RACE COMMENTS:

 Race 1
 ADM FEEDS LTD 2000

 EYESLUCKY (A Collett) – was slow to begin.

LIBRETTI (D Johnson) – was crowded after jumping away, and steadied.

JOE CARGO (V Colgan) – began awkwardly, and then raced ungenerously when being steadied in the early and middle stages.

BLACKHAVEN (C Grylls) – was crowded and steadied passing the winning post on the first occasion, then continued to overrace for a distance.

MIGHTY COLOMBO (A Jones) - raced wide until near the 1000 metres.

MY BABY ROCS (S Weatherley) – was bumped and then unbalanced passing the 600 metres when crowded by LIBRETTI.

CHASING DIAMONDS (Z Nor Azman) – was steadied passing the 150 metres when improving on to the heels of MIGHTY COLOMBO which shifted ground under pressure.

Race 2 THIRSTY LIQUOR 1200

HAPPINESS IS (B R Jones) – was slow to begin, and then was hampered.

CARRADINE (B Hutton) – began awkwardly.

COOL STORY BRO (S Goodman) – was slow to begin.

OUTOFTHEMIST (C Grylls) – began awkwardly, losing ground.

HAPPY TIGER (T Thornton) – was steadied approaching the 1100 metres when in restricted room.

CHIC BOY (M Hills) – raced ungenerously when being steadied for a distance passing the 800 metres.

PEG (Z Nor Azman) – raced ungenerously when being steadied for a distance passing the 800 metres, and was held up passing the 300 metres when awkwardly placed inside heels having to shift out to obtain clear running.

KAMIKAZE REBEL (C Lammas) – raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

AVISTAR (K McCulloch) – had to be steadied when awkwardly placed on heels passing the 100 metres. A post-race endoscopic examination of **AVISTAR** found some blood to be present in the trachea. Trainer Mr S Ralph advised that the gelding would be treated and further vetted prior to a decision being made on future racing. Mr Ralph was advised that a veterinary clearance would be required prior to racing next.

CLASSIQUE DANCE (S Spratt) – shifted out under pressure passing the 100 metres.

Race 3 THE CLOTHIER FAMILY 1200

MAREEBA (A Schwerin) – began awkwardly.

THE CANON (A Collett) – began awkwardly, losing ground.

AIM PHAR (C Lammas) – was slow to begin.

FIERTE (C Grylls) – commenced to race ungenerously when being steadied from near the 900 metres for a distance.

ITS A KINDA MAGIC (K McCulloch) – was steadied when crowded soon after leaving the barrier. **ITS A KINDA MAGIC** had to be firmly restrained when crowded and checked to the inside of CABARET which was taken in by THE CANON which had improved to the inside of FIERTE near the 800 metres. Rider A Collett defended a breach of careless riding. The charge was found proven and Ms Collett's licence was suspended from the conclusion of racing on 31 August up to and including 9 September, 5 riding days.

ONLY IF (M Coleman) – raced wide without cover throughout.

Race 4 WAHAROA TRANSPORT LTD 1400

ADRIATIC PEARL (R Elliot) – was slow to begin.

MANAIA ROSE (K McCulloch) – was a little slow to begin, then over-raced through the middle stages.

PRESIDENT TOMADO (Z Nor Azman) – raced wide without cover throughout. Rider dropped his whip passing the 300 metres.

Race 5 WAHAROA INDUSTRIAL PARK 1400

ACRE (M McNab) – was slow to begin.

BIG TONY (B Hutton) – began awkwardly.

BATTLE CRY (S McKay) - had to steady when in restricted room passing the 200 metres.

WAGNER (M Cameron) – was inconvenienced passing the 50 metres.

Race 6 OIL SEEDS 1600

ZAPALI (M Du Plessis) – began awkwardly, and then was hampered losing ground.

TUTENSE (L Satherley) – began awkwardly, and then was crowded losing ground.

DOWRY DUTY (A Collett) – began a little awkwardly.

COSTANO MILLE (S Spratt) – raced in restricted room passing the 500 metres, and was briefly steadied. When questioned regarding the performance of **COSTANO MILLE** rider S Spratt advised the mare would prefer further easing of the ground.

ROGER THAT (T Thornton) – was inconvenienced approaching the 200 metres.

NOMBERO (M Coleman) – was briefly crowded passing the 75 metres, and was steadied.

Race 7 FAIRVIEW MATAMATA 1600

SUPERARE (V Gatu) – was inconvenienced passing the 1200 metres when forced wider on the track by KILMAC which lay out.

ODENSIAN (A Scherwin) – became awkwardly placed on heels when shifting out to obtain clear running near the 200 meters having to be steadied.

KILMAC (D Prastiyou) – when questioned regarding its improved performance trainer E Green was unable to offer any tangible reason other than believing the gelding had been well suited by today's track conditions.

Race 8 RBC RACING 2000

PRIZE LAD (C Grylls) – began awkwardly. Held up entering the final straight and shifted in passing the 300 metres to obtain clear running.

EL BANDIDO (K McCulloch) – was hampered when crowded passing the 1800 metres by THE ARABIAN DUKE which shifted in and away from CARDON BOY which was dictated in slightly by MESSI.

CARDON BOY (T Wenn) – commenced to over-race when in restricted room leaving the straight on the first occasion, having to shift out off the heels of HE'S DAN which had improved forward to lead.

SING FOR THE SUN (T Thornton) – shifted out off heels making contact with KALINDA passing the 1200 metres.

KALINDA (L Magorrian) – was forced wider on the track near the 1200 metres.

REAL THIRSTY (C Lammas) – was inconvenienced approaching the 100 metres when under pressure. When questioned into the performance of the favourite rider C Lammas advised that although the gelding had wet track form he believed the gelding may be better suited to improved track conditions.
