GENERAL:

The start of Race 3 was rescheduled to 1.10pm, Race 4 was rescheduled to 1.35pm and Race 5 rescheduled to 2.05pm. Race 9 was put back one minute to 4.36pm at the request of raceday control.

Race 1	LOWE SCHOLLUM & JONES MDN HDL 3000M
SONTANA (S Fannin) - Raced keenly in the early and middle stages. Hampered near the 600 metres.	
RED SUNSET (W Gordon) - Raced keenly in the early and middle stages.	
WINDERMERE LAD (C Studd) – Jumped poorly throughout and lost ground.	
WILLY DUGGAN (M Gillies) - Dipped on landing becoming unbalanced at the second last fence.	
HER SON (E Goodinson) - Slow away. Jumped the last two fences poorly and lost ground.	
OUR DEBUTANTE (G Walsh) - Did not complete the course and was retired near the 400 metres when well back.	
RED MAFIA (M Cropp) - Landed awkwardly at the fence near the 600 metres and shifted out hampering SONTANA .	

LANDLORD (C Perrett) - Incurred a minor laceration to a hind leg.	
Race 2	INFUSION CATERING MDN HDL 3000M
<p>KANGAROO (K Walters) - Raced keenly early so was taken forward. Hampered after jumping the second last fence.</p> <p>PLATINUM SONG (M Cropp) – Pulled up after jumping the fence near the 600 metres on the first occasion and when being corrected shifted in hampering KINGIESSTAR and RED MOSS. PLATINUM SONG was attended to by veterinary staff and was found to have suffered a fatal cardio-vascular event. Jockey M Cropp was uninjured.</p> <p>HONEY QUEEN (A Browne) - Landed awkwardly at the fence near the 1200 metres and a short distance further bumped with KIPKEINO. Hampered after jumping the second last fence.</p> <p>NO DEAL (S Karnicnik) – Fell after jumping the fence near the 1000 metres. Both horse and rider were uninjured.</p> <p>KINGIESSTAR (E Goodinson) Hampered after jumping the fence near the 600 metres on the first occasion. Hampered after jumping the second last fence.</p> <p>ONE KAY (G Walsh) – Made contact with the running rail near the winning post on the first round. Hampered after jumping the second last fence.</p> <p>GOOD RISK (C Perrett) – Fell at the second last fence. Was attended to by veterinary staff and was found to have suffered a fatal cardio-vascular event. C Perrett was uninjured.</p> <p>RED MOSS (M Gillies) –Hampered after jumping the fence near the 600 metres on the first occasion. Retired from the event near the 1400 metres when racing well back. When questioned Rider M Gillies advised Stewards that the gelding was never comfortable in the going and that he had considered there may be something amiss with its action so did not persevere. Stewards ordered a veterinary inspection which failed to reveal any obvious abnormality. Trainer K Myers agreed to monitor RED MOSS over coming days and report any findings to the stewards.</p>	
Race 3	OFFICE SMARTS RST OPN HDL 3000M
<p>VICEROY (C Studd) - Slow to begin. Hit the fence near the 1300 metres hard and lost ground. Pulled up prior to jumping the last two fences. A post-race veterinary inspection of the gelding did not reveal any obvious abnormality. When questioned C Studd advised the gelding had little left after hitting the fence in the back straight.</p> <p>LE BON FIN (M Cropp) - Slow to begin. Jumped indifferently throughout and was pulled up prior to jumping the last two fences.</p> <p>SHARE THE BLAME (S Karnicnik) - Slow to begin.</p> <p>JUST ISHI (G Walsh) - Held up for some distance after jumping the fence near the 1000 metres gaining clear running near the 700 metres.</p> <p>ZARDETTO (A Kuru) – Hit the second last fence and landed awkwardly losing momentum.</p> <p>JUSTA CHARLIE (K Walters) - Dipped on landing after jumping the second last fence.</p>	
Race 4	JOLT COFFEE HOUSE WANGANUI STEEPLECHASE 4100M
<p>WHEELER FORTUNE (C Perrett) – Over-raced in the early stages. Pulled up prior to jumping the second last fence.</p> <p>MENDOZA (S Karnicnik) - Landed awkwardly at the fence near the post with a round to go resulting in the rider being almost unseated. Pulled up prior to jumping the second last fence.</p> <p>MCCULLEY (M Gillies) - Hit the fence near the 600 metres.</p> <p>THE FOX (E Goodinson) – Hit the second last fence and did not jump the last fence.</p> <p>HARD SHOT (K Walters) – Pulled up prior to jumping the second last fence.</p> <p>AND THATZ SCOTTY (A Browne) – Pulled up prior to jumping the second last fence. Returned to enclosure minus near-</p>	

