VESPA STANDING AT WELLFIELD LODGE 2YO JUVENILE PLATE 790 (790 metres)			
SWISS PRECISION (M du Plessis) – lay in early in the home straight, had to be straightened.				
BEACHWOOD (J	Riddell) – raced very greenly throughout.			
Race 2	WANGANUI STEELFORMERS 2040 (2040 metres)			
IFFITEL (L Allpress) – Underwent veterinary inspection at the start, cleared to run.				
TICKET CLIPPER	(C Grylls) – slow away.			
	E LS (D Bradley) – over-raced in the early and middle stages, rider D Bradley reported that the gelding had inish and may have choked down during the running after racing fiercely.			

N Teeluck (APLOMB) – was advised to exercise more care after taking hold of his mount sharply near the 1400 metres resulting in **ROD'S LINCOLN** (J Riddell) and **KING OBERON** (S McKay) having to be steadied.

ROD'S LINCOLN (J Riddell) – steadied 1400 metres, held up for a short distance near the 400 metres.

KING OBERON (S McKay) – steadied off heels when the pace eased near the 1400 metres.

KEILIB (H Andrew) – obliged to race three wide without cover throughout.

TIME BOMB (M McNab) - angled out near the 100 metres to improve.

Race 3 WANGANUI CHRONICLE 1200 (1200 metres)

FIERTE (C Grylls) – began awkwardly and hampered STROLLING VAGABOND.

STROLLING VAGABOND (M Cameron) – hampered at start.

THE BANDITO (J Riddell) – eased off heels in the back straight then commenced to race fiercely, hung outwards rounding the turn and was not persevered with. A subsequent veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormality. Connections were advised that **THE BANDITO** must trial prior to its next start. **Trainer J Bary** advised that he would alter the gear on **THE BANDITO** prior to trialing and this may include the removal of blinkers.

M Tanaka (HEISENBERG) – was issued with a warning under Rule 638(1)(d) after he angled his mount inwards near the 1000 metres dictating SPIKER (K McCulloch) inwards into the line of THE BANDITO (J Riddell) which was steadied. After interviewing riders, Stewards took into account THE BANDITO'S tendency to over-race prior to the interference when assessing the degree of carelessness.

SPIKER (K McCulloch) – dictated inwards near the 1000 metres.

THE DUKE OF JAZZ – rider L Allpress was to recommend to connections that blinkers be applied prior to its next start as the gelding lacked concentration.

Race 4 CORO ANGEL SYNDICATE OPN 1200 (1200 metres)

GINNER HART (N Teeluck) - shifted in on jumping away and bumped SCAPOLO.

GYPSY FAIR (A Chan) - was unable to take advantage of a run which presented adjacent to rail near the 250 metres, was then held up for some distance prior to being angled outwards near the 75 metre mark.

HEAVENS KEEP (J Parkes) – hampered 150 metres, tightened near the 75 metres.

NORTH AND SOUTH (M Tanaka) - slow away, tightened near the 75 meters.

SCAPOLO (Z Moki) – tightened after the start, steadied off heels near the 800 metres, bumped and became unbalanced near the 75 metres.

SLICE OF CLASS (K McCulloch) - shifted in under pressure hampering the weakening HEAVENS KEEP near the 150 metres.

GINNER HART (N Teeluck) and SALAMANCA (D Hirini) - bumped near the 800 metres.

Apprentice Jockey A Chan (GYPSY FAIR) - admitted a breach of careless riding under Rule 638(1)(d) after angling his mount outwards over the final stages, tightening NORTH AND SOUTH (M Tanaka) and HEAVENS KEEP (J Parkes) which was then dictated outwards on to SCAPOLO (Z Moki), which became unbalanced. After submissions **Apprentice Jockey Chan** had his licence to ride in races suspended from the conclusion of racing on Saturday, 10 September 2016 up to and including Saturday, 24 September (4 days).

