RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	PALAMOUNTAINS NUTRITION MAIDEN STEEPLECHASE 4100M
<p>FRED FLINSTONE (C Studd) – ran its fences down in the early stages and jumped slowly when well back and lost considerable ground. The gelding was not persevered with from near the 600 metres with a round to go when the rider considered something amiss with its action. A subsequent veterinary inspection was clear.</p> <p>DOCTOR HOOK (W Gordon) – landed awkwardly at the fence near the 900 metres with a round to go. Hung out final straight having to be straightened near the finish.</p> <p>YARDSTICK (S Karnicnik) – landed awkwardly at the 900 metre fence.</p> <p>DARVA (S Fannin) - fell at the second last fence. Both horse and rider were uninjured.</p> <p>KINGS KITE (R Cully) - ran down the last two fences.</p>	

Race 2	RANGATIRA RETIREMENT STEEPLECHASE 4100M
<p>MISTER DEEJAY (R Cully) – slowed up at the fence near the 600 metres with a round to go and made a poor jump at the same fence on the last round.</p> <p>MAILLY (S Fannin) – hit the fence near the 1,200 metres on the last round. Ran down the last fence losing momentum.</p> <p>GOOSEBUMPS (M Gillies) – landed awkwardly at the fence near the 900 metres and lost ground. Rider M Gillies was almost unseated. Hampered second last fence when well back.</p>	
Race 3	FIBER FRESH MAIDEN HURDLE 3000M
<p>AL MUNROE (M Mitchell) - jumped the first fence awkwardly.</p> <p>WILLY DUGGAN (I Lupton) – fell at the fence near the 1,300 metres.</p> <p>HONEY QUEEN (M Cropp) – was severely unbalanced by a fallen runner at the fence near 1,300 metres resulting in the rider being dislodged.</p> <p>MARQUATEER (S Karnicnik) – hampered by fallen runner near the 1,300 metres. Dislodged rider at the fence near the 600 metres when unable to avoid a fallen runner.</p> <p>KINGIESSTAR (E Goodinson) – hampered by fallen runner near the 1,300 metres and again by fallen runner at the fence near the 600 metres when well back.</p> <p>THE GRUBBYDUCK (W Gordon) – fell at the fence near the 600 metres.</p> <p>OUR DEBUTANTE (R Cully) – brought down at the fence near the 600 metres.</p> <p>PUKEAKE SAM (S Fannin) – fell at the fence near the 600 metres.</p> <p>HAVATASTE (A Kuru) – hampered by fallen runner at the fence near the 600 metres.</p> <p>All riders were cleared by paramedics.</p> <p>All horses underwent and passed veterinary inspections.</p>	
Race 4	INFUSION CATERING MAIDEN HURDLE 3000M
<p>JITZU (E Goodinson) - raced wide throughout.</p> <p>CARRINGTON PARK (S Karnicnik) - steadied after jumping the second fence.</p> <p>HER SON (R Cully) – hit the fence near the 900 metres and dislodged rider R Cully who was taken to hospital for observation with a suspected shoulder injury.</p>	
Race 5	CARPET MAINTENANCE & CLEANING OPEN HURDLE 3000M
<p>SIR MANAWA (C Studd) – C Studd was questioned into his ride, in particular his apparent lack of vigour after jumping the fence near the 900 metres until near the home straight. C Studd advised that his riding instructions from connections were not to place his mount under undue pressure until after jumping the third last fence as the gelding had only a brief sustained run. C Studd added that SIR MANAWA put in a poor jump at the fence near the 600 metres and did not jump the last two fences proficiently and that it may have held its breath. Trainer K Myers was questioned and confirmed the instructions given. The explanation given by C Studd was noted.</p> <p>K Myers advised that the gelding would be spelled.</p> <p>SIR MANAWA underwent a veterinary inspection which was clear.</p> <p>MY MAGICIAN (S Fannin) - was retired from the race near the 800 metres when well back and out of contention. When questioned rider S Fannin had no tangible excuse. Trainer G Vile advised the gelding would spell. A subsequent veterinary inspection was clear.</p> <p>SHARE THE BLAME (M Cropp) – was retired near the 800 metres when well back and out of contention.</p>	

