Race 1	SPEIGHT'S MID ALE MAIDEN (1200m)
	IN DANGER (G Cooksley) – crowded and buffeted at the start losing ground.
	EL CASTANO (G Jogoo) – shifted out abruptly at the start crowding and contacting outside runner.
	ZAWHIP (J Morris) – bounded at the start, raced ungenerously in the early stages.
	DUFFY (S Muniandy) – crowded shortly after the start losing ground.
	ZULIANI (D Prastiyou) – over raced early stages.
	RUAIRI (T Moseley) – crowded shortly after the start.
	TAKE THE HIGH ROAD (H Bennet) – crowded shortly after the start, lay out throughout the run home.
	MIA MAMMA (R Bishop) – shifted in shortly after the start and threw head in the air when being steadied to relieve pressure to the inside, lay in throughout the run home.

CROYDE (C Johnson) – raced keenly in the early stages, crowded passing the 1000 metres.

SEAMSTRESS (K Williams) – raced keenly in the early stages, crowded at 1000 metres, raced in restricted room last 50 metres.

RESIDENTIAL (K Mudhoo) – raced keenly and in restricted room through the middle stages.

HOT DATE (S Wynne) – steadied off heels when racing keenly near the 600 metres.

CARMENIZE (M McNab) – rider lost whip near the 220 metres.

SHE'S GRACEFUL (A Collett) – crowded and had to steady momentarily passing the 200 metres, lost the off hind plate during the running.

Race 2 | **SKELTON BROTHERS MAIDEN (1600m)**

ANCIENT (R Cuneen) – bounded at the start losing ground, crowded and buffeted passing the 1200 metres, steadied momentarily passing the 800 metres when improving onto heels of the runner in front

LADY PRUDENCE (R Yatim) – blundered shortly after the start losing momentum,

PAHAU (T Moseley) – crowded shortly after the start losing some ground, raced keenly early stages.

ASOMA (G Cooksley) – raced keenly through the early stages and had to be restrained passing the 1200 metres, lay out throughout the run home and could not be ridden to full advantage.

PARANA (M Chui) – raced keenly in the early stages and when being restrained at the 1200 metres shifted in crowding inside runner, crowded passing 200 metres having to steady momentarily.

UPFRONTNCENTRE (C Johnson) – raced keenly in the early stages, restrained off heels passing the 800 metres when continuing to race keenly.

SHE ROCKS (K Mudhoo) – raced wide throughout.

WILD JACK (K Kalychurun) – held up for the majority of the run home.

Race 3 | **COCA-COLA RATING 75 (2000m)**

MCMAY (S Muniandy) – bounded at the start losing ground.

ROCKAHOY (T Moseley) – slow to begin then taken forward to be handy.

ANGEL FALLS (S Wynne) – began awkwardly and bumped with inside runner.

TUTOR (R Cuneen) – raced wide in the early stages, checked near the 350 metres losing ground.

LA NOUVELLE VAGUE (A Collett) – raced wide without cover from the 1200 metres. **A Collett** reminded of her obligations to ensure she rides her mounts out to the end of the race.

PAW PATROL (L Callaway) – bumped near the 400 metres, held up throughout the middle stages of the run home.

ROSHEEN (K Mudhoo) – shifted out near the 350 metres checking **TUTOR**. K Mudhoo admitted a breach of Rule 638(1)(d) with the JCA suspending his licence to ride at race meetings for 2 days effective 18 September to 1 October inclusive.

Race 4 | **BOB SKELTON MEMORIAL RATING 75 (1400m)**

IMPERIUM (M McNab) – began awkwardly and got back. When questioned about the performance, rider M McNab advised that today's distance was well short of the gelding's best and had been happy with today's effort.

LAAFFAIRE (K Williams) – began awkwardly.

TOMMYRA (J Morris) –slow to begin and further hampered when crowded shortly after the start, held up in the early and middle stages of the run home.

SPRINGWATER (R Cuneen) – crowded at the start, raced keenly in the early stages.

RIVERTAINE COUP (S Wynne) – raced keenly in the early stages.

FLYING IBIS (B Moore) – held up in the early and middle stages of the run home.

ADMIRAL ROUS (G Cooksley) – raced wide throughout.

Race 5 | **PRYDE'S EASIFEED OPEN (1200m)**

RED DIRT GIRL (S Muniandy) –began awkwardly and had to be restrained when awkward on heels shortly after the start, over raced in the early stages. Rider advised that the mare was on and off the bit today and was in his opinion disappointing.

MAYBE MIAMI (C Johnson) – raced wide throughout, bumped and unbalanced momentarily at the 300 metres.