Race 5 THE O'LEARY'S FILLIES STAKES (1200 metres)

SHELLEZ ACE (S McKay) - charged the gate prior to the start and returned to the enclosure with blood present in both nostrils. A subsequent veterinary inspection confirmed nasal trauma and the filly was not considered a bleeder.

EUPHORIA (K McCulloch) - over-raced when wide without cover in the early and middle stages and made the bend

awkwardly, dictated inwards near the 200 metres.

QUEEN OF ZEALAND (L Hemi) - held up and had to be angled outwards near the 200 metres to improve.

LUNA ROSSA (L Allpress) - lugged inwards under pressure in the home straight and had to be straightened passing the 200 metres.

M du Plessis (MCPHOEBE) - was of the opinion the filly would prefer better going.

Race 6 TAKE IT EASY TOURS 1340 (1340 metres)

LUCY LIU (N Teeluck) – checked at the start with rider Teeluck becoming unbalanced and almost becoming dislodged.

MASTER PLATINUM (J Riddell) - bumped at the start with rider becoming unbalanced.

O'REILLY'S DANCER (D Bradley) - steadied final stages when well back and bumped with TIGER TIM (J Parkes).

TIGER TIM (J Parkes) – bumped near the 200 metres.

WOODEN EDGE (V Gatu) - hung outwards from near the 800 placing the rider at a disadvantage for the remainder. Had to be continuously straightened in the home straight when hanging out.

NEW YORK MINUTE (L Allpress) - over-raced early, held up early in the home straight.

TIFFANY'S (L Hemi) - held up adjacent to the rail near the 150 metres prior to gaining clear running over the final 75 metres.

STAR O'FRAAJ (M Tanaka) – wide throughout, finished some distance last. A subsequent veterinary inspection was clear.

Race 7 HS DYKE WANGANUI GUINEAS 1340 (1340 metres)

NACHOS (M Tanaka) - was steadied near the 800 metres when the pace ahead eased and went back on to **TECHNICIAN** (M du Plessis), which also had to be steadied.

TECHNICIAN (M du Plesssis) - momentarily steadied near the 800 metres.

WHITNEY - L Allpress reported the filly raced greenly throughout and had to be steadied off the heels of DON BLANCO (D Bradley) near the turn when that runner shifted out.

D Bradley (DON BLANCO) – admitted a breach of careless riding under Rule 638(1)(d) in that he angled his mount outwards passing the 600 metres when not clear of CALLIDORA (K McCulloch), which was checked, and HIGHLAD (M Cameron) which was buffeted for several strides. After submissions **D** Bradley had his licence to ride in races suspended from the conclusion of racing on Saturday, 10 September up to and including racing on Saturday, 24 September (4 days).

CALLIDORA (K McCulloch) – checked passing the 600 metres.

HIGHLAD (M Cameron) – buffeted for several strides passing the 600 metres.

QUANTUM (C Grylls) - hung outwards over extra ground in the home straight.

Race 8 DAVE HOSKIN CARRIERS 1590 (1590 metres)

WAZUZU (K McCulloch) – slow away, home straight raced up onto heels inside the final 100 metres then had to change ground to improve.

CULLISTSER (D Bradley) – slow away, held up early in the home straight.

CYCLONE TRACY (R Harris) – slow away.

STEELFIX (J Bassett) shifted out shortly after the start resulting in ALCALDESA (V Gatu) being tightened and getting back. **STEELFIX** had to be steadied into the first bend when over-racing and continued to over-race in the back straight so was taken wide. ALCALDESA (V Gatu) tightened shortly after the start and got back.

HIDDEN AGENDA (Z Moki) – bumped after the start.

CANCELLARA (T Johnson) bumped after the start.

ALCALDESA (V Gatu) raced wide throughout.

THE WOLF (L Allpress) - when questioned into the run **rider L Allpress** said the gelding was disappointing and had no excuse. A subsequent veterinary inspection was clear.

SHE'S POPPY (S McKay) was held up early in the home straight.

DE GAULLE (M Cameron) - held up for a short distance early in the home straight.