Race 6	THE BOLD ONE @ GRANGEWILLIAM STUD MAIDEN 1360M
<p>A Collett admitted a breach of Rule 638 (1) (d) in that she allowed her mount to shift inwards shortly after the start dictating STORMY RED inwards into the line of NEAT BELT which was checked. After hearing submissions Rider A Collett had her licence to ride in races suspended from the conclusion of racing on 18 September up until and including the conclusion of racing on 25 September – 5 days.</p> <p>K McCulloch (SUO LIN NANG) – K McCulloch admitted a breach of Rule 638 (1) (d) in that she allowed her mount to shift inwards shortly after the start tightening DENNY’S LINCOLN and COMMANDING PRINCE. After hearing submissions Rider K McCulloch had her licence to ride in races suspended from the conclusion of racing on 18 September up until and including the conclusion of racing on 25 September – 4 days.</p> <p>DENNY’S LINCOLN (M Tanaka) – tightened shortly after the start.</p> <p>COMMANDING PRINCE (M Singh) – tightened shortly after the start.</p> <p>SHADOW KING (R Myers) – over-raced early and hampered near the 1,200 metres.</p> <p>FALCONS REACH (S Weatherley) – tightened shortly after the start and again a short distance further when FOGARTY FEGEN was being corrected.</p> <p>D Hirini (FRUITION) was issued with a warning under Rule 638 (1) (d) in that she allowed her mount to shift in shortly after the start when not clear of FALCONS REACH which was hampered.</p> <p>FRUITION (D Hirini) - shifted out under pressure in the home straight resulting in D Hirini’s whip coming into contact accidentally with FOGARTY FEGEN on two occasions.</p> <p>FOGARTY FEGEN (A Collett) - prior to the authorisation of dividends the connections of the second-placed FOGARTY FEGEN viewed coverage of the home straight with a view to lodging a protest against the winner FRUITION which shifted out but elected not to proceed.</p>	
Race 7	JOLT COFFEE HOUSE 1360M
<p>IRISH WHISPER (K McCulloch) – over-raced in the early stages.</p> <p>O’CEIRINS WHISPER (J Parkes) – raced three-wide without cover in the back straight and into the bend.</p>	
Race 8	WANGANUI GREYHOUND RACING CLUB MAIDEN 1200M
<p>RHYMIC DANCER (S Weatherley) – slow away.</p> <p>DOUBLE ALLY (M Tanaka) – slow away.</p> <p>FREE REIN (K McCulloch) - raced wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>CULTURED PEARL (L Hemi) - was denied a run near the 250 metres when CLERMONT shifted in so was then angled inwards to improve.</p> <p>STORMFORCE WINDS (H Tinsley) - Awkwardly placed on heels shortly after the start and steadied, then commenced to over-race for a short distance.</p>	
Race 9	WANGANUI TROTting CLUB 1200M
<p>O’CEIRINS CHOICE (T Johnson) – began awkwardly, bumped with JUST YOU and settled back.</p> <p>JUST YOU (J Parkes) – Received a bump and settled back. J Parkes reported that his mount was racing in a fresh state, over-raced in the early and middle stages and had little left at the finish.</p>	
Race 10	CLASS CARPENTRY 1600M
<p>ACUTELYGOLD (J Parkes) - raced three wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>CRAFTY LADY (Z Moki) – tailed off. Z Moki had no excuses. A veterinary examination was clear.</p>	

HUNDYAMONTH (T Johnson) – When questioned into the run of HUNDYAMONTH Rider T Johnson said the gelding had little left after being taken on throughout.

Race 11

WISHING JD WORKMAN & CO WELL IN RETIREMENT MAIDEN 1600M

KEEP TRUCKING (L Hemi) – slow to begin and settled back.

WOODY STRODE (H Tinsley) - over-raced going into the first turn and when being steadied off the heels of **LA VAMOS** (S McKay) shifted out simultaneously as **SALVINIA** (N Teeluck) shifted in, resulting in **AMORATA** (R Myers) and **KEEP TRUCKING** (L Hemi) being checked. Video footage proved inconclusive and after questioning riders, no fault could be attributed to any one rider. **AMORATA** then commenced to over-race for some distance after being tightened.