RIDING SHOTGUN (A Collett) – crowded and bumped at the 300 metres.

Race 6 | **CANTERBURY WESTLAND RACING OWNERS ASSOCIATION RATING 65 (1200m)**

SNIPARINDA (A Collett) – crowded on jumping losing ground.

SHEZATOUCHA (K Mudhoo) – slow to begin, angled outwards at the 350 metres making contact with outside runner.

FLYTIME (R Cuneen) – shifted out abruptly at the start crowding outside runner.

STEADFAST (M Chui) – began awkwardly, raced wide throughout, bumped at the 350 metres.

INTENSE (L Callaway) – crowded by inside runners shortly after the start losing ground, had to be severely restrained for some distance when racing keenly passing the 600 metres, held up early in the run home and had to steady momentarily at the 300 metres.

ZOUGA (T Moseley) – raced keenly in the early stages. A post-race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormalities.

KEVILDO (J Morris) – raced wide throughout, crowded when weakening passing the 300 metres.

MONTOYA STAR (L Magorrian) – held up through the middle stages of the run home and had to change ground passing the 150 metres and raced in restricted room thereafter.

CZARISTA (M McNab) – held up early in the run home and had to angle wider passing the 300 metres to find clear racing room. Rider **M McNab** cautioned in regard to the manner he shifted ground at the 300 metres.

Race 7 | **NEW ZEALAND BLOODSTOCK CANTERBURY BELLE STAKES (1200m)**

SHIRLEY MAUDE (K Kalychurun) – began awkwardly, raced ungenerously in the early stages crowding and placing inside runners in restricted room at the 900 metres, continued to race greenly thereafter.

ZIGWIG (T Moseley) – crowded and placed in restricted room passing the 1000 metres, held up early in the run home and momentarily crowded passing the 300 metres. A post-race veterinary inspection revealed no abnormalities.

DARKSEID (S Muniandy) – crowded and placed in restricted room passing the 1000 metres.

O'NATURELLE (M McNab) –held up early in the run home, crowded by inside runner who shifted outwards and had to steady passing the 75 metres. The connections viewed replays of this incident before deciding not to proceed with a protest.

STARVOIA (C Johnson) – lay out under pressure final 100 metres crowding outside runner at 75 metres. Rider **C Johnson** was warned pursuant to Rule 638(1)(d) for careless riding.

<p>CANTINA (G Jogoo) – restrained to the rear on jumping, held up early in the run home, bumped with outside runner passing the 350 metres.</p> <p>RAPT N RED (K Kalychurun) – slow to begin.</p> <p>FIVE KINGS (T Moseley) – raced keenly in the early stages and had to be restrained for some distance passing the 1600 metres, held up in the early stages of the run home.</p> <p>KINGS PAL (D Prastiyou) – raced keenly in the early to middle stages.</p> <p>SCHMECKENBECHER (K Mudhoo) – raced wide for the majority of the race.</p> <p>MISS THREE STARS (S Wynne) – raced in restricted room for several strides passing the 75 metres.</p> <p>SAPERAVIOUS (C Spittles) – rider C Spittles reminded of her obligations regarding use of the whip prior to the 200 metres.</p>

<p>CASTUP (L Magorrian) – bounded at the start losing some ground. Rider L Magorrian spoken to advisedly regarding use of the whip prior to the 200 metres.</p> <p>HASELL COURT (D Chin) – crowded shortly after the start when runners either side shifted ground.</p> <p>SAROOKH (D Prastiyou) – had to steady at the 1100 metres as the pace eased slightly.</p> <p>HIGH VIZ (K Kalychurun) – had to steady at the 1100 metres as the pace eased slightly.</p> <p>BLU MACH (L Callaway) – had to steady at the 1100 metres as the pace eased slightly and had to shift wider at this point to avoid heels and was obliged to race wide thereafter.</p> <p>SLICK NICKEL (R Cuneen) – had to steady at the 1100 metres as the pace eased slightly and had to shift wider at this point to avoid heels and was obliged to race wide thereafter.</p> <p>DREAM DIVINE (T Direen) – had to steady at the 1100 metres as the pace eased slightly and then raced keenly for some distance afterwards having to be restrained.</p> <p>ALYTH (K Mudhoo) – had to steady at the 1100 metres as the pace eased slightly and then raced keenly for a short distance thereafter.</p> <p>FIRST OF A KIND (M Chui) – raced in restricted room passing the 200 metres and again over the final 100 metres.</p> <p>BAHHARE BABE (M McNab) – shifted ground outwards under pressure in the run home crowding outside runner at the 100 metres.</p>
