## **RACE COMMENTS:**

Race 1 THE SWISS ACE SPRINT (1200 metres)

**DARCI MAC** (J Parkes) – slow to begin.

**LADY ZAFIRA** (J Riddell) – began awkwardly.

H Andrew (MISS APPLETON) admitted a charge of careless riding in that she permitted her mount to shift inwards shortly after the start when not sufficiently clear, crowding XCUSES XCUSES and REILLY LINCOLN onto SHADOWS CAST which made contact with the hind quarters of BELIAL, with BELIAL then shifting outwards to avoid the heels of MISS APPLETON which continued to shift inwards, further crowding SHADOWS CAST and REILLY LINCOLN which were checked. After hearing submissions Miss Andrew was suspended by the Judicial Committee from the conclusion of racing on Saturday, 3 September until the conclusion of racing on Friday 16 September 2016 (4 riding days).

**REILLY LINCOLN** (D Bradley) – crowded and checked 1100 metres losing ground, inconvenienced near the 300 metres when BELIAL shifted outwards to obtain clear running.

BELIAL (L Innes) - hampered 1100 metres.

**XCUSES XCUSES** (R Myers) – crowded 1100 metres.

SHADOWS CAST (L Allpress) – crowded and checked 1100 metres losing ground.

Race 2 EL ROCA 3YO SPRINT (1200 metres)

O'REILLY'S CHOICE (J Riddell) – jumped away awkwardly losing ground.

**DUTROW** (R Myers) – raced ungenerously when being restrained near the 1000 metres.

KINGSMAN (M du Plessis) - raced ungenerously when being restrained near the 1000 metres getting its head up.

**FOGARTY FEGEN** (C Johnson) – over-raced in the middle stages.

MONGOLIAN FALCON (L Innes) made the bend near the 850 metres awkwardly inconveniencing EARLYGAIN.

**EARLYGAIN** (L Allpress) – inconvenienced 850 metres then raced three wide without cover rounding the bend.

### Race 3 BOSTOCK NEW ZEALAND SPRING CARNIVAL 1400 (1400 metres)

**SIR KINGWOOD** (N Teeluck) – steadied passing the 1200 metres when awkwardly placed on the heels of GALAXY MISS when the pace steadied, over-raced in the middle stages shifting outwards to avoid the heels of STRADA CAVALLO passing the 600 metres before having to be firmly restrained to avoid the heels of the weakening STACCATO near the 500 metres.

BISHOPBRIGGS (J Riddell) - inconvenienced 1200 metres.

**ZORRALI** (A Chan) – raced keenly in the early stages, inconvenienced near the 1000 metres.

### Race 4 RELIABLE MAN MILE (1600 metres)

**CRISTAL** (R Myers) – slow to begin.

JACKSSTAR (C Lammas) – hampered leaving the barriers by J'WALKE which shifted outwards.

**J'WALKE** (D Bradley) raced wide without cover from near the 800 metres, underwent a veterinary examination following the race which failed to reveal any abnormalities. Trainer W Jones advised he would be giving consideration to the gelding's future as a racing proposition.

**VERACIOUS** (R Goldsbury) – held up rounding the final turn and continued to have difficulty obtaining clear running until shifting outwards abruptly across heels approaching the 200 metres.

## Race 5 WESTBURY STUD – PROUD TO PARTNER THE CANCER SOCIETY 1200 (1200 metres)

**ARCTURUS** (C Lammas) – slow to begin, raced wide for the majority of the race.

**LUCYINRIO** (L Hemi) – slow to begin, then crowded, raced three wide without cover throughout.

**BRAT PACK** (C Grylls) - crowded shortly after jumping away and steadied.

**RESURRECT** (J Riddell) - raced ungenerously in the early and middle stages.

**BARABAS** (D Johnson) - when questioned rider advised the gelding had travelled only fairly and was unable to quicken when placed under pressure near the 500 metres. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any abnormalities. Trainer D Logan undertook to report anything that may become apparent in days subsequent with the gelding to undergo further tests on return to its stable.

**ELEONORA** (M Cameron) - held up rounding the turn near the 400 metres.

### Race 6 REDWOOD SPRING STAYERS (2000 metres)

MI PIACI (M du Plessis) - began awkwardly losing ground.

**ZEDBEE** (T Johnson) – slow to begin.

**AMARONE** (S Collett) – began awkwardly, raced ungenerously in the early stages making the first turn awkwardly.

MASTER POET (R Hannam) - slow to begin.

