Race 7 Tavistock Northland Breeders Stakes
Co-trainer A Forsman advised Stewards that MONGOLIAN WOLF had come through the run well and it is now their intention to continue on with the colt's current preparation.
Race 8 Homeworld Supports Hundertwasser Art Centre
Trainer S McKee advised Stewards that WHAT'S THE STORY was found to have suffered a near fore tendon injury and has now undergone stem cell treatment to the affected area, further advising that WHAT'S THE STORY would now face a lengthy break from racing.

Race 3 STELLA ARTOIS 1400

Trainer D Guy advised Stewards that TRIGGER had undergone a veterinary examination upon return to her stable with no obvious abnormality being detected. It is now her intention to continue with the gelding's preparation.

Race 4 HASTINGS – HEART OF HAWKE'S BAY 1300

Trainer J Bridge advised Stewards that VAN GOGH had come through the run well with no abnormality becoming apparent in the days following its run on 17 September.

Trainer C McDougal advised Stewards that TAVIJAZZ had pulled up well following its run, further adding it is now her intention to race the mare in blinkers at its next start.

Race 5 L I REDSHAW MEMORIAL

Trainer A Fieldes advised Stewards that GINNER HART had come through its run well, further adding that the gelding may be aimed at the Otaki meeting on 15 October.

Race 6 HAWKE'S BAY BREEDERS GOLD TRAIL STAKES

Trainer G Richardson advised Stewards that after receiving treatment upon return to his stable VOLPE VELOCE was showing no signs of lameness, adding that it was his intention to add a barrier blanket to VOLPE VELOCE's gear and starting her at Te Rapa on 30 September.

Race 8 WINDSOR PARK PLATE

Trainer D Guy advised Stewards that CAPELLA had undergone a veterinary examination upon return to her stable with no obvious abnormality being detected, adding that CAPELLA would now be sent for a spell.

BAYMAX (Z Nor Azman) – Slow away, and had to be steadied shortly after losing ground.

APPREHEND (M Cameron) – Began awkwardly.

MISS MAZZY (K Marzuki) – Began awkwardly.

STAN'S TUF TIGER (A Sims) – Lay in when placed under pressure in the final straight.

MR DAVINCI (E Farr) – Began awkwardly, and then raced ungenerously through the early and middle stages. Steadied when placed in restricted room near the 200 metres.

NOMBERO (M Coleman) – Steadied when placed in restricted room near the 1200 metres. E Farr admitted a breach of careless riding for allowing her mount MR DAVINCI to shift in when not fully clear of **NOMBERO** which was checked near the 250 metres. The Judicial Committee suspended E Farr's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Saturday 24 September up to and including racing on Friday 30 September, 4 riding days.

BOULTED INN (C Grylls) – STAN'S TUF TIGER (A Sims) shifted in when placed under pressure in the final straight momentarily inconveniencing **BOULTED INN** near the 200 metres. A Sims was advised to exercise greater care.

<p>GULD (M Cameron) – Lay out throughout the running.</p> <p>AMACHI (M Hills) – Forced over extra ground passing the 600 metres when GULD lay out.</p> <p>LEICA LADY (B Hutton) – Made contact with GEORGETHEFIFTH near the 400 metres. Received slight contact passing the 200 metres then shifting inwards away from that runner before bumping with GEORGETHEFIFTH near the 150 metres when both runners shifted ground, and then was placed in restricted room over the concluding stages. Following the race the connections of the second placed horse LEICA LADY viewed Stewards film footage with regard to a possible protest against the first placed horse GEORGETHEFIFTH before electing not to proceed.</p> <p>GEORGETHEFIFTH (T Thornton) – Bumped 400 metres. Inclined to lay in throughout the running, making slight contact with LEICA LADY approaching the 200 metres. GEORGETHEFIFTH and LEICA LADY then came together near the 150 metres when both runners shifted ground. GEORGETHEFIFTH continued to lay in over the concluding stages placing LEICA LADY in restricted room. T Thornton was advised to exercise greater care and that she must straighten her mounts sooner than she did on this occasion.</p> <p>PLUMES VOLANTES (T Wenn) – Was denied clear running approaching the 200 metres having to shift ground outwards.</p>

