Race 1	SPEIGHT'S MID ALE MAIDEN (1400m)
GEMMA JANE (K Williams) – slow to begin.	
RUAIRI (J Morris) – began awkwardly and got back, raced keenly for a short distance passing the 800 metres and improved wide from that point on.	
LILY JEAN (C Barnes) – began awkwardly and got back.	
NESTA (L Callaway) – shifted in on jumping bumping with inside runner.	
ATHONIS (R Cuneen) – buffeted shortly after the start.	
POKER PLAYER (M Chui) – began awkwardly shifting outwards on jumping making contact with the outside runner, raced keenly early stages, placed in restricted room and steadied near the 1000 metres, continued to over race for some distance.	
MISTY TRELLA (B Moore) – raced wide in the early stages.	
SHE ROCKS (K Mudhoo) – over raced for a short distance passing the 1100 metres.	
ZAKYNTHOS (S Wynne) raced keenly for short distance passing 1000 metres getting head up on a number of occasions.	
HELL BOUND (T Moseley) – raced wide throughout.	
ASPEN LASS (C Johnson) – held up for a short distance passing the 600 metres.	

MOST LIKELY (S Muniandy) – awkwardly placed on heels near the 500 metres and had to steady.	
Race 2	SI RACING AWARDS 16 SEPTEMBER MAIDEN (1400m)
BERLINGER (L Callaway) – crowded at the start losing ground.	
TAKE THE HIGH ROAD (S Muniandy) – crowded at the start losing ground.	
ASOMA (K Mudhoo) – shifted in abruptly at the start hampering inside runners, raced wide from the 900 metres.	
POWERBALL (R Cuneen) – hampered shortly after the start.	
DOMAINE (J Morris) – got its head up when being steadied to take a trail passing the 1200 metres and then raced ungenerously for a distance.	
MAHER MOMENT (S Wynne) – held up when awkwardly placed on heels near the 400 metres.	
Race 3	STALLION TENDER – RICARTONPARK.CO.NZ RATING 75 (1200m)
CANTILENA (C Johnson) – raced keenly in the early stages.	
BAZZ (R Cuneen) – raced keenly in the early stages.	
SON OF MAHER (S Wynne) – began awkwardly, held up early in the run home and had to shift ground outwards passing the 250 metres, lay outwards near the 100 metres having to be straightened.	
RIVERTAIN COUP – rider H Bennet in the presence of her employer M Pitman was reminded of her obligations to ride her mounts out fully.	
Race 4	NEW ZEALAND BLOODSTOCK OPEN SPRINT (1000m)
SUPER TROUPER (B Moore) – began awkwardly.	
RED DIRT GIRL (S Muniandy) – lay in shortly after the start momentarily crowding FIRST SERVE .	
FIRST SERVE (S Wynne) – momentarily crowded after the start.	
Race 5	GAVELHOUSE.COM THREE-YEAR-OLD (1000m)
RIO TENNILLE (K Mudhoo) – lost the right front plate in the birdcage and raced without it. Began awkwardly.	
WAIPARI LAD (H Bennet) – began awkwardly.	
JUST (R Bishop) – began awkwardly.	
WIZE ACT (S Wynne) – shifted outwards at the start crowding LA DIOSA and DEZZIES DELIGHT , buffeted between runners shortly after the start having to be restrained and got back, held up for some distance passing the 600 metres, shifted inwards to obtain clear running near the 350 metres.	
WHAT CHOUX WANT (M Chui) – hampered at the start.	
DEZZIES DELIGHT (K Kalychurun) – shifted inwards shortly after the start hampering LA DIOSA , momentarily inconvenienced 300 metres.	
LA DIOSA (R Cuneen) – buffeted between runners at the start, raced keenly for a short distance near the 700 metres, steadied momentarily passing the 250 metres when awkwardly placed on heels.	
ZIGWIG (T Moseley) – lay outwards in the home straight.	
STARVOIA (C Johnson) – shifted inwards passing the 100 metres.	
Race 6	CHRISTCHURCH CASINO RATING 85 (1400m)
SAPERAVIOUS (K Kalychurun) – began awkwardly.	
KINGS PAL (S Wynne) – restrained to the rear on jumping, rider dropped her whip passing the 200 metres.	