**FAZED** (J Parkes) - raced ungenerously when being steadied passing the 1700 metres.

**ALL THE DRAMA** (D Johnson) - raced three wide without cover throughout and was a beaten runner prior to entering the final straight, crowded and checked 300 metres when weakening. Rider D Johnson was unable to offer any excuses other than being trapped wide in the running. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any abnormality.

J Riddell (BLUSHING MOSS) - admitted a charge of careless riding in that he permitted his mount to shift outwards near the 300 metres when not sufficiently clear of AMARONE which was forced outwards crowding BANG onto ALL THE DRAMA, which was checked with MASTER POET also being hampered as a result. After hearing submissions J Riddell was suspended by the Judicial Committee from the conclusion of racing on Saturday, 3 September until the conclusion of racing on Friday 16 September 2016 (4 riding days).

AMARONE (S Collett) – hampered 300 metres, lay in then had to be steadied to avoid heels near the 100 metres.

**BANG** (M Cameron) – crowded 300 metres.

MASTER POET (R Hannam) – hampered 300 metres.

### Race 7 MAKFI CHALLENGE STAKES (1400 metres)

FARM BOY (H Tinsley) - slow to begin.

**CAPELLA** (D Jonson) – slow to begin.

**OUR VERGARA** (M du Plessis) - shifted outwards shortly after leaving the barriers crowding AUTHENTIC PADDY, GINNER HART and STOLEN DANCE.

**AUTHENTIC PADDY** (R Hannam) - crowded shortly after leaving the barriers.

GINNER HART (C Johnson) - crowded shortly after leaving the barriers losing ground.

**STOLEN DANCE** (S Spratt) - crowded shortly after leaving the barriers losing ground.

**BATTLE TIME** (C Grylls) - shifted outwards abruptly leaving the barriers when jumping away awkwardly, raced wide without cover from the 900 metres.

**VALLEY GIRL** (L Allpress) - hung outwards rounding the bend and continued to do so in the final straight finishing at the rear. When questioned L Allpress advised the mare had hung badly throughout the race but was unable to offer any further excuses. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormality. Trainer D Logan advised that VALLEY GIRL would be further vetted on return to her stable with any findings to be notified to Stewards.

MIME (J Parkes) – was unable to obtain clear running for the majority of the final straight.

**FARM BOY** (H Tinsley) – was unable to obtain clear running until near the 200 metres.

**NO MORE TEARS** (M Coleman) - when questioned regarding its poor performance rider was unable to offer any excuses advising that the mare had failed to respond once placed under pressure from the 600 metres. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any abnormality.

#### Race 8 WESTBURY CLUB MILE (1600 metres)

**WILLIE CAZALS** (C Grylls) - began awkwardly, raced ungenerously when being steadied in the early stages, had difficulty obtaining clear running in the home straight until inside the final 150 metres.

**SKYBIRD** (S Collett) - hampered leaving the barriers.

**NYMPH MONTE** (D Johnson) - crowded shortly after leaving the barriers.

**PENTATHLON** (L Allpress) - raced wide without cover throughout.

**UNDERTHEMOONLIGHT** (C Lammas) - briefly held up entering the final straight.

### Race 9 WISHING YOU WELL SIR COLIN MEADS 1400 (1400 metres)

KININMONT (R Hannam) - slow to begin.

**ROCK ON** (C Johnson) – slow to begin, had some difficulty obtaining clear running in the final straight until passing the 150 metres.

**EL NINO** (C Lammas) - shifted outwards abruptly leaving the barriers.

**BLUETWENTYTWO** (Z Moki) - became awkwardly placed on the heels of THE WOOLF near the 1100 metres when the pace steadied then commenced to over-race.

**LIAPARI** (H Tinsley) - over-raced badly in the middle stages and shifted outwards abruptly to avoid heels passing the 1000 metres hampering STROLLING VAGABOND, held up rounding the final turn having to be firmly restrained when awkwardly placed on heels near the 350 metres then continuing to have difficulty obtaining clear running until passing the 200 metres.

**STROLLING VAGABOND** (M Cameron) – hampered 1000 metres.

**THE WOLF** (L Allpress) - had to be firmly restrained for a distance passing the 800 metres to avoid the heels of EL NINO, held up entering the final straight and after attempting a tight run to the inside of EL NINO was again held up when that runner rolled inwards away from HENREE WINKLER passing the 200 metres.