<p>RON'S LAST (I Fraser-Hayes) – Began awkwardly shifting out hampering LEICA WARRIOR which lost ground.</p> <p>LEICA WARRIOR (T Thornton) – Slow to begin, then hampered shortly after.</p> <p>DISCRETELY RED (C Lammas) – Made the 800 metre bend awkwardly making contact with the hind quarters of ADMIRE which became briefly unbalanced.</p> <p>ADMIRE (D Johnson) – Briefly unbalanced 800 metres. Lay out away from LUCKY BOY near the 200 metres making contact with SHOWMUCHFUN simultaneously as CANTARE shifted inwards under pressure. As a result both SHOWMUCHFUN and ADMIRE became unbalanced. Rider S Collett was advised to exercise care.</p> <p>SHOWMUCHFUN (Z Nor Azman) – Crowded becoming briefly unbalanced near the 200 metres.</p>	
Race 4	LOWE SCHOLLUM & JONES LTD 1200
<p>SENASSY (Z Nor Azman) – Began awkwardly making contact with RESURRECT having to steady when awkwardly placed on that runner's heels. Made the 800 metre bend awkwardly shifting out forcing MIHAIA out on to the heels of BLUETWENTYTWO with MIHAIA clipping a heel of the runner and blundered.</p> <p>ONLY IF (M Cameron) – Lay out making the final bend before held up for a distance having to shift ground inwards approaching the 200 metres to obtain clear running.</p> <p>MIHAIA (H Marzuki) – Forced outwards near the 800 metres clipping the heel of BLUETWENTYTWO and blundering.</p> <p>MADDEE FAE (S Weatherley) – Eased down in the final straight by its rider. S Weatherley reported that the mare had felt indifferent in its action. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormality.</p> <p>STYLISH ACHIEVER (R Elliot) – A post-race veterinary examination found the mare to have tied up.</p>

ROCKET QUEEN (L Magorrian) – Began awkwardly, losing ground.

MR INK (E Farr) – Slow away. Lost the left hind plate during the running.

MARTINI LASS (D Danis) – Raced keenly leaving the straight on the first occasion.

CABARET (C Lammas) – Commenced to give ground from inside the 700 metres. Rider C Lammas could offer no tangible excuse for the mare's performance. A post-race veterinary examination of **CABARET** found no obvious abnormality other than the mare to be showing signs of a slow recovery rate. Co-trainer J Richards advised Stewards that the mare would now be spelled.

KILMAC (D Prastiyou) – Steadied when placed in restricted room to the inside of MR INK (E Farr) which shifted in near the 500 metres. Rider E Farr was advised to exercise care.

THENAMESBOND (Z Nor Azman) – Began awkwardly shifting out crowding JUST GOT HOME which lost ground.

JUST GOT HOME (R Scott) – Crowded start losing ground.

HE'S DAN (A Jones) – Inconvenienced 300 metres.

DOUCETTE (B Hutton) – Over-raced through the early stages.

ON PAROLE (S Collett) – Shifted out under pressure inconveniencing HE'S DAN passing the 300 metres.

SECONDS OUT (D Johnson) – When questioned regarding the performance of the gelding rider D Johnson advised Stewards that in her opinion **SECONDS OUT** may be feeling the effects of recent racing.

MERITAGGIO (Z Nor Azman) – Lay in under pressure inconveniencing HESALLJAZZ passing the 50 metres. Rider Z Nor Azman was issued with a warning. Lost the right front plate during the running.

HESALLJAZZ (C Lammas) – Had to steady passing the 50 metres.

ARZAK (S Weatherley) – Lay out when placed under pressure in the final straight.
