SUPPLEMENTARY:

Race 7 - Waverley Thursday 29th September

H Andrew (ITSALLBELT) was issued with a warning under [Rule 638 (1)(d)] in that she allowed her mount to shift inwards passing the 400 metres when not fully clear of SARABI (K McCulloch) which was checked.

RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 BAY FORD NZ PUNTER OF THE YEAR 1200

NOMISMA – K McCulloch replaced L Innes who was unable to make the weight. L Innes was fined \$200 under the Minor Infringement Schedule.

BANNOCKBURN (R Hannam) – became fractious in the barriers and after being removed to undergo a veterinary inspection was declared a late scratching on veterinary advice. Connections were advised that a warning is placed against the gelding with regard to it barrier manners.

JOANNA (T Johnson) - slow away.

IN ANOTHER LIFE (R Myers) - slow away.

Apprentice H Andrew and Rider S Collett were questioned regarding the riding tactics employed on their respective mounts MISS APPLETON and MORSE CODE.

MISS APPLETON - Apprentice Andrew advised that her instructions were to lead from the No. 1 barrier draw as per the mare's normal racing pattern. Miss Andrew concurred and agreed with the stewards view that once clearly headed by MORSE CODE a better option would have been to attempt to take a sit behind that runner.

MORSE CODE – Rider S Collett advised that the mare had shown good early speed being able to head MISS APPLETON but agreed that in the circumstances a better option would have been to attempt to sit off MISS APPLETON rather than engage that runner in the speed duel that had eventuated.

Race 2 MARDIGRAS EVENT HIRE 1200

HOSKINS (T Johnson) - bumped heavily at the start.

IFF SO HAPPENS (N Teeluck) - bumped heavily at the start. Hampered at the 900 metres.

LOLA JANE (C Lammas) - slow away.

UNDERCOVER (S McKay) – slow away.

MY TOMMY (J Parkes) – slow away.

SABOTAGE (D Johnson) and **ALWAYS READY** (K McCulloch) were both crowded and checked shortly after the start when FIERTE (R Elliot) shifted inwards when not sufficiently clear. **R Elliot** admitted a resultant charge of careless riding with his license to ride in races being suspended by the Judicial Committee from 6th - 13th October inclusive (4 days)

SABOTAGE (D Johnson) - crowded and checked passing the 1100 metres. Made contact on several occasions with GETALONGHOME CINDY when attempting to obtain clear running passing the 200 metres.

ALWAYS READY (K McCulloch) - crowded and checked passing the 1100 metres.

FIERTE (R Elliot) raced ungenerously when being restrained near the 1000 metres. Raced ungenerously rounding the turn near the 500 metres.

SACRED SURFER (L Innes) – commenced to over-race after being crossed passing the 1000 metres shifting outwards shortly after to avoid the heels of HOSKINS hampering IFF SO HAPPENS and GETALONGHOME CINDY near the 900 metres.

GETALONGHOME CINDY (A Jones) - hampered at the 900 metres. Raced wide without cover. Bumped on several occasion passing the 200 metres.

BLUETWENTTWO (S Collett) - over-raced in the early and middle stages.

FOIBLES (T Thornton) - raced wide without cover throughout.

Race 3 HAWAIIAN AIRLINES FASHION IN THE FIELD 2100

KEILIB (J Parkes) - began awkwardly.

TIFFANY'S (C Grylls) - slow away.

ON PAROLE (K McCulloch) - began awkwardly and bumped.

DRAGON BEAUTY (T Johnson) - slow away. Hampered 1700 metres.

JACKSSTAR (C Lammas) - raced three wide throughout.

BEE TEE JUNIOR (B Hutton) - raced ungenerously and lay inwards crowding SANJARA near the 1700 metres. When being corrected by its rider got its head up, shifting outwards across the heels of KEILIB, hampering DRAGON BEAUTY.

SANJARA (R Myers) – crowded near the 1700 metres. Shifted ground to obtain clear running passing the 100 metres.

BIG DREAMER (V Colgan) – Gave ground quickly from the 600 metres badly hampering SHE'S POPPY near the 500 metres and being eased down by its rider in the final straight. A post-race veterinary inspection found the mare to be suffering from cardiac arrhythmia. As this is the second occasion on which the mare has suffered from this affliction trainer P Mirabelli was advised that a full veterinary clearance including satisfactory ECG results would be required before racing again.

SHE'S POPPY (S McKay) - hampered 500 metres.

EL LUCHADOR (S Collett) - lay in under pressure making contact with LINCOLN BAY passing the 200 metres.

LINCOLN BAY (J Riddell) - bumped passing the 200 metres.

Race 4 TUMU ITM MILE

STRADA CAVALLO (M Coleman) – kicked out in the enclosure making contact with the rail. Underwent a veterinary inspection being passed fit to run. Raced three wide in the early stages. Entering the final straight near the 350 metres had to be steadied away from the heels of BOWIE which was shifting outwards to obtain clear running. CHENILE was also hampered as a result. M Cameron was advised to exercise care. When questioned regarding the poor performance rider M Coleman advised that the mare had become stirred up prior to the race and had failed to handle todays Slow 8 conditions. A post-race veterinary inspection did not reveal any abnormality.

THORN PASS (K McCulloch) - was tightened and lost ground at the start.

CHENILE (S Weatherley) - slow away. Hampered at the 300 metres. When questioned regarding performance apprentice S Weatherley was of the opinion the mare was now looking for more ground.

BOWIE (M Cameron) – made the first bend awkwardly and then had a tendency to over-race.

Race 5 RED BADGE SPRING SPRINT

PERSUASIVE – declared a late scratching at 2.34pm on veterinary advice after suffering lacerations to the nasal area and pulling a plate when being transported to todays meeting.

