Apprentice jockey C-M Waddell was shown footage of the start in the presence of her employer Mr G Haigh, and was advised she needs to improve her starting technique after previously being spoken to regarding this matter.</p> <p><b>ZIMMABELLE</b> (R Goldsbury)– Raced wide without cover throughout</p> <p><b>OKAY JACK</b> (J Parkes) – Steadied off heels at 800m when attempting a run to the outside.</p>	
<b>Race 2</b>	<b>GRAPHIX EXPLOSION MAIDEN 1100m</b>
<p><b>MADAME DEFARGE</b> (D Turner) Began awkwardly and settled back.</p> <p><b>TUSCAN WHISTLER</b> (M Tanaka) Saddle shifted backwards shortly after the start placing rider M Tanaka at a disadvantage throughout.</p> <p>Riders of <b>LIPSTICK</b>(S Wahab) and <b>ROADWORX</b> (BB Hong) were reminded of their obligations regarding their use of the whip when out of contention.</p>	

<b>Race 3</b>	<b>LINWOOD PARK "ECHOES OF HEAVEN" MAIDEN 1400m</b>
<p><b>DAL TALISKER</b>(L Hemi) Was tightened shortly after the start.</p> <p><b>VALENTIA</b> (D Turner) Was obliged to improve wide rounding the turn.</p>

<p><b>VITALIA</b> (S McKay) Slow away.</p> <p><b>ELLIES EMPRESS</b> (M Tanaka) Slow away.</p> <p><b>ART DECO</b> (A Chan) Was inclined to lug in on-straightening resulting in the rider switching his whip hand.</p>	
<b>Race 5</b>	<b>STELLA ARTOIS MAIDEN 1600m</b>
<p><b>POROTENE MHIA</b> (D Turner) Very slow away. (5L) Had to be straightened near the 150m when shifting out under pressure.</p> <p><b>DAL KILCHOAN</b> (T Johnson) Awkwardly away.</p> <p><b>ROCFIVE</b>(M Tanaka) Raced wide without cover throughout.</p> <p><b>RHIANNON</b>(R Myers) Disappointed, rider had no excuse.</p>	
<b>Race 6</b>	<b>LINWOOD PARK "EKRAAR" 1800m</b>
<p><b>TIME BOMB</b> (R Myers) Tightened start and got back.</p> <p><b>THE GRADUATE</b> (T Johnson) Slow away.</p> <p><b>ALINKO PRINCE</b> (J Parkes) Tightened shortly after start when runners either side shifted ground.</p> <p><b>CHEESE MAKER</b> (Z Moki) Rider Apprentice Z Moki was reminded of her obligations to be clear of runners when shifting ground after angling her mount inwards after the start hampering ALINKO PRINCE. Contributing to the tightening was outward movement from MANGAROA FLO JO.</p> <p><b>MANGAROA FLO JO</b> (K McCulloch) Rider K McCulloch reported the mare was not entirely comfortable in the ground. Stewards ordered a Vet Inspection which was clear.</p>	
<b>Race 7</b>	<b>LINWOOD PARK "GIANT'S STEPS" 1800m</b>
<p><b>PADDY JO</b> (L Magorrian) Rider dislodged in enclosure, cleared to ride at start by paramedics.</p> <p><b>HEISTHEONE</b> (R Myers) Bumped at Start.</p> <p><b>NITRO TED</b> (D Turner) Lay in under pressure in the home straight.</p> <p><b>HAYLEY ANN</b> (S Collett) Slow away. Rider reported mount was unsuited to the puggy going.</p>