DIAMOND EDGE (R Yatim) – raced keenly and wide in the early stages, bumped with **JACK'S RUN** near the 1000 metres, , shifted outwards near the 300 metres. R Yatim was advised to make a greater effort to straighten his mounts earlier.

JACK'S RUN (K Williams) – bumped at 1000 metres.

KEEPA TRAMP (R Cuneen) – inconvenienced when shifted wider early in the run home.

Race 7 | **PRYDE'S EASIFEED RATING 65 (1400m)**

The start of this race was officially delayed two minutes on TAB request.

MULBERRY (R Cuneen) – slow to begin, shifted in over the concluding stages under a hard ride, brushed with **COLCHESTER** inside the final 50 metres.

ALYTH (C Johnson) – blundered at the start, held up for some distance passing the 600 metres, not afforded clear racing room until inside the 150 metres.

DYNAMIC (H Bennet) – made firm contact with **JAKOB GAMBINO** after the start. H Bennet advised to exercise greater care when shifting ground near the 300 metres.

JAKOB GAMBINO (S Muniandy) – made firm contact with **DYNAMIC** after the start, rider reminded of his obligations to ride his mount out fully to the line. **S Muniandy** warned under Rule 638(3)(b)(ii) for excessive use of the whip prior to the 200 metres.

FASHION LASS (C Barnes) – began awkwardly and was further inconvenienced when **BAHHARE BABE** shifted outwards on jumping, raced in restricted room momentarily passing the 200 metres

BAHHARE BABE (T Direen) – shifted outwards on jumping, raced wide throughout.

STRALIS (B Moore) – raced in restricted room for a short distance near the 1000 metres, held up near the 300 metres finding clear racing room near the 200 metres.

COLCHESTER (K Mudhoo) – raced wide throughout, brushed with **MULBERRY** inside the final 50 metres.

ITS NO SECRET (J Robinson) – raced wide in the middle stages, lay outwards near the 350 metres, steadied when placed in restricted room near the 300 metres when awkwardly placed to the inside of the heels of **DYNAMIC**.

SHANZOU (D Chin) – held up for a short distance passing the 400 metres.

FIRST OF A KIND – rider M Chui reminded of his obligations to ride his mounts out fully to the line.

Race 8 | **NZ CUP MEETING "TICKETS ON SALE" RATING 75 (1600m)**

BRIDGET TOWN (K Mudhoo) – began awkwardly.

LUKE (H Bennet) – began awkwardly, raced in restricted room for a short distance near the 400 metres.

WISE MOVE (B Moore) – crowded at the start, raced wide throughout.

PAINTBALL (R Cuneen) – tended to get its head up when racing keenly in the early stages, steadied near the 75 metres when in restricted room losing momentum.

ADMIRAL ROUS – rider T Moseley reminded of his obligations regarding whip use prior to the 200 metres.

Race 9 | **RACECOURSE HOTEL & MOTOR LODGE LAST RACE (1800m)**

CRISTALLO (C Barnes) – raced wide in the early stages. Rider C Barnes reported that the mare felt indifferent in its action over the concluding stages. A post race veterinary inspection of **CRISTALLO** revealed an injury to the right front flexor tendon. The connections were advised that a veterinary clearance is required prior to racing next.

FERAL ICE (T Direen) – raced wide in the early stages.

LOCALLY SAUCED (C Johnson) – raced keenly in the early and middle stages, over raced near the 1600 metres when in

restricted room, held up passing the 400 metres, shifted ground outwards near the 200 metres to obtain clear running.

VILLA ELBA (K Mudhoo) – hampered near the 1600 metres when in tight quarters losing ground, raced in restricted room near the 300 metres.

SWEET TIME (B Moore) – raced in restricted quarters near the 1600 metres.

SPIDER LILY (K Kalychurun) – shifted in to avoid the heels of **SKEEN** passing the 1600 metres.

SKEEN (J Morris) – shifted in at the 1600 metres. Rider J Morris was reminded of her obligations when shifting ground.

HABITUDE (R Cuneen) – steadied passing the 1600 metres.

HASELL COURT (D Chin) – raced wide from the 1000 metres.

VANTAA (K Williams) – shifted out under pressure in the concluding stages.