BLATHWAYT (R Myers) – slow away. Hung outwards under pressure throughout the home straight.

ANTONIO LOMBARDO (S McKay) - raced three wide from the 800 metres. Shifted inwards near the 200 metres simultaneously as BLATHWAYT lay out resulting in REILLY LINCOLN and ADMIRAL being crowded for several strides.

REILLY LINCOLN (K McCulloch) - crowded near the 200 metres.

ADMIRAL (A Jones) - crowded near the 200 metres.

Race 6 SACRED FALLS HAWKE'S BAY GUINEAS

JON SNOW – D Johnson replaced J Riddell who was unable to make the weight. J Riddell was fine \$250 by the Judicial Committee.

UGO FOSCOLO (M Coleman) - slow away and then bumped. Commenced to race ungenerously near the 1300 metres continuing to do so for some distance. When questioned rider M Coleman advised that the gelding had raced erratically and had not felt comfortable in today's track conditions. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any abnormality.

KINGSMAN (M Du Plessis) - bumped at the start. Had to be steadied to avoid the heels of UGO FOSCOLO passing the 800 metres. Required veterinary treatment post-race when showing signs of an attack of colic.

WYNDSPELLE (V Colgan) - had a tendency to over-race in the early stages.

HEROIC VALOUR (M Cameron) – rider M Cameron was unable to offer any excuses advising that the colt had felt reluctant to hit out freely once placed under pressure and in his opinion may have been pinching itself. M Cameron further advised that it was his understanding blinkers would be added for the colt's next start.

Race 7 STELLA ARTOIS 1400

FALCONS REACH - late scratched on veterinary advice at 3.54pm after being injured in the tie-up stalls. A veterinary clearance is now required prior to next racing.

DOLCETTO (S Collett) - slow away.

ROAD TRIP (V Colgan) – commenced to race fiercely near the 1200 metres and continued to do so in the middle stages making contact with GARCON DEUX approaching the 1000 metres with GARCON DEUX shifting outwards clipping a heel of HOKEY POKEY and blundering. Also hampered was CANTARE.

GARCON DEUX (R Goldsbury) clipped a hell and blundered near the 1000 metres.

CANTARE (K McCulloch) – Hampered near the 1000 metres. Checked near the 500 metres when racing in restricted room between ROAD TRIP and DOLCETTO.

LUCYINRIO (D Johnson) underwent a post-race veterinary inspection after rider D Johnson felt there may have been something amiss with no obvious abnormality being apparent.

Race 8 LIVAMOL CLASSIC

Start was delayed by approx. 5 minutes after BOHEMIAN LILY required farrier attention behind the barriers.

BENZINI (R Myers) - slow away.

JULINSKY PRINCE (J Parkes) – over-raced in the early stages.

FARM BOY (S Spratt) – was obliged to take the first corner four wide without cover. Had to be steadied when placed in restricted room between BATTLE TIME and HUMIDOR near the 900 metres.

HASSELHOOF (M Cameron) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages. Briefly held up rounding the bend near the 600 metres.

PLATINUM COMMAND (J Riddell) - had to be steadied off the heels of RASA LILA approaching the 1700 metres.

AUTHENTIC PADDY (R Hannam) - over-raced in the early and middle stages.

MIME (M Coleman) - raced wide without cover from the 1400 metres. When questioned, rider M Coleman advised that the mare had received a tough trip and may have choked down during the running. A post-race veterinary inspection did not detect any obvious abnormality.

HUMIDOR (M Du Plessis) - commenced to hang inwards going into the bend near the 800 metres and continued to lay inwards in the home straight, shifting back to the inside of the track.

BATTLE TIME (V Colgan) – when questioned regarding the performance of BATTLE TIME V Colgan was of the opinion the horse did not see out the distance of todays race.

Race 9 HASTINGS-HEART OF HAWKE'S BAY 1400

EIGHT POINTS – M Du Plessis replaced L Innes who was unable to make the weight.

WAIT A SEC (J Bassett) - began awkwardly with rider becoming unbalanced.

THE ARK (J Parkes) - tightened at the start.

MASSOFDASH (S Collett) – clipped a heel of TAHNI DANCER shortly after the start when crossing the junction onto the course proper after shifting away from PROFILE which shifted outwards slightly. R Myers was advised to exercise greater care. Following the race rider S Collet reported the mare felt a little indifferent in its action, with a post-race veterinary examination failing to reveal any obvious abnormality.

WOODEN EDGE (M Hills) – when questioned regarding the poor performance rider M Hills advised the gelding had hung from the 800 metres and was of the opinion may be feeling the effects of recent racing. Trainer C Wood advised that WOODEN EDGE would now be spelled.

HUNTA PENCE (V Colgan) – shifted ground inwards passing the 200 metres to obtain clear running.

Race 10 BOSTOCK NEW ZEALAND SPRING CARNIVAL FAREWELL

ROCK ON (L Innes) - slow to begin (5 lengths). Lay in under pressure early in the final straight.

BEADLE (N Teeluck) – slow away.

O'REILLY'S DANCER (J Riddell) – slow away. Made contact with the hind quarters of TAVIGARDE near the 250 metres

CHEQUERED FLAG (V Colgan) - steadied going into the first turn when over-racing, crowding CHIC onto TAVIGARDE near the 1300 metres.

TAVIGARDE (R Elliot) – raced keenly early. Bumped 1300 metres.

CHIC (R Myers) – Crowded 1300 metres and then commenced to over-race.

MAITRE DU JEU (M Hills) - held up rounding the turn near the 500 metres.

FISTFULOFDOLLARS (J Parkes) – when questioned into the poor performance rider J Parkes advised that in his opinion the mare would now be better suited over more ground.
