Race 7 – Lisa Chittick Foxbridge Plate

RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 MARKS EWEN & ASSOCIATES 1800

PENTIRE BABE (T Thornton) – jumped away awkwardly.

HER CHOICE (U Holmquist) – over-raced when being restrained near the 1500 metres, and continued to do so until being allowed to improve forward to lead near the 1000 metres.

PRIZE LORD (S Weatherley) made contact with the hind quarters of MOPSY when attempting to obtain clear running rounding the turn near the 300 metres. **S Weatherley** was issued with a warning.

MOPSY (M Cameron) – unbalanced when bumped rounding turn near 300 metres. When questioned rider advised the mare would be better suited over more ground, and as the mare had only had one trial since being spelled would benefit from the run.

Race 2 SACRED FALLS @ WAIKATO STUD 1000

GET SMART (S Spratt) – shifted out abruptly on jumping away making contact with MATAMAY which became unbalanced.

MATAMAY (S Collett) – unbalanced when bumped start.

SWEET LEADER (C Grylls) – slow away, then raced greenly making the 800 metres bend awkwardly.

MIZ OLDFIELDS ROAD (D Turner) - slow away.

SHELLEZ ACE (C Lammas) - rider reminded of his obligations when riding mounts out to the finish.

Race 3 EL ROCA SPRINT

CUTTING UP ROUGH (Z Nor Azman) – slow away before being further inconvenienced shortly after the start.

BULLSPUR (M Hills) – restrained early stages from wide barrier draw.

FIERTE (C Grylls) – made the 800 metre bend awkwardly.

RUBY ARMANI (C Lammas) – made the 800 metre bend awkwardly when being steadied off the heels of FIERTE.

SUPER LETHAL (S Weatherley – lay inwards when rounding the bend near the 800 metres, then continued to hang inwards badly despite the efforts of its rider. Was unable to be ridden out throughout the final straight. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormality. Trainer M Sheely was advised that the gelding would now be required to trial satisfactorily prior to racing again.

AMBITIOUS UNICORN (L Innes) – not persevered with in the final straight after racing in restricted room for some distance.

THE BANDITO (J Riddell) – had to be firmly restrained off heels passing the 400 metres.

Race 4 NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE

BUFFALO ELLE (A Jones) - was slow away.

BELLA GIOIA (D Johnson) – dipped badly near the 800 metres.

SHEZNIMBLE (R Scott) – made the 800 metre bend awkwardly.

ITS TIME FOR MAGIC (S Spratt) – raced three wide without cover.

THISTLEDONICELY (M Hills) - had difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight.

GLASS SLIPPER (M Coleman) – was unable to obtain clear running throughout the final straight going to the line untested.

Race 5 HAUNUI FARM 1200

ANUKA (S McKay) – jumped away awkwardly.

COHABITATE (D Turner) – was crowded leaving the barriers, and was briefly held up near the 150 metres having to shift out to obtain clear running.

PASABAHCE (S Olney) – jumped away awkwardly then raced wide without cover throughout, running wider rounding the final turn.

Race 6 BEAMISH BLOODSTOCK 1300

DREAMLINING (J Riddell) – over-raced in the early stages.

TANIA (M Coleman) – over-raced in the early and middle stages.

EL FERNANDO (C Lammas) – had to be steadied off heels approaching the 700 metres.

KEEPHERINMIND (C Grylls) – had to be steadied off heels approaching the 700 metres.

VIVA LA JOUR (M Hills) – got its head up for a distance when having to be firmly restrained off heels passing the 600 metres. M Hills reported that he had been struck on the chin by a horse shoe near the 1100 metres.

SHE IS STRYKING (B Hutton) – had difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight.

MISTRAHMA (K McCulloch) – inconvenienced short of the finish when TRIGGER shifted out under pressure.

FROM EDEN (S Spratt) – rider advised the mare had to do a bit of work through the middle stages, and would derive some benefit from the run.

Race 7 NIAGARA @ THE OAKS STUD 1300

TRINOVANTES (J Riddell) – was slow away.

CASING THE JOINT (L Innes) – jumped away awkwardly, losing ground.

GLORIOS (D Turner) – was slow away.

AHJAY (S Collett) – raced ungenerously when being restrained approaching the 1000 metres.

TEN OUT OF TEN (L Satherley) – made the bend near the 800 metres awkwardly, and was not persevered with in the final straight when well beaten, rider advising that the gelding had hung badly throughout. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a minor laceration in its mouth.

PHOEBE SNOW (M Coleman) – rider advised that the mare was held up for a distance passing the 400 metres, and was unable to obtain clear running for the majority of the final straight.

BRONNY'S LAD (S Spratt) – was held up for clear running until passing the 200 metres.

Race 8 THE CAMBRIDGE STUD 1200

BREAK MY STRIDE (M Coleman) – jumped away awkwardly making solid contact with HOKEY POKEY.

HOKEY POKEY (S Spratt) – hampered start losing ground.

HELLO M'LADY (S McKay) – jumped away awkwardly, losing ground. Held up entering the final straight, shifting ground abruptly inwards to obtain clear running near the 250 metres.

O'NATURELLE (M Cameron) – over-raced when being restrained in the middle stages.

IFF SO HAPPENS (D Turner) – commenced to hang outwards going into the bend near the 800 metres, and continued to do so for the remainder of the race not being persevered with in the final straight. The connections were advised that a warning would be placed against the mare for its racing manners.