front plate.

SINISTA (C Studd) - Retired near the 600 metres when well back and out of contention.

SHAMAL (M Cropp) - Landed awkwardly after jumping the last fence shifting in.

Race 5	WANGANUI RACEHORSE OWNERS ASSOCIATION MDN 1360M
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Trainer K Myers - issued with a warning under Rule 537 (a) for failing to declare a rider for **TABARD** by the required time and also for **AVE MARIA** in Race 7.

TABARD (Z Moki) – Slow to begin. Checked when crowded near the 200 metres losing ground.

BELLADITA (L Hemi) – Bumped 200 metres becoming momentarily unbalanced.

VALENTIA (D Turner) – Steadied when placed in restricted room near the 50 metres.

ITSA KEEPA (R Hannam) – Held up before having to shift ground inwards to obtain clear running near the 100 metres.

R Myers (AMORATA) - admitted a breach of Rule 638 (1) (d) in that she allowed her mount to shift out near the 200 metres when not clear of **TABARD** which was checked and crowded onto **BELLADITA** which was unbalanced. R Myers licence to ride in races was suspended by the Judicial Committee from the conclusion of racing on 27 August up to and including 7 September. (4 riding days)

Race 6	THE PROPERTY BROKERS COMPLIANCE LIMITED R65 1360M
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GARFUNKEL (Z Moki) – Slow away.

PLAY THE GAME (L Hemi) – Was inclined to race keenly in the early and middle stages and was momentarily hampered when **HUNDYAMONTH** shifted out towards the end of the back straight.

CHARLIE CHINE (K McCulloch) – Denied clear running until shifting inwards near the 150 metres.

Race 7	G BRISTOL & SONS MDN 1200M
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CALL ME KATE (M Tanaka) – Slow to begin.

DUCHESS DARCI (B Hutton) – Finished some distance last. Connections advised the filly would be retired.

Race 8	PRO POWDER COATING R65 2060M
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BAD BOY BROWN (K McCulloch) – Slow away.

IN A TRANCE (R Myers) - Finished well back. Rider R Myers was of the opinion the mare may be better suited to more rain affected footing. A subsequent veterinary inspection was clear.

BANG (H Andrew) – Raced in restricted room for a short distance near the 150 metres and had to be steadied.

HAMILTONIAN (L Allpress) – Rider L Allpress advised Stewards that in her opinion the gelding would be suited to more rain affected footing.

PENTIME (R Hannam) – Subsequent to the race, connections advised the gelding had suffered an attack of nasal bleeding. Trainer M Ivil advised that the gelding would not be persevered with as a racing proposition.

Race 9	PALAMOUNTAINS NUTRITION MDN 2060M
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CARTAGENA (R Goldsbury) – Slow away.

PUKEAKE SAM (S Wahab) – Slow away.(4L)

ANY STREAM WILL DO (D Turner) - Began awkwardly. Lay out rounding the final bend.

SOPHIA GRACE (T Johnson) – **KIT** lay in entering the final straight crowding **SOPHIA GRACE** which had to be steadied when

weakening. Also contributing was outward movement from **ANY STREAM WILL DO**.

STREET FIGHTER (J Parkes) – Improved onto heels near the 150 metres having to be briefly steadied.
